- Please stop at all the stop signs whether you are driving, in a golf cart, or on a bicycle.
- Take pride in your home and weed, pressure wash, and clean up the carports.
- Make sure that any car you have in the community has a parking decal or pass.
- Please take a few minutes out of your day to read the current Rules and Regulations and make sure that you are following them. They are available on the Palm Hill Website or you can pick up a copy from the office.

**For our seasonal residents, as you head back north: bring inside anything that can fly around in the event of a hurricane. Please also shut off the water to your home and set your A/C just low enough to prevent humidity inside.
