VACANT PROPERTIES

When you leave for an extended period of time on vacations or leaving for the summer months, consider contacting the sheriff's department, 727-582-6200, and have them periodically inspect your property. They will visit and perform an inspection of your home to ensure there are no signs of forced entry. If you have authorized someone to park in your driveway, inform them of the model of the vehicle and license plate number. Prior to returning, be sure to call them and let them know at least 10 days in advance so they can take you off the watch list otherwise you may have some deputy sheriffs at your door. While you are away, if you have authorized someone to stay in your home for any length of time, please contact a board director and let them know. We do get calls or observe activity in your home and do not know if the activity in your home is authorized by you. One of the reasons our community is secure is neighbors are watching out for one another. That can sometimes be a bit too much but it does help keep a community watch active in our community and outsiders know we are watching.

When you leave for your second home away from Briar Creek, be sure the board of directors have you address. We have most of them in our database, however to ensure they are accurate just send your address to briarcreekoff@gmail.com. We can then double check to ensure our records agree. In today's world of cell phones your local phone may also be your phone number when you are away. If you use a landline when away send us that number too. We can tell you of many horror stories of owners who were away when issues occurred at or near their Briar Creek home. Turn your water off. If you're not sure how or where the shut off is located contact us - we can help you.

ast year the Board replaced the keys to the Clubhouse and Pool Area with FOBS that increase the safety of all residents of Briar Creek. Remember to bring your FOB with you when you are going to the Clubhouse or Pool. Do not assume that someone will be there and open the door or gate – this defeats the purpose of issuing FOBS for security.

After use of the Clubhouse or Pool Area remember to do the following:

• Relock any doors you dogged in the open position



- Turn off lights
- Turn off any fans you used also fans on back deck by the pool
- Return any items you used from the kitchen and, if needed, empty the trash

CAN YOU SPOT A SCAM?

Five red flags to watch out for:



1. Unexpected contact – A person or company contacts you out of

the blue by phone, text, or email about an invoice, order, delivery, or charge you didn't know about.

- 2. Everything is urgent Scammers will create a false sense of urgency and use pressure tactics like rude or pushy language to get you to act immediately.
- 3. Very specific or unusual way to pay Someone is asking you to pay or send money using gift cards, cryptocurrency, a payment app, or even an online wire to pay for something, resolve an "issue", get sweepstakes "winnings", or secure a high return on your "investment".
- 4. Threatening language Scammers may tell you that you owe money and then threaten to call the police if you don't pay immediately. They may also coach you on what to tell the bank to withdraw or transfer money, or ask you to keep a secret.
- 5. The romantic "emergency" A new online love interest bombards you with "sweet talk" but doesn't seem to want to meet in person. Suddenly a hardship or emergency strikes and they want you to send them money.

What to do if you suspect a scam:

- Slow down. Pause, take a breath, and think it through.
- Someone you don't know is asking you for your money.

o Remember it's right to confirm things no matter how urgent anyone says it is.

You're in charge when it comes to your money.

- Contact the company they claim to be, call your bank, or call the police if it doesn't seem right.
- Consult with a friend or family member you trust.

t's July 2 as I write this and while watching the TV news last night, I was surprised when the announcer said the water temperatures in the Gulf



▲ of Mexico and Tampa Bay have broken record highs this year. A few days ago, the water temperature in the Gulf was 91 and yesterday's Tampa Bay water temperature was 93. All I need is a little soap and beach time and I could save money on my water bill.

With the arrival of August, the Atlantic hurricane season is now entering its third month which is normally when the frequency of storms begins to increase. NOAA has projected a normal hurricane season of 12-17 named storms with 5-9 named hurricanes. I'm not really sure who Mother Nature communicates with at NOAA but we've already had three named storms as we remain hopeful that November 30th gets here sooner versus later. When the water temperatures reach 80 degrees, the chances of hurricanes developing increases significantly.

The bottom line is that if we haven't yet prepared for hurricane season, it's time to take action. Those of us who have lived here for a while know the drill but for those new to Florida, there are plenty of Guides available to help us develop a hurricane plan.

I can't emphasize enough how important it is to develop an evacuation plan since we live in a mandatory evacuation zone. It can get scary sitting in our home with 100+ mile per hour winds outside and we simply shouldn't have to worry about risking our personal safety when we ultimately know better. Unfortunately, sheltering in the Clubhouse is not an option as structure doesn't meet code and insurance would not cover personal injury if a tragedy occurred. None of us want to experience the "big one" that Sanford from the TV series talked about.

Finally, when winds reach the hurricane level of 74 miles per hour and higher, debris and unsecured personal items around can blow away damaging not just our own, but our neighbor's cars and homes. None of us really want to hear that our lose flower pot or ornamental decoration dented our friend's car or smashed their window. This is why we encourage snowbirds and travelers to move these items inside to a secured area. If you haven't done so, now is the time to make arrangements to help ensure the safety and security of your neighbors.

So please, if you haven't prepared a hurricane plan, do so now. It only takes one storm to make a difference in us feeling sorry if we didn't plan ahead or glad if we did.



Common Causes Of Back Pain

The low back is one of the most common symptoms that people see doctors and therapists for. Because the lumbar spine supports the upper body most issues arise at the L4-5 and S1 areas. This is around the belt line.

1. Sprain/Strain

A sprain is when there is an inflammation or tear of the ligaments that support a bone or in the case of the spine a vertebrae. A strain is the inflammation or tear of a tendon attaching to muscles. Tendonitis falls in this category. Tennis elbow can occur even if you do not play tennis.

2. Degenerative Disc Syndrome

This can occur with normal aging or excelerated with trauma and injury. The cushion between the vertebrae are called a disc. When the disc begins thinning and losing its elasticity and ability to cushion forces a process of degeneration occurs. This is also called degenerative osteo arthritis. There are stages of development typically from stage 1 which is mild to stage 4.

3. Ruptured or Herniated Disc

When the forces to the disc are greater then its resilience the disc can tear or rupture. Since nerves exit out from the spine these problems can inflame and pinch nerves that travel to specific muscles of the low back, hips, and down the legs.

4. Spinal Compression Fractures.

This occurs typically when there is moderate to advanced osteoporosis. Osteoporosis is a degenerative process of the vertebrae losing their mineral strength. There are stages 1 through 4 typically. The weaker the bones become a spontaneous fracture can occur as it gives way to the ongoing stress.

5. Sciatica.

From the low back exits the largest nerve in the body, the sciatic nerve. All of the issues above can lead to that nerve becoming inflamed or pinched. The Sciatica nerve passes through the buttocks and travels down the back of the leg all the way to the ankle.

All of these issues can cause pain, restricted range of motion, numbness, and often a person can have a few of these issues occurring simultaneously. It is important to not just mask symptoms, but to be evaluated by a orthopedic doctor, as well as a chiropractor. Sometimes an M.R.I. is essential in seeing the extent of the problem. Treatments with chiropractic, physical therapists are extremely beneficial, as well as understanding what everyday exercises to do at home. Also knowing what foods and supplements to make part of your lifestyle. When we are proactive, and willing to make healthy choices in our lives most problems can improve and be prevented. Think Forever young especially as we become older. Information is power.
