That is June's focus, however, we are also looking at your entire lot. For those residents that responded and complied with the notices that were sent about home storage areas, thank you. HURRICANE SEASON

June 1st begins hurricane season. In case of evacuation, you need to know where you are going and have an emergency supply kit ready to take with you. For those who do not have a place to go, our closest shelter is Bauder Elementary School 12755 86th Ave. North, Seminole. If you have a pet the closest one to go to is Oak Grove Middle School 1370 South Belcher Rd. Clearwater. Remember the clubhouse is NOT an approved evacuation shelter. It is good to have a list ready for items that you would need if we needed to evacuate. Bring your park phone book with you in case you need to call a neighbor. You can visit pinellascounty.org to get a complete list of shelters in the area.

UPDATE ON DECK FURNITURE

PINELLAS COUNTY LEASH LAW

Is there a leash law in Pinellas County? Yes, the law states, "No dog or cat shall run at large within the county. Any person who possesses, harbors, keeps, or has control or custody of any dog or cat which is running at large shall be in violation, regardless of the knowledge, intent or culpability of the owner."

PETS

The rules for pets have not changed. We have a dog park on Robin Rd. and a pet section in the park. Please refer to your rules and regulations for information about dogs. While walking your dog, do not let him/her step on any lawn except your own and in the dog park. If you walk them to do their business in your own yard BEFORE you go for a walk, you will find that they will remember your area for that purpose.


ICE CREAM SOCIAL

SPINACH FRITTATA FOR TWO

1/4 pound fresh mushrooms, sliced2 Tbls finely chopped onion1 1/2 Tbls butter

4 eggs

■ 1/4 tsp seasoned salt

- | 1/2 cup chopped cooked spinach, well drained
 - 3 Tbls grated Parmesan cheese
- Parsley or red peppers optional

Saute mushrooms and onion in butter in an 8-inch ovenproof skillet over medium heat until tender, but not brown. Beat eggs and seasonings. Stir in drained spinach. Pour over mushrooms and onion. Cook over low to medium heat until eggs are set, about 5-7 minutes. Sprinkle with cheese. Broil about 6 inches from heat for 2-3 minutes. Cut in wedges to serve. Garnish with parsley and petters, if desired.
