ore information will be coming. Keep an eye on the Scuttlebutt, e-mail, facebook, and the weather channels.

BEING PREPARED FOR A HURRICANE:

Hurricane season begins June 1st and ends November 30th, more or less. We in mobile homes are in the area known as ZONE A. This designation means we must evacuate from our homes when/if a hurricane is expevcted to come to our area. Evacuation may be to a friend's or relative's home in a safe zone, going North and or inland or to a designated shelter. If you require assistance with transport during the emergency, arrangements can be clarified through the citizen's information center 727-464-4333 PRIOR TO THE NEED. Forms will be available to be completed then submitted to appropriate people at the EOC. This number is only available once the hurricane threat is posted. Paper pamphlets are being printed and will be available.

To get updates on any storm it is suggested you sign up to receive emergency notifications by phone text or e-mail at www.pinellascounty.org/alertpinellas.

To find updates on preparedness before, during and after the storm sign-on at www. pinellascounty.org/emergency.

If you have a pet you can contact www.pinellascounty.org/animalservices.

Information on general preparedness and live updates during emergencies can be seen from the Emergency Operations Center (EOC) and found on Spectrum 637, WOW! 18 or Frontier 44.

It's also time to be putting that **TO-GO-BOX** together, just in case.

12 essential items you need to pack: 1. 1 gallon of water per person per day. 2. Food, at least a 3 day supply of non-perishable with a can opener if you have canned foods. 3. Battery powered or hand crank radio and weather radio with tone alert. 4. Flashlight and extra batteries. 5. Basic first aid kit and supplies. 6. Whistle to signal for help. 7. Dust mask to filter contaminated air. 8. Plastic sheet and duct tape for sheltering in place. 9. Moist towelettes, garbage bags, and plastic ties. 10. Flood and Homeowner's Insurance policies. 11. Pictures of the Property before the Hurricane. 12. Cell phone with chargers and a battery backup.

ADDITIONAL emergency supplies to include in that **TO-GO-BOX**: prescription medications, contact lenses, and prescription glasses, important documents in a waterproof container, cash, blankets, change of clothes, sturdy shoes, hats, water purification tablets, fire extinguisher, matches in waterproof container, personal hygiene items, paper cups, plates, paper towels, plastic silverware, pet food, medical records for pets, and paper and pencils.

Residents of Harbor Lights: the following are sites that may be accessed to assist in the event of a hurricane coming to our area: pinellascounty.org/emergency/prepare ahead/htm storm.pinellascounty.org nhc.noaa.gov cdc.gov/disasters/hurricanes/before.htm A WATCH alert usually is 72 hours before the storm.

A WARNING means prepare to leave. It is suggested a supply of batteries, a USB battery pack (charged), battery "tea lights" be ready Battery operated radio is also recommended. One gallon of water per person, or a case of water bottles. WE are ZONE A therefore, must evacuate. NO ONE CAN REMAIN. A VEHICLE WILL MAKE THE ROUNDS OF THE PARK TO ANNOUNCE EVACUATION IS TO OCCUR.

If someone is in need of an electrical source for medical purposes contact a friend to seek shelter in a safe home, or prearrange a stay at a local hotel when the first alert occurs that a possible hurricane is approaching. If you don't have a vehicle bus lines are available to call PSTA 727-540-1900

After the storm: Wait for all clear signal: notice is broadcast once the danger of fallen trees, flooding or other conditions have been addressed.



HERE'S WHAT'S COOKING:

Best Darn Ham Sandwiches;

2 -12 packages of sweet Hawaiian rolls (the small dinner roll looking ones), 1 ½ lbs of Virginia ham (NOT honey ham), 12 slices of Swiss cheese, 1 stick of real butter, 2 tsp. Worcestershire sauce, 1 tsp. garlic powder, 1 tsp. onion powder, 1 tsp. poppy seeds (optional).

You will need two 9x13 pans. Place the bottoms of 12 rolls in each pan. Place ham (about 2 shaved slices or so) on the rolls. Cut the cheese slices into 4 parts and place 2 small pieces on each sandwich. Put the dinner roll tops on. In a sauce pan, mix butter Worcestershire sauce, onion powder, garlic powder and poppy seeds. Wait until all butter is melted and then brush the melted mixture over the ham sandwiches. Cover with foil and lit sit in fridge for 1 hour or overnight. (If you want to bake them right, you can). Preheat oven to 375 degrees and bake for 15 minutes or until cheese is melted. Serve. They are hot and even at room temperature.




