- 5. Allow any thoughts, noises or sensations to flow in and out of your mind, redirecting your attention to following your breath.

That's it! Keep is short and simple to start. You may slowly increase your time or try other methods, but this simple daily practice will, in fact, gradually reduce your symptoms of a clogged, inflamed brain.






