### WHAT IS THE DIFFERENCE?

- 1. Both "may" and "can" are used to indicate that something is allowed, but "may" is more formal: "You may leave whenever you like" is more formal than "You can go whenever you want to."
  - May is a request asking permission. "May I go for a bike ride?", requests permission. Can implies the ability to do something. "Can I go for a bike ride?", asks whether I have the ability to do so.
- 2. "May and "might" both indicate that it is possible something might/may occur. However, may expresses a high possibility of something happening, whereas might hints that it might not happen.
- 3. In legal documents, there is an important distinction between "shall" and "may." "Shall" is a command; whatever follows after "shall" is mandatory. It is required; it must be done. On the other hand, "may" is discretionary; what comes after "may" is optional; it is at the discretion of the person making the decisions.
