

Recipes For July

Roasted Clams with Lemony Panko

Ingredients

4 tbsp. olive oil, divided
4 cloves garlic, finely grated and divided
Kosher salt
1/2 c. dry white wine
1/2 tsp. red pepper flakes
3 dozen littleneck clams, scrubbed
1/3 c. flat-leaf parsley, chopped
1 tbsp. lemon zest plus 3 Tbsp lemon juice



Directions

- 1. Heat oven to 400°F. On small rimmed baking sheet, massage together panko, 2 tablespoons olive oil, one-fourth of garlic, and a pinch of salt.
- 2. In 9- by 13-inch baking dish, mix wine, red pepper flakes, remaining garlic, and 1 tablespoon oil with clams.
- 3. Transfer both pans to oven; bake, tossing panko once, until golden brown, 8 to 10 minutes. Remove panko, increase oven temperature to 475°F and roast until clams open, 8 to 10 minutes; discard any unopened clams. Toss panko with parsley and lemon zest. Pour lemon juice over clams, drizzle with remaining tablespoon oil and sprinkle with half of lemony panko. Serve with remaining panko.



Ingredients

2 (10-ounce) packages frozen strawberries, thawed, strained, and juice reserved

1 (12-ounce) package frozen raspberries, thawed, strained, and juice reserved

1 1/3 c. confectioners' sugar

1 1/2 tsp. cornstarch

3/4 c. heavy cream

3 (16-ounce) containers nonfat vanilla Greek yogurt, such as Chobani

40 ladyfingers

2 tbsp. orange liqueur such as Cointreau (optional)

1 (16-ounce) package frozen blueberries, thawed and drained

Directions

1. In a medium saucepan over medium heat, whisk together raspberry and strawberry juices with 2/3 cup sugar and cornstarch. Boil until thickened, 1 to 2 minutes. Transfer to a medium bowl and refrigerate until cool, about 20 minutes.

2. Meanwhile, in a medium bowl, whip heavy cream to stiff peaks; set aside. In a large bowl, combine yogurt and remaining 2/3 cup sugar. Fold in whipped cream.

3. Break ladyfingers in half. Place half of them in a 2-quart glass bowl or trifle dish. Drizzle cookies with 1 tablespoon liqueur, if using, and dollop with one-third of yogurt mixture. Spoon half of berries over yogurt mixture, then drizzle 3 to 4 tablespoons thickened juices. Layer another one-third of yogurt mixture over berries, followed by a layer of remaining ladyfingers. Drizzle with remaining 1 tablespoon liqueur and dollop with remaining yogurt mixture. 4.Top with remaining berries and 3 to 4 more tablespoons thickened juice. Refrigerate until chilled, about 2 hours, before serving.
