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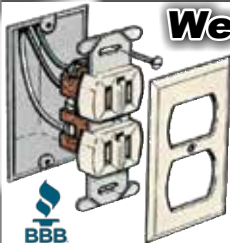

Clubhouse Pool SPA

There have been some major upgrades to the clubhouse and Pool/Spa. The electrical wiring and circuit panel have all been replaced. The 40+ year old electric was in great need of renovations. After seeing some warning signs, it seemed only wise for safety and insurance reasons to complete a major overhaul of the electric system. A special outlet with 220-volt service was installed on the North wall of the stage in the alcove area on the North side. We have also purchased an extension that will plug into that outlet with a system configured at the end to provide 110 volt service. This will provide higher amp service should there be a need along the front of the stage. See the clubhouse director if you need the extension for such a service.

A camera system has been installed both outside the clubhouse and inside. A separate camera is also installed at 116 Beechwood (BC Mart). This will provide a high-resolution camera surveillance of the common elements should there be a need for insurance or legal reasons.

Four new commercial grade hand-held microphones have been installed. The volume can be adjusted if necessary, however these new microphones have eliminated the static and interference. They also will sense voice without having to alter the manner in which the microphone is held. Be aware there are only 9 frequencies available by Federal Law without a license and we are using 4 of them. Therefore, if an outside microphone is used inside or near the clubhouse while our sound system is on, our system will pick up those signals and broadcast on our sound speakers. Entertainment Committee be aware when hiring entertainers.

Three Pool heaters have been installed to replace the original two Geothermal heaters. This newer state of the art heaters will meet the needs of the pool to maintain an even temperature of 84 degrees year-round. The heat units have a titanium core which, based on current engineering, has a lifetime warranty against wear. The previous system was struggling to meet these needs and often times resulted in the old heaters not being able to handle the load or fail. It eliminates the use of ground water from the aquifer used by the old heaters. A new heater was also installed for the SPA. As a reminder, there is an age restriction imposed by the Florida Health Department we have posted at the pool. As a public facility we must adhere to this age limitation or be subject to Health Department closure and possible revoking of our SPA license.

As many are aware there were some extreme delays between the permitting entities (City of Safety Harbor & Pinellas County) as well as some disastrous oversights by Duke Energy which delayed the complete for several months. Hopefully the discomfort and agony from that experience will fade in time. We owe a huge debt of gratitude to our neighbors and the board in Phase II for having the privilege to use their pool during this extended downtime. Also a Thank You to Ron Browne who came to our aide and made many calls and emails to so many agencies and political officials to help move along this process. His intervention was greatly



appreciated and his electrical background helped us decipher between fantasy (the correct PG-13 word plus I don't wish to offend any Bull's) and truth. Patience is a virtue and you have all been very virtuous. I don't look good in Tar & Feathers so Thank You for your tolerance.

The clubhouse, Pool and SPA have now entered into the 21st century and meet all 2023 codes.

FOBS

Last year the Board replaced the keys to the Clubhouse and Pool Area with FOBS that increase the safety of all residents of Briar Creek. Remember to bring your FOB with you when you are going to the Clubhouse or Pool. Do not assume that someone will be there and open the door or gate – this defeats the purpose of issuing FOBS for security.

CLUBHOUSE/POOL AREA

After use of the Clubhouse or Pool Area remember to do the following:

- Relock any doors you dogged in the open position
- Turn off lights
- Turn off any fans you used – also fans on back deck by the pool
- Return any items you used from the kitchen and, if needed, empty the trash

The moment has finally arrived!

The pool is up and running with computer-controlled temperature at (or near) 84 degrees, year-round. This is the ideal temperature recommended to be comfortable and not so warm to allow bacterial growth, algae and other unwanted life forms.

Sometimes, swimmers are heard remarking that our pool reminds them of a tropical resort in paradise. One of those features which creates that image is the trees. At times, rain and wind will deposit foliage in the pool. There are usually three nets resting around the perimeter of the pool. Almost every morning, you can see bugs floating (dead and alive) on the surface of the water. The nets are available for anyone to use to skim the bugs, leaves or any other floating items from the water. It is an easy task; instant gratification is the reward.

GUIDELINES FOR SPA

Briar Creek is a 55+ community where focus on safety and comfort of residents is priority while also adhering to respected guidelines.

- Spa temperature ranges from 102 – 104 degrees (maximum temp per CDC recommendation and CPSC *

- This is well above the safe temperature range for **kids under the age of 14/Small children:** Physiologically, children are incapable of producing enough sweat to cool their bodies down. *Some sources recommend that children under **five years old** should not be allowed in water over 95° Fahrenheit, and keeping kids out of a hot tub is a good idea in general. **

- Shower first
- Do not swallow spa or pool water
- Most reputable sites concur that adults avoid alcohol prior to entering hot tub
- No more than 15 – 30 minutes at 102 degrees
- Do not enter with open wounds or skin rash
- Do not enter if you have diarrhea

The purpose of this article is to remind residents that we have chosen to live in a community that is governed through our Incorporation Articles, Bylaws and Restrictions. For the most part, they are easy to follow, at other times, perhaps not so much. Regardless, the Documents are what they are and each of us should be familiar with how they work and affect how we live in BCII.

It's important to remember we are chartered under Florida Statute Chapter 718 as a "Condominium Community". Many people think of a condominium as a traditional tower like building. Increasingly, more mobile home parks are adopting this chartered approach. What this means is that many of the rules we must follow were not developed by Briar Creek. They were developed by federal, state or local legislators and enacted into law. Being a Condominium Community means BC is not legally comprised of single family homes nor are we chartered as a Home Owner's Association (HOA)". That is a different animal with a different set of state statutes and regulations. Often Condo and HOA laws and restrictions do not overlap and can be quite different.

It is also important for long-time and newer owners to remember that our Association, like other condo associations, must comply not just with our own legal documents, but that those documents must comply first with numerous legal requirements as well. As owners, we

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agree at the time of purchase to abide by and live within the boundaries of those documents. While some of the issues a Board must deal with may seem petty or unreasonable, they are often enforced to ensure compliance with outside regulatory requirements. When problems occur, such as non-compliance with an Alterations Forms request or failure to address Home Inspection deficiencies, they are noted and owners are informed and expected to correct them. Actions to address issues are taken, often behind the scenes, to protect the privacy and confidentiality of our friends and neighbors. One should not assume that just because they don't know what is happening to address an issue that the Board is not taking action. It's quite the opposite but unfortunately, sometimes corrective action takes longer than anticipated or anyone wants due to legal requirements outside a board's control.

Enforcing rules and restrictions can be very beneficial to our community. The many advantages of rule enforcement include protecting and enhancing home values, preserving the aesthetics of the area, community pride of ownership in BCII, maintaining common area property and that of its owners, and a reputation of compliance with federal, state, local requirements and the community's governing documents.

Living in a condominium community is not for everyone, and may not be for those that have come from areas where there were no zoning or property restrictions and now question, "what are all these rules?". Conversely, if one wants to own in a community like Briar Creek, seeking out and becoming familiar with its Documents, Bylaw and Restrictions prior to buying is critically important. That is one reason why prospective buyers are interviewed by Board Members in advance of the purchase to ensure they are aware of what is involved in living in BCII and what is expected once the closing occurs.

So, please, take time to become familiar with their contents, follow the rules and help us work together to continue making BCII a premier community in which to live.

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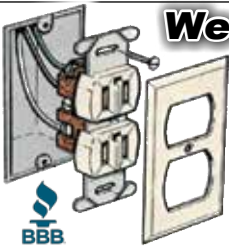

HAPPY FATHER'S DAY

Everyday Exercise

Exercise is like building a house. It all depends upon where you begin. For some it starts with a blue print and having a vision of the outcome. For some there is already a strong foundation to build upon. For some the house is there but it's remodeling time, and getting excited again. We all have a different starting point, but the key is to have everyday strategies for stretching and strengthening exercises, and making it simple. Remember also physical work is Not Exercise, nor is playing sports. Those are activities we do out of necessity or enjoyment. But the purity of Exercise is with the purpose to be able To Do those things for a long time.

STRATEGIES

1. Comfort Zone stretching. Each morning and evening gently take the time to consciously stretch various parts of your body. Think of a dog or cat waking up. They stretch to get the nerves and blood functioning. Do not overdo or do anything that is painful but find stretches that are comfortable.
2. Conscious Breathing. Remind yourself to breath deeply through your nose and out your mouth. Apply the breathing technique to your stretches as well as activities you do through the day.
3. Magic Jump Rope. This is not for everyone but for those who can pretend they have a jump rope and jumping rope twice a day for 30 seconds. Great news, no tripping over the invisible rope.
4. Stretchy Bands. These are inexpensive bands purchased at Target or Walmart. These bands can be used to stretch as well as strengthen all the muscles in our body. I take stretchy bands wherever I go, as well as use them when I am watching television. So easy and so simple and so effective.
5. Chi Gong. Like Tai Chi but simpler. Slow motion movements of the body with conscious breathing to enhance balance coordinating the nervous system. If you play tennis, pickle, or golf reenact those motions of that sport in slow motion. Powerful!
6. Modified push-ups and situps. You can gently stand and push against a wall back and forth. If you are sitting simply bend back and forth. Simple.
7. If you like to Dance have fun dancing to music at home. Especially fun while in the kitchen cooking.

Make Everyday exercise fun and in 30 days you will notice you feel younger, more energy, and inspired to do more. Blessings.

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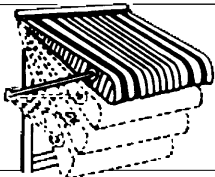
