Cape Cod Massachusetts

Tell, here we are on Cape Cod Massachusetts, 4 community families live on Cape Cod, for the summer.

Cape Cod has 15 Towns and is located to the Eastern Part of Massachusetts. There are 3 bridges that lead to the Cape. All three bridges are in the Town of Bourne, which was settled in 1640, which is the first town you cross into if taking one of the bridges, The Three Bridges are:

The Railroad Bridge, Bourne Bridge and Sagamore Bridge. The Town of Bourne has 9 villages: Bourne Village, Buzzards Bay, Cataumet, Monument Beach, Pocasset, Sagamore, Sagamore Beach, Gray Gables and Bournedale. Bourne received its name from the political figure, Johnathan and Richard Bourne, President Grover Cleveland had a summer place at Gray Gables, from 1893 to 1896 it was destroyed by fire in 1973.

Bourne is also the home of the Aptucxet Trading Post the nation's oldest store. It was founded by the Pilgrims in 1627, at a site halfway between two rivers, which divide the cape from the rest of the state, it was out of this location that the Cape Cod Canal was formed which was the first trading post between the Dutch and the Wampanoag Native Americans. The Cape Cod Canal a man-made water way, separates the town of Bourne, so no matter which side you live on, it's considered "Entering Cape Cod". The Massachusetts Maritime Academy is also located in Bourne on the canal.

Next month we will look at another Cape Cod Town. Till then Enjoy the summer.



Living with Gout

out is a common and painful type of arthritis (swelling in one or more of your joints). It usually first appears in a big toe or lower limb. But other joints can be affected. Most types of gout are treatable, especially if caught early. Gout is more common in men. It tends to first arise for them in middle age. Women usually

develop gout only after menopause.

Flares of gout often start suddenly at night, with intense pain that may wake you up. Usually, just one joint is affected. It may feel swollen, red, warm, and stiff. Flares usually get better within a couple of weeks.

If left untreated, flares can begin to arise more often and last longer. They may be triggered by certain foods, alcohol, some medications, or illnesses.

Treatment plans are based on symptoms and the cause of your gout. Over-the-counter and prescription medications may help reduce pain and swelling during flares.

Lifestyle changes can also help you manage gout and reduce flares. Eating a heart-healthy diet can help. Also, avoid alcohol, red meats, and seafood to reduce the chance of gout flares. Losing excess weight may help minimize the number of flares you have. Learn more about gout at www.niams.nih.gov/health-topics/gout.

redit reporting company Experian warns that scammers utilize bots — automated programs — to deceive people into sharing the two-factor authentication codes sent to them via text or email from financial institutions (or from companies such as Amazon). The bot will make a robocall or send a text that appears to come from a bank, asking you to authorize a charge, then it asks you to enter the authentication code you've just been sent if the transaction isn't yours. It's actually the bot that's trying to log into your bank account, and it wants the code that the bank sent to you as a precaution, so it can get in.

How to stay safe: Never share authentication codes, or provide other information, in response to an unsolicited phone call or text.




