



Te started our trip with a short flight from Ottawa to Toronto on May 24. After a short layover, we flew from Toronto to Zurich, Switzerland. From Zurich, we had a short flight to Prague, Czech Republic. At the baggage claim, we came to realize that we were missing one piece of luggage! Paula had placed an Apple Air tag in each suitcase, so we were able to see that the suitcase was still sitting in the Toronto Airport. Thankfully, we had packed half and half in each suitcase, plus a change of clothing in our carry ons!

We spent 3 wonderful days in Prague! What a beautiful city full of history and wonderful sights. We certainly enjoyed the Czech beer and wine, and one evening enjoyed a traditional Czech dinner of duck, with dumplings and sauerkraut! We had a lot of free time, and we sure did a lot of exploring. We quite enjoyed visiting The Dancing House and enjoying a lovely cocktail, while we took in the views on the observation deck! After a lovely afternoon at a wine tasting, we hopped on the transit and headed back to our hotel, only to find that our suitcase had arrived. On to Krems, where we toured the 900-year-old Gotweig Abbey. Vienna was our next stop. While on a walking tour in Vienna, we watched a military parade only to find out that the Austrian President was about to arrive. He was to greet the Czech President who was coming for a meeting. We were only about 25 feet from the President. Even our guide was excited! That evening we attended a "private Viennese Concert, which we BOTH enjoyed!!

The next port was Bratislava, Slovakia. Another great guide took us on a tour of the city. A little later that day, we went on another wine tasting tour. We visited a private vineyard and then did some sampling at two venues.





Our final port was the beautiful city of Budapest, Hungary! How we wished we could have visited the city for another day or two. A guided tour through the city was lovely but we were sure it just showed a fraction of what Budapest has to offer. In the evening, after dinner, we enjoyed traditional Hungarian entertainment. Just when we were thinking our cruise was ending, the captain took us on an evening cruise to view the awesome sights of Budapest at night. The Hungarian Parliament buildings were spectacular!

We started our journey home the next day, and after being up for 24 hours, we arrived home at 11:30pm



Famous people who refused to be failures

The 've all heard the stories of famous people who had rough or bumpy starts. Here's a few for the record:

- Lucille Ball: She began studying to be an actress in 1927 and was told by the head instructor of the John Murray Anderson Drama School, "Try any other profession. Any other."
- Clint Eastwood and Burt Reynolds: In 1959, a Universal Pictures executive dismissed them at the same meeting with the following statements. To Burt Reynolds: "You have no talent." To Clint Eastwood: "You have a chip on your tooth, your Adam's apple sticks out too far and you talk too slow."
- Marilyn Monroe (Norma Jean Baker): In 1944, Emmeline Snively, director of the Blue Book Modeling Agency, told modeling hopeful Norma Jean, "You'd better learn secretarial work or else get married."
- Elvis Presley: In 1954, Jimmy Denny, manager of the Grand Ole Opry, fired Elvis after one performance. He told Presley, "You ain't goin' nowhere son. You ought to go back to drivin' a truck."
- Alexander Graham Bell: When he invented the telephone in 1876, it did not ring off the hook with calls from potential backers. After making a demonstration call, President Rutherford Hayes said, "That's an amazing invention, but who would ever want to use one of them?"
- **Thomas Edison:** He was one of the greatest inventors in American history. When he first attended school in Port Huron, Mich., his teachers complained that he was "too slow" and hard to handle. As a result, Edison's mother decided to take her son out of school and teach him at home. In his lifetime, Edison produced more than 1,300 inventions.
- Franklin D. Roosevelt: Paralyzed by polio at 39, he went on to become one of America's most beloved and influential leaders. He was elected president of the United States four times.
- Julia Child: In 1953, she and her two collaborators signed a publishing contract to produce a book tentatively titled French Cooking for the American Kitchen. Julia and her colleagues worked on the book for five years. The publisher rejected the 850 page manuscript. Child and her partners worked for another year totally revising the manuscript. Again the publisher rejected it. But Julia Child did not give up. She and her collaborators went back to work again, found a new publisher, and in 1961—eight years after beginning—they published Mastering the Art of French Cooking, which has sold more than 1 million copies.
- **Douglas MacArthur:** He might never have gained power and fame without persistence. When he applied for admission to West Point, he was turned down, not once, but twice. But he tried a third time, was accepted and marched into the history books.
- **Abraham Lincoln:** He entered the Blackhawk War as a captain. By the end of the war, he had been demoted to the rank of private.

The anti-cancer lowdown on herbs and spices

any spices and herbs are believed to be imbued with health-building properties and have anti-cancer effects. Herbs and spices are believed to be full of antioxidants, which prevent the damage that free radicals can do to cells.

The National Cancer Institute has identified the following herbs and spices as having cancer-preventing properties: tarragon, cumin, coriander, anise, caraway, turmeric, fennel, rosemary, thyme, oregano and sage. Some of these; caraway, tarragon, fennel and cumin; may also prevent tumor growth, and they are believed to reduce cholesterol levels. Coriander, it is believed, is effective in combating carcinogens. Turmeric contains curcumin, which gives it a yellow color, and has been shown to protect mice against Alzheimer's. Saffron and paprika are believed to stimulate immunity. Cloves and nutmeg are believed to fight bacteria, and chili peppers and ginger might help prevent tumor formation. Cinnamon could be a possible treatment for diabetes in the future. One to two teaspoons were found to lower blood sugar and prevent insulin spikes. —adapted from the U.C. Berkeley Wellness Letter
