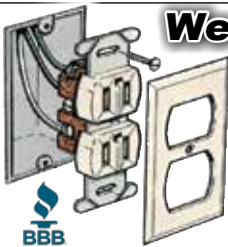

The June book choice is The Lincoln Highway by: Armor Towles. the following is summary of the story:

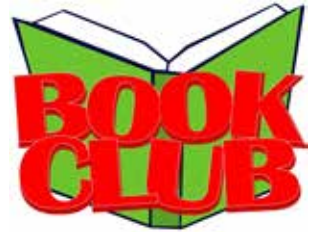

The ten sections comprise multiple chapters, titled with the name of the character whose experience is the primary focus of that chapter. With the exception of the chapters belonging to Duchess and Sally, which are written in first person, all other chapters are written in third person limited perspective. The sections of the novel begin with the heading of TEN, and progress in descending order through to the novel's conclusion.

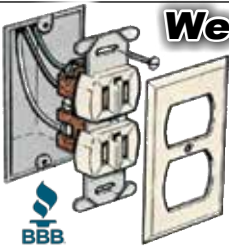

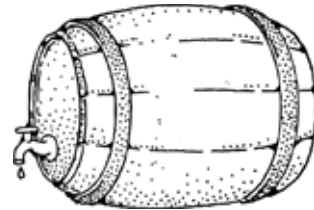
Someone in WW II asked if we could try to bring back our old "Help Out Your Neighbor" that used to be in the "Hi Lites."

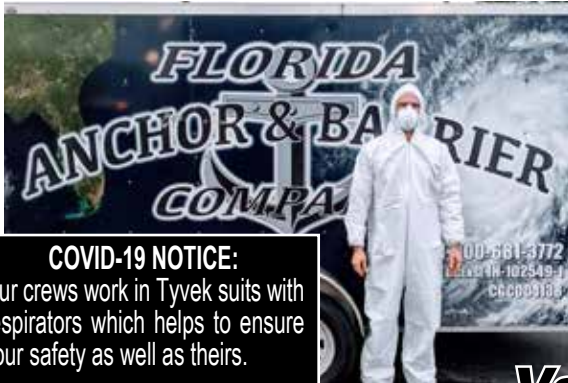

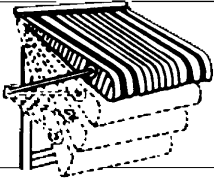
