### **MANAGER'S CORNER**

### **HOME MAINTENANCE**

July is known for high winds, heavy rain, and strong storms. Make sure your gutters are free of debris and around your home is clear of anything that can be blown away or possibly damage homes. If you have awnings or shutters, please inspect them to make sure they are secure. Of course, we are also looking at your entire lot. For those residents that responded and complied with the notices that were sent about home storage areas, thank you. A special thank you goes out to those that we didn't have to send a notice to in the last few months. We appreciate you all keeping Sugar Creek looking fabulous.

### LITTERING

We have been noticing some residents are throwing cigarette butts in the drains, on residents' grass and gardens as well as on the street. Be courteous and respectful and refrain from dropping or throwing garbage anywhere but the appropriate spot, which is your trash. We take pride in our park, and we would hope all who live here do too.

### **RAINY SEASON**

When it rains hard, at times the streets will flood until it slows down to drain, be aware of the extra water in the streets after the heavy rain. Do not speed through the water, it can damage your vehicle, and it goes up residents' carports like waves.

### **SMOKING**

We have a designated smoking table at the pool area. Please leave this table area open for the residents that smoke. We have designated non-smoking areas also. There are signs posted for both areas. No smoking on the back deck or near the

clubhouse doors. If you are attending a function and smoking outside of the west side of the clubhouse, please smoke far enough away that it doesn't come into the clubhouse.

### **POOL AND SPA**

Sugar Creek Rules and Regulations: Page 5, # 2 states: (Please do not wear suntan oils while in the pool as they contaminate the water and stain the pool). The rules for the pool area are posted on the pool house, please familiarize yourself with these rules. When the pool/spa is contaminated with these lotions and oils, we must close the pool and or spa.






