

Here are the exact statistics for how often each thing is played:

Rock - 35.4 percent

Scissors – 29.6 percent

A few of the objects have been tied to cultural stereotypes. For example, aggressive or angry people will most likely play the rock. If you're playing against an aggressive person, playing paper gives you a better shot at winning. Women are most likely to throw scissors and men throw rocks more often.

Peanut Butter Sheet Cake

From Cookie Pontis and Kim Alford

- 1 stick oleo
- 1 cup water
- 1/2 cup peanut butter
- 1/2 cup oil



Combine 1st 4 ingredients in medium saucepan and bring to a boil. (watch closely). Then pour into a large mixing bowl. Add the following ingredients:

- 2 cups flour
- 2 cups sugar
- 1 teaspoon baking soda
- 2 eggs- slightly beaten
- 1/2 cup milk
- 1 teaspoon vanilla

Combine all ingredients until smooth. (Batter will be very thin but don't worry) Pour batter into a greased jelly roll pan (15 1/2 x 10 1/2 inch pan 1 inch high).

Bake in a preheated 375 degree oven for 20 minutes. (use toothpick to test for doneness). Remove from oven and immediately apply icing while still hot.

Icing ingredients:

- 1 stick oleo
- 1/3 cup milk
- 1/2 cup peanut butter



- 1 tablespoon vanilla

Combine until smooth and pour over hot cake. Let cake cool completely before cutting.

PS- I like to use smooth peanut butter in the cake batter and crunchy in the icing...

FACTS ABOUT HURRICANE SEASON FOR OUR AREA

If you are new to the West Coast of Florida, here are some facts you might want to know:

- Please remember ALL MOBILE HOMES IN PINELLAS COUNTY MUST EVACUATE when given the order for Zone A.
- To learn about making your evacuation plan please go to this website: https://pinellas.gov/make-a-plan/hurricane-guide-english/ Special needs residents must register for County assistance in advance. Pet owners can also pre-register for shelters that take pets in evacuation.
- Recently Southwest Florida has been hit by a major storm once about every 5 years. These included Hurricane Irma in 2017 and Hurricane Ian in 2022.

TAMPA, Fla. (WFLA) — when Fall arrives that not only means the promise of a gradual slide into cooler and drier air, but also the greater risk of a direct hit from a Gulf of Mexico hurricane on the West Coast of Florida. That's because as the seasons change, so do the steering currents which guide storms.

Since 1950, Florida's West Coast – from Apalachee Bay to Cape Sable – has only had two direct hits from Gulf hurricanes in August. Hurricane Charley is one of those rare exceptions, making landfall in mid-August 2004 near Ft. Myers. That number ramps up in September and jumps to 10 direct landfalls during the month of October over the past 71 years.

Anyone in the path of the potential storm should make sure they have an up-to-date hurricane safety kit and a family plan in case you plan to leave. You can keep checking back WFLA.com for updates as new information is released.

GARDENING TIPS AND INFO



all is the perfect time to plant flowers and plants in West Central Florida. According to https://thegardeningdad.com/best-flowers-to-grow-in-florida/, the most popular fall annual flowers in our area include:

- Petunias They thrive in the heat but should be in hanging baskets or window boxes because <u>rabbits</u> will eat them before they bloom on the ground.
- Daisies Plant bulbs in the fall and actual plants in the spring to watch them come back year after year with little to no maintenance. They thrive the hotter it gets and more sunlight it receives, making this the perfect flower to plant anywhere in your yard. Deter rabbits and deer from your flower garden with the pungent flavor of daisies.
- Dahlias are the easiest flower to grow. You do not need to fertilize it, barely needs water, and can be planted in any soil. The best spot to plant dahlias is in gardening containers. This is because you can grow them anywhere, such as in your house, on your patio, or transplant into a window box. Dahlias are prone to garden pests, like <u>squirrels</u>, deer, and <u>rabbits</u> that will eat bulbs, flowers, and even the plant itself.
- Lilies are one of the only flowers on this list that grows perfectly vertical. This means it is perfect for small spaces, urban gardeners, or in between other plants as a cross-pollinator. Make sure to plant this flower close to your house, in a raised garden bed. Lilies tolerate rain, heat, cold, shade, and droughts. But too much rain can cause root rot and other diseases that will kill your Lilies. They are the most popular summer-blooming flower in Florida, and one of the least expensive perennial flowers to grow.
