Lastly: All prospective Residents or persons wanting to live with a Resident must have background checks run and Doral Board approval.

From the Hurricane Preparedness Committee

s I write this; hurricane season has been going on for a few days but when you read this it will have been ongoing for about a month. That means it's time to KNOW what you will do if Doral is evacuated. REMEMBER; if Pinellas County declares an Evacuation, mobile home parks such as Doral are first on the list. NO structure in Doral Village is rated as a shelter.During an evacuation, please remember to deposit the evacuation form (available at the office if you need one) in the Evacuation mailboxes at each exit.One of the last

board members/employees will shut off the main water valve on their way out. YOU need to shut off your water valve before you depart and turn off your Water Heater as well.

You should plan now for your actions during an evacuation:

- 1. Are you planning on going to a hotel or maybe to a friend/relative outside the evacuation zone? It is recommended that especially for those that rely on electricity for oxygen or perhaps are temperature sensitive, or require elevators in a hotel follow the weather reports to observe the "cone of the hurricane" and plan accordingly.
- 2. If you plan on staying home (NOT recommended!); remember that you will have NO water flowing and if you have an emergency it is likely that Emergency personnel will not respond until the hurricane event is over.
- 3. When you are choosing hotels you should pick one that is unlikely to be in the 'cone'. Residents have reserved rooms at hotels and could not check in due to evacuation while others have checked in and then the hotel lost all electricity.
