FROM DEE'S KITCHEN TO YOU

Easter Frittata

Six large eggs

1/3 cups heavy whipping cream

1/2 tsp salt, adjust to taste

1 large container of ricotta cheese

1 pound of sausage, out of its casing

1/2 pound bacon well done.

3 tb parsley

Brown sausage, cooked bacon

Beet eggs, cream and ricotta cheese well. Add sausage, bacon, and parsley bake 350 for one hour. Keep checking. To make sure Top is nice and brown and eggs settled.





Cinnamon Baked French Toast

1-loaf of crusty sourdough or French bread

8- eggs

2 cups of whole milk

1/2 cup whipping heavy cream

1/2 cup of sugar

1/2 cup of brown sugar

2 tablespoons of vanilla extract

For the Topping

1/2 cup all purpose flour

1/2 cup firmly packed brown sugar

1 teaspoon ground cinnamon

1/4 teaspoon of salt

Freshly grated nutmeg

1 stick, cold butter, cut into pieces plus more for serving

Warm pancake syrup for serving



Grease baking pan with butter. Tear the bread into chunks or cut into cubes and just evenly distribute in the pan. Crack eggs in a large bowl. Whisk together eggs, milk, cream, granulated, sugar, brown sugar, and vanilla. Pour evenly over the bread, cover the pan tightly and store in the refrigerator overnight.

For the Topping

Mix flour, brown sugar, cinnamon, salt, and some nutmeg in a separate bowl. Stir together with fork. Add the butter with a pastry cutter and mix it all together until crumbly. Store in resealable plastic bag and put in the refrigerator. When you are ready to bake the casserole, preheat the oven 350°. Remove from refrigerator and sprinkle topping over the top. Bake at 45 minutes for a soft texture or one hour for firmer crispier texture.


