

Constitution and Bylaws of the Hillcrest Social Club

Adopted by amendment 1999

Revised 2008 Revised 2015

ARTICLE I: NAME. The name of this club shall be HILLCREST SOCIAL CLUB.

ARTICLE II: OBJECT. The object of this club shall be to create harmonious relationships and conduct social activities for the best interest of the members and for the residents of the park.

ARTICLE III: MEMBERSHIP. All residents of the park shall be eligible for membership and must have kept their dues current.

ARTICLE IV: OFFICERS.

Section I. The officers of this club shall consist of a President, 1st Vice President, 2nd vice President, Secretary and Treasurer. The newly elected officers shall assume office on January 1. Their terms will be for two (2) years. (For the first election reflecting this change, the President, 2nd Vice President & treasurer will be elected for 2 years, the 1st Vice President & secretary for 1 year. (The following year 1st vice President & Secretary will be elected to a two (2) year term, ensuring veteran officers always on board.)

The nominating committee report on nominations will be presented at the January meeting. Then accept nominations from the floor, with elections immediately following. Newly elected officers will assume their duties following the election.

Section II. These officers, together with the immediate past President, shall constitute the Executive board, and shall serve until their term expires. The immediate past President shall serve in an advisory capacity only, without voting power.

Article V: MEETINGS

Section I. Meetings shall be held monthly, preferably in the first week of the month during the active season, unless that propose: day is in the first week of January, then it shall be held in the second week. If there is a valid reason to hold a meeting at another time, the Executive Board shall decide upon an alternate meeting day and must notify the membership as soon as possible.

Section II. Executive Board meetings when needed shall be held at some time prior to the stated club meeting.

Section III. Special meetings of the club maybe called at the discretion of the President or a majority of the Executive Board, or by a petition signed by twenty (20) or more members of the club.

Article II - Directors

Section 1. Functions. All corporation powers shall be exercised by or under the authority of the Board of Directors. The business and affairs of the corporations shall be managed under the Directors of the Board of Directors.

Section 2. Qualifications of Direction. Each Director shall be a member in the Corporation. Directors shall be non-paid volunteers. The word "Board» as used herein includes all Officers and Directors of Hillcrest Residents. Inc.

Section 3. Duties of Directors: The Directors shall have a Fiduciary Relationship to the Corporation. A Director shall perform his or her duties as a Director, including his or her duties as a member of any committee of the board upon which he or she may . serve, in good faith, in a manner he or she reasonably believes to be in the best interest of the Corporation and with such care as an ordinarily prudent person in a like position would use under similar circumstances.

Section 4. Number of Directors. The number of Directors shall be not less than five (5) seven (7). The number of Directors may be increased or decreased by Bylaw amendments adopted by the Directors and approved by the members.

Section 5. Nominations.

- (a) It shall be the duty of the Board of Directors, at their regular October meeting to appoint a Nominating Committee consisting of one Director appointed by the President to act as an advisor, plus a minimum of two (2) members in good standing.
- (b) The Nominating Committee shall report their slate of nominees to the board at the November Board Meeting. The slate shall consist of two or more nominees for each vacancy to be filled. Under extreme circumstances, which must be documented, one (1) nominee may be provided for the slate for each vacancy.
- (c) Nominations will also be accepted from the floor at this meeting at the annual meeting, when made by any qualified member of the Corporation. The nominee must indicate he or she is will to serve as a member of the Board.

Section 6. Terms of Office.

The terms of office for Directors shall be two (2) years. The terms of office shall be staggered so the entire Board is not up for re election at the same time.

Article III - Election of Board of Directors

Section 1. At the December Meeting **Annual Meeting**, the Board of Directors shall appoint, from the members in good standing, a chairperson for the Election Committee and at least two (2) additional members.

- (a) Election Day shall be the last Monday in January of each year at the annual meeting. Notice of the date, time and place shall be given by the President or Secretary. Such notice shall be in writing to each member at his or her Clearwater, Florida address, as it is on the books of the Corporation and shall be mailed, or hand delivered, not less than fourteen (14) days nor more than thirty (30) days prior to the date of the election. Proof of such mailing shall be given by the affidavit of the person giving the notice. Mailing need not be by certified mail. Notice shall also be posted in a conspicuous place on the Corporation bulletin board in the Recreation Center, fourteen (14) days prior to the election day.
- (b) When voting for the election of Board of Directors, current owners shall be entitled to cast one vote and must present their membership card. Such membership card was issued, one per lot, when their membership fee was paid. Each person voting being entitled to cast his or her vote for each of as many nominees as there are vacancies to be filled. All members must be in good standing with current dues paid.
 - (c) Hours for the voting will be listed on the call of the meeting notice.



Famous people who refused to be failures

The 've all heard the stories of famous people who had rough or bumpy starts. Here's a few for the record:

- Lucille Ball: She began studying to be an actress in 1927 and was told by the head instructor of the John Murray Anderson Drama School, "Try any other profession. Any other."
- Clint Eastwood and Burt Reynolds: In 1959, a Universal Pictures executive dismissed them at the same meeting with the following statements. To Burt Reynolds: "You have no talent." To Clint Eastwood: "You have a chip on your tooth, your Adam's apple sticks out too far and you talk too slow."
- Marilyn Monroe (Norma Jean Baker): In 1944, Emmeline Snively, director of the Blue Book Modeling Agency, told modeling hopeful Norma Jean, "You'd better learn secretarial work or else get married."
- Elvis Presley: In 1954, Jimmy Denny, manager of the Grand Ole Opry, fired Elvis after one performance. He told Presley, "You ain't goin' nowhere son. You ought to go back to drivin' a truck."
- Alexander Graham Bell: When he invented the telephone in 1876, it did not ring off the hook with calls from potential backers. After making a demonstration call, President Rutherford Hayes said, "That's an amazing invention, but who would ever want to use one of them?"
- Thomas Edison: He was one of the greatest inventors in American history. When he first attended school in Port Huron, Mich., his teachers complained that he was "too slow" and hard to handle. As a result, Edison's mother decided to take her son out of school and teach him at home. In his lifetime, Edison produced more than 1,300 inventions.
- Franklin D. Roosevelt: Paralyzed by polio at 39, he went on to become one of America's most beloved and influential leaders. He was elected president of the United States four times.
- Julia Child: In 1953, she and her two collaborators signed a publishing contract to produce a book tentatively titled French Cooking for the American Kitchen. Julia and her colleagues worked on the book for five years. The publisher rejected the 850 page manuscript. Child and her partners worked for another year totally revising the manuscript. Again the publisher rejected it. But Julia Child did not give up. She and her collaborators went back to work again, found a new publisher, and in 1961—eight years after beginning—they published Mastering the Art of French Cooking, which has sold more than 1 million copies.
- **Douglas MacArthur:** He might never have gained power and fame without persistence. When he applied for admission to West Point, he was turned down, not once, but twice. But he tried a third time, was accepted and marched into the history books.
- **Abraham Lincoln:** He entered the Blackhawk War as a captain. By the end of the war, he had been demoted to the rank of private.





The anti-cancer lowdown on herbs and spices

any spices and herbs are believed to be imbued with health-building properties and have anti-cancer effects. Herbs and spices are believed to be full of antioxidants, which prevent the damage that free radicals can do to cells.

The National Cancer Institute has identified the following herbs and spices as having cancer-preventing properties: tarragon, cumin, coriander, anise, caraway, turmeric, fennel, rosemary, thyme, oregano and sage. Some of these; caraway, tarragon, fennel and cumin; may also prevent tumor growth, and they are believed to reduce cholesterol levels. Coriander, it is believed, is effective in combating carcinogens. Turmeric contains curcumin, which gives it a yellow color, and has been shown to protect mice against Alzheimer's. Saffron and paprika are believed to stimulate immunity. Cloves and nutmeg are believed to fight bacteria, and chili peppers and ginger might help prevent tumor formation. Cinnamon could be a possible treatment for diabetes in the future. One to two teaspoons were found to lower blood sugar and prevent insulin spikes. —adapted from the U.C. Berkeley Wellness Letter
