ne of the things that attracted us to our house was the front porch. We have a corner lot so the view is more open and it faces north so we are usually in the shade. It's ideal for morning coffee, reading, relaxing, Happy Hour and the most fun is visiting with other residents as they pass by.

It's hard to see from the photos, but many of the deck tiles were loose or cracked and the floor flexed as you moved around. The railings were old painted steel that were starting to rust out, and out of style as were the tiles. Time for a change.

Before construction started, we removed all the front bushes and filled that raised area with crushed white marble. Got rid of the 2 big stones and whatever that green thing was growing between them and continued removing a bunch of stuff along the long street side and added crushed white marble there.



The next 2 photos show the new deck and some of the landscaping.

Glen Carson and his crew took over and demoed the railings, deck and a somewhat suspect supporting structure and then rebuilt it with treated wood and a 4 elephant weight rating. **Rich Gaughan** was found wandering along 3rd Street, so we recruited him to lay the tile on the deck. It's a little hard to see on the photo below, but the tile is a weathered beachy gray, plank style. The last photo in the article with **Renee** on the deck shows it a little better. **Rich** did a great job on the tile!

The next 3 photos show the final product.

Glen, mastermind extraordinaire, sobered up his crew and completed the job with skirting and a white vinyl railing to set it off.

Everyone involved contributed to a fantastic project!!! We can't thank you enough!






