## **Neighborhood Watch**

From Ken Simms, Honeymoon Park Neighborhood Watch Coordinator

### Vacation House Check Service:



e are soon getting to the time of year when Snowbirds are beginning to return to their summer homes. "Vacation House Check" is a free service provided by the Pinellas County Sheriff's Office.

Sheriff's deputies will perform regular checks on your home while you are away. They do a complete walk around of the premises, looking for any irregularities, ensuring all windows and doors are secure and that there have been no forced entries. They also check on your vehicles you may have left

parked at your homes and for any unauthorized vehicles.

To obtain this free service, simply call the Sheriff's office at 727-582-6177 stating you are calling

to schedule for Vacation House Checks.

Be prepared to supply them with the following information:

- Date you are leaving and date you will be returning (if you return earlier, be sure to call them).
- Address for house check, (Honeymoon mobile Home Park, Lot Number, Street, Dunedin, 34698).
- Homeowners name.
- Phone number where you can be reached while away.
- Address of your destination.
- Phone number, name, and address of a local contact (neighbor or family member, etc.).
- Advise whether someone will have access to your home while away.
- If lights will be left on or on timers.
- If your vehicle or a non-owned vehicle will be parked on your property.
- Please mention if you are a member of Neighborhood Watch.

This service provides snowbirds with peace of mind knowing that your winter homes will be checked regularly by a deputy. The continued presence of Deputies in the park is another deterrent to crime. In addition to this service, many of the full-time residents in Honeymoon Park are Neighborhood Watch members. They too will be vigilant in keeping an open eye on our homes while we are away and reporting any suspicious activity to the sheriff's office.

## **CLOSING MOBILE HOME FLORIDA**

## <u>OUTSIDE</u>

- **V**Bring in all outdoor furniture.
- $\checkmark$  Put bikes in shed.
- $\checkmark$  BBQ in shed
- $\checkmark$  Any decorations on outside walls or hanging should be taken down including curtains on patios.
- $\checkmark$  Shut off water to home turn off main water valve.
- $\checkmark$  Shut off washer.
- ✓ Turn off power for washer, dryer, and fridge.
- $\checkmark$  Empty and defrost outdoor fridge and unplug.
- ✓ Pull down window covers and outside shutters.
- ✓ Disconnect hose, reel, and bring inside.
- ✓ Turn off water heater breaker if electric or put on with low/vacation/pilot setting if gas.
- ✓ If vehicle left, connect vehicle battery maintainer, or disconnect battery.
- $\checkmark$  Make sure all trash and recycling items have been removed and put in trash bins.

## **INSIDE**

- $\checkmark$  If using humidistat set at 50%
- ✓ Put bars of Irish Spring soap out in plastic bowls (1/2 bar per bowl) and place several in each room
- $\checkmark$  Put out ant and roach traps.
- $\checkmark$  Put bleach in toilets and cover with saran plastic wrap and shut lid.
- ✓ Any cans etc. being left put in Rubbermaid bins with lids.
- $\checkmark$  Empty and wash out fridge.
- ✓ Change batteries in humidistat.
- ✓ Place fabric softener sheets on furniture and beds
- ✓ Thermostat at 86
- ✓ Bleach in drains; put covers on drains.
- ✓ Unplug TV
- ✓ Take home any adaptors needed in another residence.
- ✓ Call Duke Energy and suspend Spectrum.
- ✓ Post Office change of address
- ✓ Call Pinellas Sheriff to let them know how long your home will be vacant: www.pcsoweb.com and search for <u>Vacation House Checks</u>
- ✓ Change return air filters and leave extras for folks checking on home.
- ✓ Unplug night lights.
- ✓ Replace all smoke detector batteries.
- $\checkmark$  Have A/C serviced, including the cleaning of the drain line.
- $\checkmark$  Leave dishwasher door slightly open.
- ✓ Leave all cabinet doors open.
- ✓ Leave all closet doors open.
- $\checkmark$  Put rubber drain covers on shower floor drains.
- ✓ Leave window blinds down 1 inch from windowsill to avoid mildew buildup.



## **2023 Mobile Collection Events**

s of October 2022, Pinellas County updated the list of items that will be collected. Effective October 2022, your government issued ID will be required and scanned to verify Pinellas County residency.
