FEDERAL HALF-STAFF HOLIDAYS

In case you were wondering why and when the United States flag flies at half-staff or at half-mast, it marks the time when the nation or a state is in mourning. The president, a state governor, or the mayor of the District of Columbia can order fags to fly at half-staff. Most often it marks the death of a government official, military member, or first responder. It can also mark a national tragedy or Memorial Day or another National Day of Remembrance. Here are the Federally designated dates and reasons:

May 7th, honors National Fallen Firefighters Memorial Services

May 15 is Peace Officers Memorial Day

May 29th the flag is flown at half-staff until noon in honor of Memorial Day

September 11th, is for Patriot Day

December 7th, is Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day

There are additional days the flag is flown at half-staff. President Joseph R. Biden, Jr. directed all flags to be lowered to half-staff on Thursday, May 11, 2023 as a mark of respect for the victims of the violence perpetrated on May 6, 2023, in Allen, Texas.
