# SOUTHWIND COMMUNITY YARD SALE FUNDRAISER WAS A "WIN-WIN"

Thanks to the hard work of devoted community volunteers, led by new Board Member Dudley Harvey, this year's annual Community Yard Sale was a huge success! Homeowners, residents and friends were invited to donate items we no longer need or want, to be sold at this sale. Proceeds of all donated items sold went into the HOA bank account to fund future events and activities for the entire community.

This was a rare opportunity for residents (like myself) who do not have the stamina/physical ability to haul items out to our own carports for buyers to drive around and park to view and buy, or perhaps didn't have enough items of their own to sell. Dudley made and posted signs in the neighborhood asking for donations for the sale. He printed announcements to hand out at the HOA Meeting with donation info. The response was overwhelming!

Dudley announced that pre-sale items were pictured and sold at Facebook Marketplace, which made \$1,070 in advanced sales for this HOA Fundraiser.

He led and/or organized volunteers to pick up donations on the Friday before the event. More than 15 volunteers pitched in to help make this fundraiser successful.

There were 2 pickup trucks and several golf carts that made 20-25 trips to pick up donations from our community, including some large furniture. Dudley thanks our entire Southwind community for the many volunteers and countless donations from residents, too many to list, who he said were all responsible for the success of this event.

There were 8 tables full of items inside the Clubhouse and the sidewalk/parking lot spaces were full of donated items to sell. Photos taken at this event tell the story. At the end of the day, our Treasurer deposited \$2,616.20 in proceeds to our HOA bank account from the Yard Sale. This event was the largest fundraiser one day event on record, since Covid and maybe ever. After the sale was over, Dudley had previously arranged a pick up for unsold items from a local church.

What a great way for all of us to de-clutter our homes/ sheds, and enjoy the benefits of our donations with more HOA funds as our return. The fact that so many donations came pouring in, and so many people volunteered to help, is absolute proof of what a great community we have here at home in Southwind!

# **POT LUCK SOCIAL**

Pot Lucks are back at Southwind and what a great success this one was! About 40 people attended this event in the Club House at 6pm on Saturday, March 11th to bring their favorites and sample a huge variety of tasty treats. It was nice to relax, socialize with friends and neighbors, and not have to cook a full dinner at home.

Delicious treats were brought in by residents. Everything from deviled eggs, oriental cabbage salad, to a pork roast with barbeque sauce, braised mushrooms, scalloped potatoes and ham, pasta dishes, Top Gun tots, Tex Mex casserole, buffalo chicken sandwiches, gluten free brownies, cakes and grape salad to HUGE fresh strawberries filled three whole tables! Plates were full for those enjoying the plentiful fare. Iced tea and lemonade were provided. There was so much food there to sample that it's hard to even remember it all. Another Pot Luck planned for Flag Day on June 14th. Do yourself a favor and don't miss it!

Here are some recipes from the March Pot Luck:

<u>Top Gun Tots</u> – bake frozen tater tots – enough to fill a baking dish (8x8 square) with the cooked tots, add a layer of crumbled cooked bacon bits and top with triple cheddar shredded cheese. Bake or microwave the whole dish just long enough to melt the cheese and serve hot.

### **ORIENTAL NAPPA CABBAGE SALAD** – from Connie Brandt

- 1 head NAPPA CABBAGE (chopped)
- 5 green ONIONS (chopped)
- 1 head BROCCOLI FLORETS (chopped)
- Rinse cabbage, broccoli and green onions in cold water drain well. Can be stored in plastic bag with a paper towel in the bottom to absorb any moisture.
- 2 packs RAMEN NOODLES discard flavor pack (or save for other recipes)
- 1 cup sliced ALMONDS
- 2 T. SESAME SEEDS

In a skillet melt ¼ c. butter. Add crushed/crumbled Ramen noodles, sliced almonds and sesame seeds. Brown till toasted. Drain on a paper towel.

Can be stored in a separate plastic bag till mixed.

### **DRESSING**

- <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> cup of cider vinegar
- ½ cup sugar
- 1 tsp. Soy Sauce
- ½ cup Salad Oil

Dissolve sugar and vinegar (warm in microwave for about 20 seconds. Add soy sauce and salad oil. Can be saved in a plastic container until served. Shake well before adding to veggies. Mix well and serve.

The closest Recycling Drop-off to us is AT 1825 Curlew Rd between Belcher Rd and CR 1 (southside).

This recycling drop-off center is managed by the Pinellas County Department of Solid Waste. Accepted materials include: glass bottles and jars, metal food and beverage cans, flattened cardboard, paper, plastic bottles and jugs, and cartons. All other materials are not accepted; plastic bags are not accepted.

There are also Monthly Mobile Collection Events. The closest one to Southwind is located at 29582 US Hwy 19 N Clearwater, FL 33761 for chemicals, paints, electronics etc. Visit <a href="https://www.pinellas.gov/household-chemical-collection/">www.pinellas.gov/household-chemical-collection/</a> for the Mobile Collection Schedule and a list of accepted materials. Events are limited to Pinellas County residents only. Please note that your government-issued ID will be required and scanned to verify residency.

Did you know you can get free mulch?

Free mulch is available to Pinellas County residents. Just bring a pitchfork and take as much as you need. For pickup truck or trailer loads, be sure to come prepared with a tarp or vehicle cover to keep your mulch load secured, as required by law.



example; last year a 2.0 Ton AC Unit was \$2,995.99 with tax and Standard Installation is \$700. Total cost was less than \$3,700. There are 2 locations close to our area, in Largo & New Port Richey. Plan ahead with preventive actions:

Schedule an annual system check, and have your tech check your air flow and temperature in all vents to make sure there is no blocked duct that interferes with cooling. Also, have a leaf guard mesh covering installed over the a/c fan. It's important to have a tech vacuum out leaves inside to prevent the cause of damage later or rust out the inside of the unit.

Make sure to change the a/c filter monthly or quarterly, depending on the filter – spraying Lysol inside the opening before inserting the new filter makes the whole house smell fresh and clean.

Hot water heaters need to be serviced annually to drain the sediment out of the line. Too much sediment in the drain line can cause major damage.

Annual and pre-season check-ups really do have a value because they indicate potential problems that can possibly be avoided later on. Plumbing lines under the house need to be checked or cleaned out annually to prevent potential blockage out to the street or through the household lines.

Ask about Senior or Military Discounts – even though the providers who give those discounts tend to cost more, it never hurts to ask.

Here are some tips to help you for when those pesky and expensive things happen at your house:

\*Make a list of service providers you can call, and tape it to the inside of a kitchen cabinet door, so it will be handy and easy to find when you need it.

\*Know where you put the paperwork, install/repairs receipts and warranty/service contract information for all of your appliances (HVAC, Water Heater, etc) so you can have it ready to view when your service provider arrives.

\*Set aside an emergency bank account to cover the cost of repairs for your home and/or your car and don't touch it or tap into it for anything else...(even if you're sure you're on a winning streak at the Hard Rock or Biloxi Casino)

\*Don't try to be a hero and fix it yourself, it may cost you twice as much when your "repairs" don't hold up. (Do you remember "Tim the Toolman Taylor", from the TV show Home Improvement – yeah, don't be him!)

Every homeowner should be familiar with where to find access points or plumbing shut off valves and make sure your breaker box is labeled correctly.




