Bylaws of Hillcrest Residents, Inc.

Homeowners Association As Adopted, March 15, 1985 Amended 1/2-7/86, 2/10/88, 2/1./98, 4/10/2012 Article I. Location and purpose



These are the Bylaws of the Hillcrest Residents, Inc., hereinafter called the "corporation" or "Association", a Corporation for profit or non-profit, whichever is applicable, if there is a change in status.

Section 1. Principal Office. The principal office of the Corporation shall be 2346 Druid Road E. Clearwater, Florida 33764 or as specified by the Board of Directors.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the Corporation.

- a. As a homeowners association to represent the home owners within the Hillcrest Mobile Home Parle located at 2346 Druid Rd. E., Clearwater, Florida 33764.
- b. To negotiate with management on behalf of the mobile home owners.
- c. To liaise with and support external organizations which are active in supporting the lifestyle and objectives of mobile homeowners.
- d. To work for the good and welfare of all residents and serve as a liaison between park management and resident owners of the Hillcrest Mobile Home Park.
- e. To protect personal and property rights.
- f. To sponsor the recreational, social and cultural activities and to promote other clubs, organizations or groups which may be formed, as long as they abide by and follow the bylaws of this association.
- g. Park management shall have no responsibility in relationship to this Association and no management employee, with administrative and or supervision authority shall serve on the Board of Directors.
- **Section 3. Corporation**. This Corporation is not to be confused with the Hillcrest Social Club, which organization is responsible for and limited to the conduct of organized social activities for the residents of Hillcrest Mobile Home Park.
- **Section 4. Fiscal Year.** The Fiscal Year of the Corporation, shall end on January 31 of each year.
- **Section 5. Seal.** The seal of the Corporation shall bear the name of the Corporation and the word "Florida".
- **Section 6. Govern Corporation.** The Directors shall govern this corporation in accordance with these by-laws and applicable Florida Statutes.

Article II - Directors

Section 1. Functions. All corporation powers shall be exercised by or under the authority of the Board of Directors. The business and affairs of the corporations shall be managed under the Directors of the Board of Directors.

Section 2. Qualifications of Directors. Each Director shall be a member in the Corporation. Directors shall be non-paid volunteers. The word "Board" as used herein includes all Officers and Directors of Hillcrest Residents, Inc.

Section 3. Duties of Directors: The Directors shall have a Fiduciary Relationship to the Corporation. A Director shall perform his or her duties as a Director, including his or her duties as a member of any committee of the board upon which he or she may serve, in good faith, in a manner he or she reasonably believes to be in the best interest of the Corporation and with such care as an ordinarily prudent person in a like position would use under similar circumstances.

Section 4. Number of Directors. The number of Directors shall be not less than five (5) The number of Directors may be increased or decreased by Bylaw amendments adopted by the Directors and approved by the members.

Section 5. Nominations. Nominations will be accepted from the floor at annual meeting, when made by any qualified member of the Corporation. The nominee must indicate he or she is will to serve as a member of the Board.

Section 6. Terms of Office. The terms of office for Directors shall be two. (2) years.

The terms of office shall be staggered so the entire Board is not up for re-election at the same time.

Article III - Election of Board of Directors

Section 1. At the Annual Meeting, the Board of Directors shall appoint, from the members in good standing, a chairperson for the Election Committee and at least two (2) additional members.

- (a) Election Day shall be at the Annual Meeting. Notice of the date, time and place shall be given by the President or Secretary; Such-notice shall be in writing to each-member at his or her Clearwater, Florida address, as it is on the books of the Corporation and shall be mailed, or hand delivered not less than fourteen (14) days nor more than thirty (30) days prior to the date of the election.
- i. The newly elected Directors shall assume their position immediately following the annual meeting.
- j. In the event of a request for recount, the recount shall be made by the Election Committee in the presence of the Member or Members requesting the recount. This request must be made within twenty-four (24) hours after the announcement of the results of the election. The recount shall be performed within seven (7) days following the election.

Section 3. Vacancies. When vacancies occur on the Board of Directors, the Board shall appoint replacement members to fill the vacancies from the last elections state of candidates, for the unexpired terms. If no candidates are available from the last slate, a member in good standing will be appointed to that position.



Section 4. Meetings. Meetings of the Board of Directors shall be open to all members, and notice of meetings shall be posted in a conspicuous place upon the Official Bulletin Board at least forty-eight (48) hours in advance, except in an emergency. Meetings of the Board of Directors may be held at such time and place as shall be determined by a majority of the Directors. The President may call a meeting of the Board when deemed necessary or when requested by the majority of the Board members. Such meeting shall be scheduled to take place not later than two (2) weeks after receipt by the President of such request.

Section 5. Special Meetings. Special meeting of the Board of Directors may be called by the President, or in his or her absence, by the Vice President, and must be called by the President or Secretary upon receipt of a written request of one-third (1/3) of the members of the Board. Notice of meeting shall state purpose of the meeting. Special meetings of the Board of Directors shall be open to all members in good standing and notice of such meetings shall be posted in a conspicuous place on the official bulletin board in the Recreation Hall at least forty-eight (48) hours in advance of such meeting, except in the event of an emergency. Notice of such special meeting shall be given personally, or by mail to each Director and such notice shall state the time, and purpose of the meeting. His notice shall be transmitted to each Director at least forty-eight (48) hours prior to the meeting.

Section 6. Majority. A simple majority of members of the Board of Directors shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business.

Section 7. Adjournment. If at any meeting of the Board there is less than a quorum present, the majority of those present may adjourn the meeting. No further notice need be given of an adjourned meeting.

He liked having a regular payday, and at night he walked around with friends and talked about physics. So it was in his spare time that Einstein changed the laws of physics. And that's part of why the world still loves him so. Even after he wrote and published four historic papers during his "miracle year," he continued on as an employee at the patent office. And isn't that what we all want, after all, to be recognized for the geniuses that we are, instead of the office kooks we feel like.

As a matter of fact, Einstein's job at the patent office might have helped him, since if he had been in the academic world his ideas might have been squelched by the professors in power. Would they have listened to a young guy who believed that space and time were not absolute?

His job probably also kept his mind sharp, because he was constantly called upon to evaluate people's inventions. This required him to use his powers of visualization and to use specifications and drawings to test the ideas out.

Einstein wrote: "Working on the final formulation of technological patents was a veritable blessing for me. It enforced many-sided thinking and also provided important stimuli to physical thought." — adapted from "Who knew: Outside player," by Joel Achenbach, in National Geographic


