





The following information is about where you can take all recyclables if you choose not to dispose of them as garbage:

Zero sort recycling is available behind Tri-City Mall on the other side of East Bay.

Directions: Just go out the back exit of La Plaza onto 69th Street and go across East Bay Drive onto the road going into Tri-City Mall and take a right at the end of the road.. 

- · Don't.. take unnecessary risks to obtain information on suspicious subject or crimes.




