

Slow Cooker Baked Potato Soup

Ingredients:

- 4 lbs frozen diced potatoes
- 1 medium yellow onion, diced (about ½ cup)
- 6 cloves of garlic, minced (if you use jarred, it's a 3 tsp equivalent)
- 64 oz chicken stock or broth
- 8 oz fat free cream cheese
- 2 tsp All Season salt
- 8 oz diced ham (optional)

Garnishes (also optional): crumbled crisp bacon, shredded cheese, chopped green onions Directions:

- 1. Add potatoes, onion, garlic, seasoning, and chicken stock to slow cooker.
- 2. Cook on high for 4-6 hours (potatoes should be very soft).
- 3. Set aside half of the soup. Add cream cheese to the slow cooker and incorporate it using an immersion blender or handheld mixer.
- 4. Return the half you set aside to the slow cooker, add the diced ham, and stir well. Cook on low for another 15-30 minutes.
- 5. Serve into soup bowls and top with garnish of your choice.

FROM THE OFFICE

Summer seems to have arrived, as we have been setting records for high temperatures. Before we get to the time of year when the nights stay warm and it is hot and muggy



all the time, I suggest you take notice of the condition of your mobile home. I have sent out over 60 letters to residents who needed to have their mobile home power washed (Park rules state that it must be done at least once a year). I have also started to send out letters regarding carports: no construction materials, garbage cans, household furniture, refrigerators, etc. The carports in the park were all in great shape as everyone prepared for Hurricane Ian last fall. Now it's time to prepare for Hurricane Jessie! I will be taking several park rides every week looking for carport issues, as well as screen rooms being used as storage, broken or cracked windows, boarded up windows, etc.

I also will be looking for garbage being put out early. Today is Saturday, and I took a ride earlier and saw a toilet laying by the road. Who wants to have guests come over and see that? What makes it even worse was this person lives within a short distance from the 3rd street dumpster, which was open! I have said it before, and I will say it again.....items the Park picks up ARE NOT to be put out until after 5 p.m. on Sundays, Tuesdays, and Thursday. If it is raining and you have furniture, leave it under your carport so it doesn't get soaking wet and heavy, then call or text Roy and tell him you would like it picked up but wanted to keep it dry. If I see it out earlier, I will text Roy to not pick it up at all...take a little pride in the Park that you call home, even if it is only your home for part of the year.

The camera has been installed at the 3rd street dumpster, so beware that I am watching you! I have already sent people to retrieve items they left there on the ground. Who do you think is going to pick up your outdoor heater, mattresses, etc. and put them in the dumpster? No garbage fair lives here!



Residents are still putting yard waste and remodeling scraps in the wrong dumpster. I have kept a dumpster in the Park just for yard waste for several months, so there is no reason for it to be put in the garbage dumpsters. It doesn't even get locked up! I find it funny that this is usually done after it is dark.....do you not realize that the cameras work at night??? When I see a female hefting a large black bag into the top of the dumpster as if it was as light as a softball, do you not think that I can figure out it is yard waste? I get real cranky if I don't

get enough sleep, so you really do not want me to be returning your trash to you late at night or first thing in the morning!!

There are 3 "Summer" holidays, Memorial Day, 4th of July and Labor Day. If someone is interested in being a coordinator for any of these dates, you can reach out to Ron Russell or myself and we will gladly give you some guidance.

The membership allows you to play and practice at the Clubhouse Courts and to eventually be part of one of the three teams (when there is space available and after being taught the basics and getting knowledgeable with the game).

FMO

(Florida Manufactured/Mobile Home Owners Organization)

MO is a non-partisan organization with a mission to "promote the general welfare of our members, protect the rights and interest of, and be a consumer advocate for manufactured/mobile home owners of Florida."



Pretty words, but what does that mean? The FMO keeps a close eye on policies — as well as proposed policies — and laws which may affect manufactured/mobile home owners. They work hand-in-hand with legislators to ensure someone is looking out for the home owners/residents of mobile home communities. And while the overall outcome will affect you whether you are a member or not, you CAN INFLUENCE the discussion by becoming a member of the FMO. When our FMO lobbyist approaches a legislator about a certain bill, one of the key talking points is how many people are in favor of/opposed to the proposed action. The higher the number of FMO members, the greater the chance a legislator will support our point of view on the matter. An example of some proposed legislation for 2023 includes a proposal to eliminate sales tax on the resale of a mobile home; clarifies that a homeowner or HOA may file a complaint in circuit court without prior mediation; requires the Park owner/manager to respond to an applicant who desires to be a resident within 15 days; and allows the HOA to represent some or all of the home owners in legal proceedings. So, it is in YOUR best interests to join the FMO. Our Embassy representative is Ron Russell, lot 1301. He has the blank application forms and will gladly forward your application and membership fees to the FMO office for you. Current membership fees are \$25/year or \$65/3 years (prices are going up in August to \$30 per year or 3 years for \$75).

EMBASSY HOMEOWNERS' ASSOCIATION (HOA)

he HOA deals with issues of a park-wide nature; it does not deal with personal issues/complaints with the Park Owner or Park Manager. The HOA appoints a Rent Committee comprised of up to 5 people who meet with the Park Owner once a year to discuss any rent increases or issues that



affect the safety and well-being of everyone in the Park. Why should you join the HOA? The HOA speaks for all members when approaching the Park Owner or Park Manager with their concerns. However, to be considered a legitimate representative for all, the HOA must be established by approval of 30 percent of the current residents who own their homes. HOA members are knocking on doors in an effort to get the required 30 percent of signatures on the petition, so please, if the title to your mobile home is in your name, sign the petition. HOA Meetings: You do not have to be a member to attend the twice-yearly meetings, but you MUST BE a member to vote on any actions taken by the HOA. It is easy to join and there are no membership fees. Simply bring a copy of the title to your mobile home, with your name on it, to any HOA board member and say that continued or page 27



HURRICANE PREPAREDNESS

The official season runs June 1st through November 30, but we have seen hurricanes in May so now is the time to start preparing. The Office has Hurricane Preparedness Guides which contain valuable information



on shelters, evacuation routes, and items to have on hand in the event of a prolonged power outage. There are some things you can get ahead of time, a little at a time, so you don't break the bank with a large purchase when a hurricane is imminent. Consider:

- 1. Generators. This can be a bit expensive and there is no guarantee that we will lose power for more than a few hours, if at all. If you are leaning toward purchasing a generator you will find that the prices are better BEFORE a hurricane arrives. And, if you do get a generator, you will need a supply of gas to power it. Gas is a very volatile substance so take care when storing it. Also, if you find yourself powering up the generator, be sure it is placed in a well-ventilated area.
- 2. Cash. Most of us use our debit cards for all purchases and therefore find little need for cash on hand. However, if the power goes out here, it is most likely also out at the grocery store and restaurants. You may be able to find a place to buy food and water, but there is no guarantee that they will have power to run electronic cash registers. Banks/ATMs are just as vulnerable to power outage, and you may not be able to get cash-on-the-go if you wait until the last minute.
- 3. Bottled water. This is a biggie. Designate a location in your home or shed where you can store bottled water. You may think that the tap water will continue to flow even without power, but the water treatment and sewage plants cannot do their jobs without power. Think about how much water you drink on a daily basis and store enough to last 7 days. You can buy small packs at a time (I know I can't lift the larger cases of bottled water)—a few bottles per week—until you feel you have enough to outlast any inconvenience from a hurricane. Again, if you wait until the last minute, you risk not being able to get any water at all.
- 4. Paper products. Have you ever noticed? As soon as a storm is brewing in the Caribbean there is a run at the grocery store for toilet paper, paper towels, and paper plates (dishwashers will not run without power). So why would you want to join the madhouse? Buy extra packs of toilet paper and paper towels now. They won't spoil and can be easily stored in the bottom of your closet so they are out of the way. The same goes for paper plates and bowls.

Note: Last year Florida had a "disaster preparedness tax holiday" running May 28th through June 10th. You can expect a similar tax holiday this year, though specific dates have not yet been announced (they will likely be announced on the local news program or published in the newspaper). The tax holiday includes many items, to include generators, batteries, flashlights and lanterns, to name just a few.

I will discuss more pressing preparations in the June 1st issue.


