BIRDS AND BLOOMS – WOOD STORK

owdy neighbors! We are well into summer here in Florida. This month is dedicated to the Wood Stork. Our only native stork in North America, a very large, heavy-billed bird that wades in the shallows of southern swamps. Flies with slow wingbeats, and flocks often soar very high on warm days. Young Wood Storks have



noisy begging calls, but adults are almost silent except for hissing and bill clappering. Florida populations have declined as water management here has become a more difficult problem. It eats a wide variety of fish, especially minnows, killifish, mullet. Also crayfish, crabs, aquatic insects, snakes, baby alligators, small turtles, frogs, rodents, some seeds and other plant material. I hope you have enjoyed reading about this bird! CLEANING TIP:

leaning your washing machine. With all the products we use to clean our clothes, detergent, softener, etc., your washing machine gets a build up of these ingredients. The easiest way to clean your machine is to run a cycle in hot water with a cup of bleach. Also, if you have a front load machine, you'll want to take out and clean the detergent cup (where you pour the detergent, softener, etc) and wash it separately. Once you've run a cycle with the bleach, make sure you run the rinse cycle again, to make sure all the bleach is gone. Also with a front loader, wipe the gasket around the door with a clean cloth.

RECIPE: CRAB CAKES

1 cup seasoned bread crumbs, divided

2 green onions, finely chopped

1/4 cup finely chopped sweet red pepper

1 large egg, lightly beaten

1/4 cup reduced-fat mayonnaise

1 tablespoon lemon juice

1/2 teaspoon garlic powder

1/8 teaspoon cayenne pepper

2 cans (6 ounces each) crabmeat, drained, flaked and cartilage removed

1 tablespoon butter

Directions

- 1. In a large bowl, combine 1/3 cup bread crumbs, green onions, red pepper, egg, mayonnaise, lemon juice, garlic powder and cayenne; fold in crab.
- 2. Place remaining bread crumbs in a shallow bowl. Divide crab mixture into 8 portions; shape into 2-in. balls. Gently coat with bread crumbs and shape into 1/2-in.-thick patties.
- 3. In a large nonstick skillet, heat butter over medium-high heat. Add crab cakes; cook until golden brown, 3-4 minutes on each side.

To help prevent crumbling, handle crab cakes with care while you're shaping and frying them. Also, be sure to measure the ingredients accurately to ensure that you're not skimping on the mayo or being too generous with the veggies—these things can also create a broken crab cake. If you're still having trouble, pop the crab mixture in the fridge for 20 minutes to let it set before shaping the crab cakes.





FLORIDA FISH AND WILDLIFE

'd like to highlight a different fish/wildlife species native to Florida each month. Please note that when this article mentions dolphin, they mean mahi mahi, and not flipper.

Baiting with Squid. Seriously, is there any offshore game fishing roaming our waters that won't readily eat a squid? Whether it's pelagic predators hunting the upper reaches of the water column or deep-water bottom dwellers, squid face predation from all angles. Anglers can catch a variety of different targets by simply heading offshore with a few boxes full of these slimy cephalopods. However, the tactics you choose to employ and the manner in which these baits are presented will have the greatest influence on the outcome of your efforts. Many seasoned salts will tell you that live bait is the name of the game in offshore fishing, particularly in southeast Florida where the seasonal sailfish action essentially requires live bait. Never discount the effectiveness of live bait, it's also important to consider the alternatives. The reality is that live bait is pricey when purchased and can be difficult for anglers to procure on their own. Dead bait, however, is easily purchased at a local tackle shop and while it's very different than a livewell full of frisky enticements, it's effective in its own right. When it comes to the many dead bait options lining the freezers of tackle shops statewide, squid is perhaps the most versatile offshore offering. Moreover, there are plenty of pursuits where live bait isn't even a viable option, yet dead squid excels. Take deep dropping, for example. Deep dropping may very well be the most popular use for squid across our fisheries. Many of the deep-water species anglers target, including grouper, snapper, tilefish and barrelfish, all keep squid in their regular diets, making it the first choice for anglers baiting their multi-hook rigs destined for the dark depths. Besides the fact that these fish naturally prey on squid, another advantage is that squid remains securely pinned to your hooks throughout the duration of each drop. Deep droppers know that few things are more frustrating than dropping down only to not have any bites because their baits came off on the way down. In addition to demersal game fish inhabiting the seafloor, pelagic predators rely on squid as a staple form of food. For example, when anglers head offshore in search of dolphin, squid is an important bait option to have on board. Live bait is still likely going to be your best bet when you encounter dolphin offshore, but a whole squid fished near the surface is a strong alternate when livies are unattainable. Additionally, you can pick off many dolphin cruising through stretches of open blue water by simply flat-lining a whole squid pinned to a 5/0 live bait hook on a light spinner while you deep drop. All of the deep drop grounds fished off the southeast Florida coast are in the Gulf Stream, situated among prime dolphin territory. Another venue and application where fresh squid continues to prove its worth is deep in the Gulf of Mexico. While anglers trust a variety of offerings on these trips from slow pitch and bucktail jigs to goggle eye, false albacore and ballyhoo, squid remains a top choice trip after trip. Both the demersal and pelagic predators frequently caught on these excursions feed regularly on squid, making it a logical addition to any bait cooler. On these trips where anglers



fish around the clock, it soon becomes evident why squid are such popular baits. Shortly after the sun sinks below the horizon and darkness sets in, the bright lights aboard the legendary head boat shine down toward the water's surface, attracting all sorts of marine organisms like moths to a porch lamp. Among them, squid are perhaps the most abundant as small flashes of pink and purple dart through the shadows. Here, the most resourceful anglers leave their frozen goggle eye and ballyhoo on ice and briefly swap their fishing rods with long nets to capitalize on the fresh bait below. Once they've procured a few squid, it's game on as the fresh baits tend to out-fish anything else on board. Additionally, some anglers save their fresh caught bait for daylight hours and deeper venues, where trophy queen snapper, snowy grouper and more will surely pounce on a properly presented squid. Lure manufacturers across the industry continue to innovate and create lifelike fakes that accurately mimic a variety of forage species, including squid. Among the dizzying array of options available, Savage Gear's (savagegear-americas. com) 3D Swim Squid is perhaps the closest thing to the real deal. Based on the scan of a real squid, the 3D Swim Squid can be rigged to swim forward or backward and comes in a variety of colors and sizes. Bait is one of the most important factors in any fishery. It can be extremely difficult not only to acquire the right bait for your specific pursuits, but also fish it correctly and coerce your targets into committing to your offerings. However, armed with the knowledge that there really aren't many offshore predators that won't eat a squid, anglers should always keep a box or two on board.

THE DON CESAR HOTEL - ST PETE BEACH

he Don CeSar is a hotel located in St. Pete Beach, Florida. Developed by Thomas Rowe and opened in 1928, it gained renown as the Gulf playground for America's pampered rich at the height of the Jazz Age. The hotel was designed by Henry H. Dupont. The Don CeSar is a member of Historic Hotels of America, the official program



of the National Trust for Historic Preservation. In 1924, Thomas Rowe purchased 80 acres of land in St. Petersburg, Florida for \$100,000 to begin his dream of building a "pink castle". He hired architect Henry Dupont to design the hotel and Carlton Beard as contractor. To ensure the stability of the hotel on the shifting sand and avoid the high cost of sinking so many pilings, Beard devised a floating concrete pad and pyramid footings. To this day, there is no sign of evident settling of the hotel. The architecture is a blend of Mediterranean and Moorish styles modeled after different hotels and developments that Rowe and Beard saw in Palm Beach, Coral Gables and Boca Raton. Arched openings, red clay tile roofs, balconies, stucco over hollow tile and tower like upper stories were some of the elements that they borrowed. The original design called for a \$450,000 six-story hotel with 110 rooms and baths. It was expanded to 220



rooms and 220 baths, and the costs soared to \$1.25 million, 300% over budget. Rowe named it Don Cesar after Don César de Bazan, the hero of William Vincent Wallace's opera Maritana. Rowe's "Pink Lady" opened on January 16, 1928, with an extravagant party attended by the elite of Tampa, Florida and St. Petersburg, Florida. The hotel quickly became a favorite romping ground for the rich and famous of the Jazz Age including F. Scott Fitzgerald, Clarence Darrow, Al Capone, Lou Gehrig, and Franklin D. Roosevelt. The Pink Palace continued to attract the rich and famous throughout the Great Depression in part to a deal made with New York Yankees owner Jacob Ruppert to house his team during spring training for three years. However, after the sudden death of Rowe without a will, The Don was left to his estranged wife and began to fall into disrepair until the United States entered into World War II, and the hotel was bought by the Army for \$450,000. It was converted into a military hospital and reopened in December 1942. In February 1944, the Don Cesar became a convalescent center for the United States Army Air Corps. In June 1945, the Don Cesar was ordered closed and was vacant by September 1945. It was converted into a Veterans Administration Regional Office by the end of 1945. In November 1967, the Veterans Administration began moving out of the Don Cesar, having opened a new office in downtown St. Petersburg. By Spring 1969, the once grand hotel was vacant. The General Services Administration planned to raze the graffiti-covered hotel, but this plan was met with fierce opposition from local residents. In March 1972, the Don Cesar was sold to C.L. Pyatt and William Bowman Jr., a franchise owner of Holiday Inn. The Don CeSar reopened on November 23, 1973. Multiple renovations from 1985 to 2001 have updated and added to the hotel, including a 4,000-square-foot spa, a signature restaurant, and a second outdoor swimming pool. After the addition of the full-service beach club and spa, the official name of the hotel was changed to The Don CeSar Beach Resort and Spa. The Don CeSar was named to the National Register of Historic Places in 1975 and became a founding member of the National Trust Historic Hotels of America in 1989.

CLIMBING THE ROPE – DICK POPE JR.

Then Dick Pope Jr.'s mother got him out of school early one day back in 1942 to help put on a ski show for some servicemen, little did either of them realize that he would be embarking on a career that would keep him in a leadership role in the sport of water skiing for over 40 years. That wartime experience when Pope was 12 years old took place at Cypress Gardens, a struggling Florida attraction which he was destined to direct as president 20 years later. Pope made his mark early in water ski competition, winning national overall titles four straight years, beginning in 1947, and capturing the 1950 world overall championship in the second world tournament ever held. 1st in slalom, 5th tricks and 2nd in jumping. Pope had competed in the first one, at Juan les Pins, France, the year before. He had a good chance to win slalom and jumping but, in his youthful determination to go all out, he lost the titles

to more conservative Europeans. All the while skiing in the Cypress Gardens shows which were gaining national recognition, Pope introduced a starling routine in 1947 when he succeeded in skiing on his bare feet, an accomplishment that was quickly picked up by the newsreels and print media. Pope was one of the earlier slalom skiers to "graduate" from two skis to one, realizing the advantages of the single ski in high-speed runs. He also was one of the "daring" American jumpers who used the maneuver of "climbing the rope" for added distance until the practice was outlawed as too dangerous. Although he liked slalom and jumping better than tricks, he perfected several ramp tricks and introduced the 540 turn on the rap in 1952 in his last tournament before joining the Marine Corps. Returning



from the service, he accompanied the U.S. Water Ski Team to Beirut, Lebanon, in 1955 as its manager. When the World championship returned to Cypress Gardens in 1957, he was president of the World Water Ski Union but he spent much of his time coordinating the tournament action for the CBS television cameras. The network televised the Sunday finals live after weather problem knocked out the scheduled airing of the tournament on Saturday. Pope continued his show skiing and he was frequently pictured giving skiing tips to such dignitaries as the Shah of Iran and other newsworthy figures including the annual Miss Americas. In 1956, Pope became involved in manufacturing the tools of the sport, investing in Tourney Skis, a company located in nearby Lakeland. He later bought out his partner, moved the company to Eloise, just south of Cypress Gardens, changed the name of the Skis, and began producing a diversified line of tournament and family skiing equipment that set the pace for the industry for many years. Pope succeeded his father as president of Cypress Gardens in 1962, took the company public 10 years later, and was elected chairman of the board in 1982 before the attraction was sold to Harcourt Brace Jovanovich, Inc.

FLORIDA SNAKES

hen most people think of venomous snakes, they think of species that have the capability of inflicting severe pain or death to those unfortunate enough to be bitten. In Florida, we have six such species: the Harlequin Coralsnake, the Eastern Copperhead, the Florida Cottonmouth, the Pygmy Rattlesnake, the Timber Rattlesnake, and the Eastern Diamond-



backed Rattlesnake. In this usage, the distinction between venomous and non-venomous snakes has a practical benefit relating to safety of people and pets. Technically speaking, however, the distinction between what snakes are venomous and non-venomous is more complicated. This is



because many snake species that are normally considered "non-venomous", in the sense that a bite would likely not do serious harm to a human, do actually produce some venom. Examples of these species include Ring-necked snakes, Common Gartersnakes, Crowned snakes, and Hog-nosed snakes. Most people are unaware of this for several reasons. First, the venom is extremely weak and produced in tiny amounts, so they may only be capable of relaxing small prey items such as centipedes, earthworms, or toads. Second, many of these snake species never or only rarely bite people, even in self defense. Third, the production of these venoms is likely stimulated only by the presence of prey. Therefore, although these snake species do produce venom, they pose no danger to people or pets. On rare occasions, bites from these species can produce localized swelling and discomfort in some people.

HISTORY OF JOHN'S PASS – MADEIRA BEACH FL

Tohn's Pass is a popular tourist destination located in Treasure Island, Florida. It has a rich history dating back to the mid-1800s when it was named after John Levique, a French immigrant and local fisherman who discovered the area while searching for a new fishing spot. 
