

REMINDER:

Please remember; <u>COME TO THE OFFICE</u> to sign in/out. This is needed to begin and stopping the Water/Sewer/Trash Bill. Residents can notify the office by either dropping a note in the black mailbox at the clubhouse front door, email, or come to the office during business hours (9:00-1pm PM). We will need your name, lot# and day of arrival or departure. Do Not leave a message on the answering machine, it must be in writing to be effective. Per the Golden Gate Rules & Regulations: (#16 Home sites): Shareholders will be exempt from billing for City utilities for any month which the home is unoccupied providing the sign out procedure with the office has been properly completed.

Checking Out? Leave a forwarding address with the post office.

- If you are leaving the community for an extended period of time, don't forget to leave a forwarding address for your mail. There are forms in the office if needed or you can get one from our mail carrier. Simply fill it out and leave it on your mailbox for the mail carrier to pick up. Don't forget to change your mail back to be delivered here when you return.
- PLEASE REMOVE YOUR ORANGE OR FADED DOTS FROM THE MAILBOX UPON YOUR RETURN TO THE PARK

Closing up your home when you leave remember to;

- Turn off your water
- If leaving the electric on turn off Water Heater Breaker
- Store all garden items and trash receptacles
- Forward your mail.
- Sign out at the office please.
- Put down and secure your awnings

MONTHLY RULE:

XIX. SECURITY: #6. Fobs are the property of the Association.

#7. If the home is sold the Fobs are to be returned to the office to be reassigned to the new owner by the Director.

PLEASE BE AWARE:

There have been reports that strangers have been seen in Golden Gate. If you have a concern of their permission to be here, check the sign in sheet at the office door, notify the office of time of day, a description and where seen. The cameras will be checked, but you as a resident, needs to take the responsibility of notifying the Police of your concern immediately. Please, do not approach or confront someone you do not know.

XI. EXTRA OCCUPANCY FEES AND GUESTS: #1 Overnight Guests must be registered upon arrival and they must agree to abide by all the rules of the Association.

#4 Use of unit by a Shareholder's guest, when not in resident, is permitted, provided the Shareholder notifies the office prior to the arrival of the guest and assumes responsibility for the water, sewer and garbage charges and designate the length of stay.

SUGGESTION: If anyone would be interested in starting a NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH GROUP, please let the board know and a sign up sheet can be posted of Shareholders who would be interested in forming a committee.

A NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH is a FREE program provided by the Pinellas County Sheriff's Office. They will teach you how to observe and report suspicious activity. Through mutual communication, they will help make our community a better and safer place to live.

A Neighborhood Watch Group requires a minimum of three volunteers to oversee your group:

- *Chairperson
- *Co-Chairperson
- *Communication Leader

All volunteers, full and part time residents, will be welcome to work together as a committee to make Golden Gate a safe and secure place to live.
