

Subject: Monthly Activity Report: April 2023





ear Fellow Residents:

Board Issues:

- Dave Grant resigned from the board in early April. The board voted to offer the open position to Judy Flynn. Judy accepted. Her term will run until the next election in March 2024.
- Kathleen Broders is scheduled to replace Judy Flynn on the Social Committee, pending board approval.
- New buyer/seller packets are available in the office.
- Kathy McQuiston-O'Dell is initiating website upgrades.

Newsworthy:

- Some people have been fishing in Watkins pond. Please be aware that alligators are in the pond and could be a threat to people who fish in the pond. The park is not responsible for any injury caused by wildlife.
- The feeding of all wildlife in the lake and the pond is against Florida statutes.
- Vendors are not allowed to solicit in the park without board permission. Please notify a board member if you become aware of any unapproved solicitors.
- Property maintenance: There are some driveways that are in desperate need of repair. The shareholders will be notified in the upcoming weeks. As this may be a costly item to repair, the board is looking for an extended deadline for the residents to complete the repairs.
- Please note that all seasonal decorations should now be removed.

Maintenance:

- The hall floor was stripped and finished at a cost of \$2000. Since Andrew and Paul Burke did the work, the park saved several thousand dollars.
- The Library was repainted. The books will be moved back into the library in the next couple of months.
- The repair of the cupola will be delayed until the fall. This is intended to delay expenditures and wait for cooler weather.
- The pool temperature is set to 86 degrees and the spa is set to 102 degrees. These temperatures were determined after consulting several governmental agencies.
- A new pump was installed in the lift station. The cost was \$4800 and will be covered by reserves.



- A well pump was replaced at a cost of \$4200. This will be covered by reserves.
- The fire extinguishers in the hall were inspected and brought up to code. This is a yearly activity. The cost for this inspection exceeded the budget, \$900 vs \$650.
- Safety lights are needed in the card room. This is an unanticipated expense and required to meet the building code.
- The new metal columns outside the office will be installed in May.
- The Social Committee had a licensed electrician install a larger television in the hall.

Financial Status:

- Financial information for April is posted in the hall.
- Park expenses continue to exceed the budget. Inflationary increases are being felt in all areas of the park maintenance. The board is reducing expenses where possible including changing electric rates, using timers for lights, increasing the hall air conditioning temperature, and shutting down one refrigerator in the hall.

Wyatt Property: The court filing for the foreclosure of the share was submitted to the Pinellas County court. The court date is scheduled on or about 24 May. If the court rules in our favor, an online auction will be scheduled approximately 45 days later. The board, through our attorney, will submit an opening bid of \$15,000. The board will not submit any other bid for the share. The result of the auction will be either the park will take possession of the share with a bid of \$15,000 or a third party will take possession of the share. Tax liens will have to be paid by the winning bidder.

Water and Sewer Project: Pinellas County has appointed a new project manager. The new manager intends to send the board a draft of the easement in the next month. The board and our attorney will review the easement and respond accordingly to the new project manager. The county still intends to conduct a 30% design review on the sewer part of the project before mid-summer. The water portion of the project is delayed somewhat.

Board Meeting: A Board Meeting was held on 3 April 2023 in the hall. The minutes of this meeting were email blasted to the residents and posted in the hall. A schedule for board meetings will be announced by the end of May.



June 14th is Flag Day in the USA



On June 14, 1777, the Second Continental Congress took a break from writing the Articles of Confederation and passed a resolution stating that "the flag of the United States be 13 stripes, alternate red and white," and that "the union be 13 stars, white in a blue field, representing a new constellation." Over 100 years later, in 1916, President Woodrow Wilson marked the anniversary of that decree by officially establishing June 14 as Flag Day.

Canada has its own Flag Day celebrated on February 15 of each year. At the stroke of noon on February 15, 1965, Canada's red and white maple leaf flag was raised for the very first time on Parliament Hill. On the same day in 1996, National Flag of Canada Day was declared.

BOATS AND TRAILERS

The recent Rules and Regulation changes require all boats and trailers parked on LSR property or moored at the common area pier to have an LSR parking sticker, just like all motor vehicles. This requirement was added so that the boats and trailers on the property can be identified as LSR shareholder property. If you need a sticker for your boat or trailer, you can purchase them in the office for \$1 each.



PINELLAS COUNTY EMERGENCY NOTIFICATIONS

The Atlantic hurricane season begins June 1 and ends November 30 of each year. Historically in Florida, the most active time for hurricane development is mid-August through mid-October. Pinellas County Emergency Management offers a free emergency notifications service, called Alert Pinellas that will send an email and/or a text to you to let you know about imminent severe weather. You can sign up for emergency notifications at www. pinellascounty.org/AlertPinellas

You will need to establish a user name and a password for this site, but it is friendly and is easy to navigate. Both year-round residents and Snowbirds may sign up for this service. The site will not send out routine weather reports, but it will contact you when extreme weather is approaching our area. This includes tornado warnings, hurricane or tropical storm warnings, and any other weather event that may require residents to seek shelter or evacuate.



June 20-22 is the Summer Solstice

The Summer Solstice in the Northern Hemisphere occurs between June 20 and June 22. It is the longest day of the year that marks the start of the summer season. The solstice happens when the Earth arrives at the point where the North Pole is at its maximum tilt in relation to the sun.



This is why days are longer during the Summer Solstice. During the Summer Solstice, the sun rises north of east and sets in the northwest because it is at its northernmost point in the sky. The sun is visible in the sky longer than usual making the Summer Solstice the longest day of the year. In case you wondered, in the Southern Hemisphere, the summer solstice takes place on December 21 when the sun is at the farthest south.







Oh, my aching neck...

The neck is a pretty common place to experience pain. That's because your neck is the most mobile part of the spine — so injuries and painful conditions are more likely to occur there. If you are suffering from neck pain, you should see a health professional about it.



To prevent neck pain and injury, follow these tips:

- Maintain proper posture. Use a chair that is appropriate, stable and the right height. Use a table that is also the right height to avoid neck strain. Change your position periodically, so that exhaustion and pain will not occur. Avoid twisting your neck suddenly. When you are standing, maintain a relaxed neck, with your head upright and your chin retract—ed. You'll also want to get the right size pillow. A pillow should support your neck in a balanced position.
- Exercise your neck regularly to maintain and improve flexibility. Take a break from whatever you do during the day, about every half hour. Stretch your neck in different directions by looking up, down, to the right and to the left. Another good way to exercise this area is to raise and squeeze your shoulders together and then relax. Repeat this a few times.

- Get steamed. Make or order foods that are baked, grilled, poached or steamed, rather than fried.

- Get a doggie bag first. Before you dig in, scrape some of that mega-portion into a doggie bag.
- Mix it up. One of the healthiest ways to eat is to
