- There is also an application for your smartphone "Ready Pinellas."
- It doesn't hurt to check your homeowner's policy for coverage.
- If a tornado warning is issued you would be better off going to the clubhouse or pavilion bathrooms (be sure you have the codes written down) than staying in your mobile home, park model or RV.
