

<u>https://www.emergencyprofile.org/</u> lets you create a personal profile so that when you call 911 for yourself, the info you have added is now visible to emergency operators. The 911 operators can find you by the information on this site. I built mine, and it took me 3 minutes. Now, granted, I don't have a lot of health issues but still. I logged in, entered my name and address, and gave emergency contacts. They ask for any allergies or medical problems you have. It's easy, it's free, and it just may save your life one day. They do not ask for your social security number or pertinent billing information. If someone does hack this account, the most they find out is that I have an allergy to sulfa-based items.
