he New Spectrum Contract has finally begun as of March 23rd and if you aren't already taking advantage of the new benefits, please do so. Make sure you have the right Modem and Router to get higher-speed internet (if your computer allows it). Get a DVR if you don't already have one, the DVR and its service are included, in addition to the bandwidth to support your smart devices. Please get the most from this Spectrum Package. I hope the new TV channel line-up meets your approval. Enjoy

Note: For all questions and support please go to or call Spectrum @ 1-855-326-5115, or call a friend. Please do not call the PI office as they will only direct you to call Spectrum for support.

I would like to remind all residents and your heirs that all sales of homes must be authorized through the office. This process ensures the prospective buyer meets the requirements to live in our community and that the sale is documented properly for everyone's benefit. A sales package is available from the PI office as needed or to include in your important papers.

The Co-Op Board has reaffirmed the Neighborhood Watch Program. Please Watch and Support NW program events. Protect our community. Program volunteers are needed, if interested please reach out to the New Program Director.

A Rules and Regulations committee has been re-established to review and make our rules reasonable, fair, and enforceable. The rules and regulations are for our mutual benefit and every resident should have a copy received during orientation and/or mailed to you when they were last updated in July 2019. Please avoid the penalties, follow the rules, and support the community.

The Communications committee will work to continue and enhance our communications with all residents. If you are not receiving messages for One Call, or Email distribution, please sign up to be included.

We are changing our process and the Concern forms are being eliminated. **The new method** includes a form to notify the PI office of an issue that requires repair/corrective action by the Maintenance Department or a Non-compliance issue relating to our Rules & Regulations. All other issues such as Neighbor-to-Neighbor Complaints are **NOT handled** by Park Management and you will have to address them with your neighbor directly.

Please note that the Co-Op Board of Directors and the Park Office Management **Do Not do business on Facebook**. If you want your issue addressed it needs to be submitted in writing to the Park Office using the new form.

As our winter residents get ready to head North, please Summer-ize your Florida home to protect your investment and your neighbors. Store away items in your yard, and help protect your neighbors and the community, Thank You. Please make sure your summer contact information is up to date in the office. Kipp who also offered her name to be a board member. The HOA will have another breakfast on April 15th, from 8:30 to 10:30, cost \$7 the menu will be determined later.

Continuing from last month's message... The PI Social Committee is the organization charged with the responsibility to coordinate and provide the equipment necessary to the many park activities from Boccie to Water Aerobics, as well as providing the clubhouse entertainment that we all enjoy. They will consider starting a new activity if someone is willing to be the chairperson and there are enough residents interested. Recently they added a Quilt group and a Book Club.

The PI Church In The Park is probably the least known of the incorporated groups. This Non-Denominational congregation is providing faith based services within the park that include Sunday Services, Choir, Bible Study, Prayer Group plus the Sonshine Committee includes the Prayer Bears, Greeting Cards and New People Contact. The church also administers a Outreach Fund that the church and HOA have contributed monies to, that is available to help park residents that may need some temporary financial assistance. Should you or someone you know benefit from the outreach fund, please contact a member listed in the church message article of the monthly media.

That leaves the HOA. Our by-laws direct us to provide a conduit for non-share residents to address concerns with the Co-Op. Of course, you can always fill out an incident report at the Co-Op office as well. Bingo was accepted as an HOA responsibility because neither the Co-Op or the Social Committee wanted to tackle the weekly burden. It is a monumental task that requires numerous volunteers to pull it off. During COVID we were shut down but are beginning to return to pre-covid levels, which will allow us to finance projects for the park that will not increase our monthly lease. We will be exploring a maximum \$3000 grant from the City of Largo which requires matching funds and, with your guidance, will select an appropriate project to submit for the grant.

Thanks you from your HOA Board. We, like the volunteer board members that served before us, need your support.

VETERAN'S CORNER

Teterans who received care at non-VA emergency rooms since 2010 could now get some of their out-of-pocket costs reimbursed years later, even if their claims were previously denied. The VA is finalizing a new rule, published Feb. 22 and taking effect April



24, that would cover those past costs and reimburse veterans going forward.

The prior patients will have to file a new claim with the VA by Feb. 22, 2024, to get the money. The retroactive reimbursements apply only to VA patients who received emergency treatment for a non-service-connected condition and who also had health insurance through a third-party insurer. The VA will reimburse only coinsurance -- defined as the patient's out-of-pocket, cost-sharing percentage with their third-party insurer -- at non-VA emergency departments and won't reimburse flat-rate copayments or payments toward flat-rate deductibles. Emergency transportation such as an ambulance ride also counts as care.

Veterans and Paying for Emergency Care

Typically, the VA can pay for emergency medical care if the treated condition is service-related or caused by a condition tied to a veteran's service, and care isn't available at a VA facility, according to its website.

For conditions not considered service-connected, VA can also pay for emergency medical care but only under certain conditions: Care must be provided in a hospital emergency department; care must be given to treat life or health-threatening conditions; the required care must not be available to the veteran at a VA; and the veteran must have received care at a VA facility within the past two years. In an emergency, the VA says the veteran should go to the "nearest emergency department."

The new reimbursement rule affects veterans who are covered by both VA and private insurance.

The VA will pay the reimbursements retroactive Covering Vets Who Had Private Insurance to care received on or after Feb. 1, 2010, the effective date of the Expansion of Veteran Eligibility for Reimbursement Act. The change was made after a prolonged series of court battles, public comment periods, letters from both houses of Congress and the consideration by VA of some existing precedent.
