PORK & HEESY ONION CREAM: (German Recipe)

4 Pork cutlets salt & pepper to taste 3 TBS unsalted butter. 3 onions peeled & cut into rings 1 C. heavy Cream ³/₄ C. sour cream. 1 C. white wine ¹/₂ C. vegetable stock 2 clove garlic chopped. 2 TBS chopped parsley 3TBSchopped chives 1 tsp. chopped fresh thyme. 1 tsp chopped fresh oregano 8 oz. grated gouda cheese.



Preheat oven to 400°, season chops on both sides, Heat butter in a pan & fry cutlets on both sides. Transfer to covered 2.5 Qt Casserole to keep warm. Sauté onions and add them to casserole dish, In a separate bowl, whisk together cream, sour cream, wine, and stock. Add chopped garlic and mix in spices. Pour sauce over pork and sprinkle with cheese. Place in oven and bake for 20 minutes - remove and serve

VETERAN'S CORNER

6 G H asked by those who once served in the military. Many businesses offer discounts to Veterans for restaurants,



hotels, stores, recreational activities and even home improvement, among other perks. Former service members will want to take advantage of those opportunities.

First, you'll want to apply for VA's Veteran ID Card (VIC), which is a digital photo ID you can use to get those discounts. Since September 2022, all new Veteran ID cards have been digital. A Veteran with a physical ID card can continue using it to get discounts. The VIC is separate from the VA health care ID, which a Veteran receives when enrolling in VA health care. If you have any questions or need help, email VA's VIC program at vetidcard@va.gov.

Login using your existing Login.gov, ID.me, DS Logon or MyHealtheVet account. A Veteran without any of these accounts can create a free Login.gov or ID.me account. If you are unable to submit your VIC application through VA.gov, please use Access VA. When applying, make sure to have your social security number; a digital copy of your DD214, DD256, DD257 or NGB22 that you can upload; and a copy of a current and valid government-issued ID, such as a driver's license, passport or state-issued identification card.

You'll also need a digital color photo of yourself from the shoulders up. The photo should follow all of these standards:

- Show a full, front view of your face and neck with no hat, head covering or headphones covering or casting shadows on your hairline or face.
- Be cropped from your shoulders up much like a passport photo.
- Show you with your eyes open and in a neutral expression.
- Be taken in clothing you'd wear for a driver's license photo.
- Be a square size and have a white or plain-color background with no scenery or other people in the photo.
- Show what you look like now, meaning a photo that is no older than 10 years old; it should be uploaded as a .jpeg, .png, .bmp or .tiff file.

A Veteran must meet certain criteria to be eligible for a VIC, including both of these requirements:

- Service on active duty, in the Reserve or in the National Guard, including the Coast Guard.
- Receipt of an honorable or general discharge under honorable conditions.

If the Veteran received an other-than honorable, bad conduct or dishonorable character of discharge, that person is not eligible for a Veteran ID card. If a Veteran has an uncharacterized or unknown discharge status, VA must verify that person's eligibility before approving an application. The Veteran must provide a copy of his/her discharge papers when applying for a VIC to prove their character of discharge. After a Veteran applies for a VIC, VA will check that



person's eligibility and verify that the character of discharge meets eligibility requirements, the ID submitted is valid and the image chosen to appear on the card meets photo requirements.

VA will then send an email letting the Veteran know the status of the application. If the Veteran has an unknown or uncharacterized discharge status, the application will take more time to process. VA may need to request your records from the National Personnel Records Center, part of the National Archives and Records Administration. If a Veteran receives an email from VA asking for additional information or evidence to process the application, that person must sign in to AccessVA and update the application. VA will send an email with the digital card attached if a Veteran is eligible for a Veteran ID Card.

ery soon the 2023 hurricane and severe storm season will begin. Ending a bit longer in the fall than before. Ignoring either will not make this yearly weather go away or consequences either. The Atlantic hurricane season

usually runs from June 1st through November 30th. Most find their roots in West Africa in late August through September. For year-rounders like me (there are more now in the park) this is our storm and wet season. We want the rain though not always how it finds us.

Without being specific to any chronic condition let us say that you must have certain medications, oxygen, nursing services, dialysis, just had major surgery, batteries for equipment vital to your survival that require replenishment within 14 days. Why 14 days? In a major weather event or disaster, the supply of what you absolutely need to live isn't around the corner anymore, plus the supply lines to vendors, pharmacies, hospitals, clinics, home health can be threatened. They just do not carry extra inventory on the shelves. We live in a new supply world where large expensive reserves of everything are no longer close to us. Vital medical supply chains are further controlled by our economic issues. Dependence on USPS, UPS and FedEx is pervasive and not always responsive. We are fortunate in we live in a location where supplies most seniors need is more plentiful but not endless. Being a global economy, our medical supplies still and

often come from outside the U.S! Especially generics.

As an RN in Florida's Disaster response team, we start with preparing TODAY! Preparing is not as hard as we think. Take it one step at a time. Starting now means you will not rush and forget something vital.


The first is life sustaining equipment. Oxygen and the equipment required to deliver is #1. Find an invoice from the vendor who brings the oxygen and maintains the devices. Put the invoice in an envelope that you will fill in with other information. Take a picture with your phone too. If you have large oxygen canisters, they will be hard to transport. Oxygen concentrators can be heavy though newer versions are much lighter. You cannot expect every shelter will have unlimited oxygen available. If any. Always register early with the shelters. Also shelters may not have consistent electricity to power equipment. If your equipment has rechargeable batteries, then keep them charged! The Pinellas County Disaster management can help you know where the best shelters are for you! Staying at home may not be an option and can be deadly. Mandatory evacuations mean emergency services have shutdown. The police will drive through our park numerous times and tell us still here that we are now on our own. Do not die in your coach.

The second is medications. If you do not have a current list of your medications, then you can write down your own or better have your pharmacy print your list. Medication organizers are necessary to have. Also reminds me what day it is! However, the downside is that someone else has no idea what each pill is. Believe me. So, keep at least one pill in their original container from the pharmacy. Do not ever wait until the last minute to have your medications, including syringes refilled. Remember, shelters do not have pharmacies and getting vital medications in a disaster can be exceedingly difficult if not impossible. Get a plastic container with a locking lid to store all your medications. Put your full name on the container. Got a pet on meds? Do the same! More pets are diabetic now than ever.

Often liquid medications require refrigeration. Often, they come in a Styrofoam container. Keep one, always! Do not toss the frozen ice bag either. Get ready and start today. Help a neighbor get ready too. We are a community.


