- TVs, tires, and paint are not permitted in the trash and are therefore not accepted at the sanitation field.
- For televisions and home electronics, excluding anything with rechargeable batteries due to them being a fire hazard, you can take them to the landfill at 3095 114th Ave. N. You can also check with Best Buy and Home Depot to see if they are collecting them.
