AMENITY RULES FOR VISITING FAMILY MEMBERS AND GUESTS:


- MUST REGISTER: with the office with photo ID (ex. driver's license or passport) before they can make use of any park amenity.

o to this website, on the right-hand side click INDIVIDUAL APPLICATION

There does need to be some space under your mobile home for them to dig the anchors in, so if you don't have any room between the trailer and ground this wont be an option.

In addition, there has been much talk about people wanting sheds outside the home, it's very important to **get the permit from the main office first**, if possible print out shed with the dimensions listed, so the permit can be approved expeditiously, then decide on how you will anchor. The company that installed the anchors to my home said they also anchor sheds so here is that information. I am not endorsing this business I am only including this information as it was my experience they did a great job of anchoring my home.
