That's makes our Colonial Village Park a 5-Star park?

There are many aspects – professionally trimmed palm trees, well-manicured green lawns, colorful shrubs, well-kept white fence, well-kept sidewalks and roadways, signage, cleanliness, amenities including the pool and clubhouse, and, of course, the friendly residents.

Recently a team led by Jon Lago, unit 96, and Terry Benham, unit 129, both avid gardeners, removed the dead shrubs and planted the 'islands' with two varieties of twenty eight colorful scrubs consisting of mango and mammy Crotons and Schefflera Arboricola which blended nicely with the existing green and yellow shrubs. It was a 2+ day job. The islands at the East Bay entrance are inviting as well as the front door clubhouse entrance beds. The entrance park sign was recently repainted. The beds around the pool and the clubhouse front entrance were done too. Fifty-two bags of Cedar Mulch were put down; their helpers were Dave Benham,



Melinda Hartsel, Unit 70, and Richard Bradish, unit 135. The shrubs will be pruned by Jon and Terry. The expense was under budget - \$600. Thank you, Jon and Terry. They both have beautiful plants around their units. Terry also helps with coffees, pancake breakfasts, and will be active with many summer activities.

Watering and Colonial Village Equipment

Te have a lovely community because of you, our volunteers and staff. Residents are urged to keep their units clean, flower bed bricks clean and weeded, and shrubs groomed. If you irrigate your lawn and shrubs, please consider doing it in the early morning because it is the most effective and that 'stinky water' spraying during the day results in unpleasant odors for others enjoying outdoors, especially during meal times.





Let's review the park rules. Watering the lawn can be done by hand sprinkling using a shut-off valve per the City of Largo regulations. Inground sprinkler systems are allowed. Only well water can be used for yard watering. Use of City water is not permitted. If excessive use of water is determined due to car washing, carport washing or lawn watering, the Resident will receive a notice of violation as determined by the Association. Watering restrictions may be in effect. Check with the

Colonial Village Office.

Folks that require assistance may find the tools available or guidance from our maintenance staff. Residents and other designated people are not to use maintenance department golf carts without prior written approval from maintenance department personnel. Golf carts are not to be taken outside Colonial Village for personal use. All users of the maintenance department golf carts must be insured at time of use. Maintenance department golf carts, tools and power equipment (push-mowers, edgers, trimmers, blowers, and power washers) are not to be used for personal use during normal maintenance department working hours unless authorized by maintenance department personnel. All of the above equipment is not to be removed from Colonial Village. Colonial Village shall be held harmless in all respects. Maintenance department equipment can be used by Residents only for personal use at their own risk, and Colonial Village shall be held harmless in all respects. All maintenance equipment used by Residents must be signed out. Residents will be held liable for any negligent damage to the equipment. Outside contractors are not permitted to use equipment belonging to Colonial Village. Thank you for your attention and contribution in keeping our community's high-end standards a priority. In addition, tables and chairs are not to be borrowed without authorization.
