IF RESIDENTS ARE INTERESTED, we can have a class on: Hands on AED use, basic First Aid and non-certified CPR. This would be free, in the clubhouse, about an hour and probably in the fall. Our own Chuck Barlet will do this for us. As a reminder, there is an AED machine in the clubhouse, to the right of the kitchen on the wall. Very easy to use. Information is on the posters and inside the case. Please do not open the packages inside.

RED BOX AT THE POOL BY THE CLUBHOUSE DOOR . This has a phone with a direct line to 911. It is a lot faster than wet hands on a cell phone in the sun.

Pool safety is not exactly neighborhood watch but let's watch out for each other. More folks, visitors, and kids may be going to the pool and there's always the chance of a fall or someone having distress in the water. BE ALERT! BE KIND! BE SAFE!

Co-op Update

Thope everyone is pleased that Matthew's Landscaping has returned with their street sweeper, I've seen some welcome back signs and the streets already look better. Matthew's planned schedule is on Fridays 4/14, 4/28, 5/5, 5/12, 5/19, 5/26. 6/2, 6/9, 6/16, 6/23, 6/30, 7/8, 7/14, 7/21, 7/28, 8/4, 8/11, 8/18, 8/25, 9/1, 9/8, 9/15, 9/22, 9/29, 10/6. 10/13, 10/27, 11/10. 11/28, 12/20, 1/19, 2/16, 3/1, 3/15 and 3/29, subject to weather. Mark your calendars. If you don't want your lawn cut, please use blue flags to indicate it. On non-mowing weeks they will be here at times to trim certain trees and leaf cleanup, dates to be announced.

Along with the Friday mowing schedule, please make sure your lawn sprinkler timer is set as to give your lawn a chance to dry before the mowers arrive, so the mower doesn't hurt your lawn. The Pinellas County watering schedule, for use of pond water is, if your lot number ends with an even number, then Thursday and/or Sunday; odd numbers on Wednesday and/or Saturday. The times are 12 am to 10 am or 4pm to 11:59pm. That is once per day and up to twice per week. The length of time sprinklers should be on varies but don't over water or that will hurt your lawn and shrubs.

A project has been started to analyze the desire, need and safety concerns of regular use of the back gate. The gate has always been for emergency use only. The planning will also include detailed plans and bids for the work that would be needed. This process/effort will take some time to accomplish properly, please be patient.

The long-awaited Traffic Light at Willow and Starkey is still in the works, but no date yet. We are working with City of Largo and the County to track progress to get it installed.

The new workorder/rules violation reporting form is being utilized to address any issues that require management intervention. We ask that every resident reviews the rules to ensure you are adhering to them. The major complaints received are parking issues (emergency vehicle access), property up-keep (debris, clutter, maintenance of your investment) and as always speeding & not stopping at signs (please watch out for your neighbors). Please be part of the solution.



That would cut us down from 21 meetings a year to 12. Board member, Ray LaBelle has been active with the FMO (Federation of Manufactured Home Owners of Florida, Inc) an advocacy group for all manufactured homeowners. Their goal is to represent us in the Florida legislature by lobbying on our behalf. All homeowners are encouraged to join the organization so that your membership dues of \$25. a year or \$65 for 3 years can continue to fund the important work they do. Contact Ray if you are interested. As we will lose channel 732 with the new Spectrum contract we will endeavor to put our meetings live and on demand on the PI Largo Facebook page. 





VETERAN'S CORNER

AMBELL, Alaska (AP) — Bruce Boolowon, then a lean 20-year-old, and a group of friends were hunting for murre eggs in a walrus skin boat on a remote Alaska island in the Bering Strait when they saw a crippled airplane flying low.



"Something was wrong," Boolowon, now 87, recalled of that day in 1955. "They came in and one engine was smoking."

Long before drones or weather balloons became military targets, a U.S. Navy P2V-5 Neptune maritime patrol aircraft had been attacked at about 8,000 feet (2,438 meters) by two Soviet MiG-15 fighters roaring out of nearby Siberia. The plane's right engine was destroyed and the pilot was making a controlled crash landing. Its 11 crewmen had injuries in varying degrees of severity, caused either by the bullets sprayed by the two jet fighters, shrapnel or the fireball that erupted when the Neptune landed wheels up on the tundra of St. Lawrence Island and fuel tanks stored in the plane's belly exploded. "And as the plane decelerated, the fireball didn't. And it rolled forward. It burned everybody," the navigator on the flight, David Assard, told the Anchorage Daily News in 2015. Several of the men had severe burns. The men took refuge in a ditch on St. Lawrence Island — just 40 miles (64 kilometers) from Siberia and 715 miles (1,151 kilometers) west of Anchorage — to avoid the exploding ammunition and waited, but for what they weren't sure. When the armed Siberian Yupik Eskimo egg hunters showed up, the Navy men didn't know if they were about to be captured or rescued.

"Well, they were glad to see us and that we were Americans," Boolowon told The Associated Press. They were not only friendly faces but members of the First Scouts unit of the Alaska

National Guard who lived on the island and whose job it was to monitor the Soviet Union given their proximity. The 16 guardsmen and an unknown Air Force member helped the crew get medical attention and alerted military authorities the men were safe. On Tuesday, the guardsmen were honored with Alaska Heroism Medals, giving the Alaska Native men the recognition that wasn't available 67 years ago. Boolowon, then a corporal, is the sole survivor, and family members of the other 15 received the medals on their behalf.

Maj. Gen. Torrence Saxe, the adjutant general of the Alaska National Guard, not only approved the medals for the men, he personally handed them out at the ceremony held with a driving snow outside. Residents filled the gym at John Apangalook School in Gambell, home to the King Polar Bears — or Qughsatkut in Siberian Yupik— sports teams. Family members receiving medals sat in honored seats on the gym floor, and Saxe posed for photos with each after presenting the medals and a certificate. A community luncheon followed. "I'm glad we're going to get recognized a little bit for saving the crewmembers," Boolowon said. Shortly after the June 22, 1955, rescue, two of the guardsmen, MSgt. Willis Walunga and SSgt. Clifford Iknokinok, received honorific letters and certificates from the Navy and National Guard. They were taken to Washington, D.C., and presented "Wings of Gold" with the Honorary Naval Aviator Program designation. They were only the second and third persons so honored after the program started in 1949. The other 14 only received letters. "I don't know why they didn't include us," Boolowon said of the Navy designation.

There were no other medals available to the men for their deeds because it wasn't a combat mission, and the rescue was considered a peacetime affair. "The families felt like that the members should have received a better award than a letter of appreciation," said Verdie Bowen, the director of the state Office of Veterans Affairs. "The best one that we could find that fit this feat of valor was the state of Alaska's Heroism Award," he said. It honors Alaska National Guard members who distinguish themselves by heroism, meritorious achievement or going beyond the call of duty.
