




omeone in WW ll asked if we could try to bring back our old "Help Out Your Neighbor" that used to be in the "Hi Lites."

Read about the signers of the Declaration of Independence

This week our nation will celebrate its 247th birthday! I am not sure what one gets a nation for such an occasion, but I suspect it will include fireworks and barbecues. Personally, L I am hoping it will also include sunshine! The truth is what our country needs most on its 247th birthday is neither fireworks, barbecues, or even sunshine, what it needs is for us all to step back from the day to day worries of life and to reflect on the freedoms we have and the sacrifices that made them possible. Sacrifice in our culture is in many ways is a foreign concept. I often wonder if World War II were to happen today if our nation could rally as it did then to stop evil's march, or whether we would be too overrun by self-interest and political rancor. This week when we celebrate Independence Day, we do not celebrate the moment our nation was free, but rather the moment we declared Independence from Great Britain. The difference is important, as between the moment Independence was declared and the moment it was fully realized our nation endured great suffering, sacrifice and loss. This week we will commemorate the courageous actions of 56 men who signed the Declaration of Independence in 1776, and the countless men and women who stood beside them in this great moment and all that would follow. I think we often forget the signers of the Declaration of Independence were not statesmen, most of them were ordinary people like you and me. Twenty-four of them were lawyers, eleven were small business owners, nine were farmers. Indeed the 56 signers of the Declaration of Independence did not reflect every portion of society at the time, but they did reflect her heart, and they did pledge their lives, fortunes, and sacred honor to the cause of freedom that is shared with us all this day. The sacrifices demanded of the signers for something greater than themselves was real. Five of the signers were captured, tortured and killed by the British. Twelve of the signers lost their homes and all their possessions, two lost their sons, and nine of the signers died as a result of wounds and suffering directly caused by the Revolutionary War and their brave actions therein. As a child I always remember learning about Thomas Nelson, Jr. who signed the Declaration of Independence. During the battle of Yorktown British General Cornwallis took over his home and made it his headquarters. Nelson, who served at General George Washington's side, told Washington he should fire on Cornwallis' headquarters/his own home. Washington did and in doing so Nelson lost everything he owned and would die penniless. Nelson's fate was better than that of John Hart who was forced to leave his wife at her dying bedside. He left behind his wife and thirteen children and had to flee, living in caves and the forest to avoid capture and certain death at the hands of the British. A year later when Hart retuned, his wife had died, his kids vanished and he died shortly thereafter of a broken heart. The stories of these first Independence Day's, and the sacrifices made, are not unlike those that have followed through the years, the stories of men and women who sacrificed all for the sake of freedom and our nation. Some of the names of those who sacrificed are indeed remembered in the cemeteries, and rolls of honor, but countless are the names not known, but sacrifices just as real- the names of mothers who lost sons, families who sacrificed, and people who surrendered dreams and the plans of life, when duty called. This Independence Day weekend when we celebrate what we have as a nation, it is important



that we also remember how we got it. Freedom is never free and sacrifice is never easy. The sacrifice of the 56 signers of the Declaration, and many others like them, is what gave birth to our nation.

ince her death in 1979, the woman who discovered what the universe is made of has not so much as received a memorial plaque. Her newspaper obituaries do not mention her greatest discovery. Every high school student knows that Isaac Newton discovered gravity, that Charles Darwin discovered evolution, and that Albert Einstein discovered the relativity of time. But when it comes to the composition of our universe, the textbooks simply say that the most abundant atom in the universe is hydrogen. And no one ever wonders how we know."

CECILIA PAYNE.

Cecilia Payne's mother refused to spend money on her college education, so she won a scholarship to Cambridge.

Cecilia Payne completed her studies, but Cambridge wouldn't give her a degree because she was a woman, so she said to heck with that and moved to the United States to work at Harvard.

Cecilia Payne was the first person ever to earn a Ph.D. in astronomy from Radcliffe College, with what Otto Strauve called "the most brilliant Ph.D. thesis ever written in astronomy."

Not only did *Cecilia Payne* discover what the universe is made of, she also discovered what the sun is made of (Henry Norris Russell, a fellow astronomer, is usually given credit for discovering that the sun's composition is different from the Earth's, but he came to his conclusions four years later than *Payne*—after telling her not to publish).

Cecilia Payne is the reason we know basically anything about variable stars (stars whose brightness as seen from earth fluctuates). Literally every other study on variable stars is based on her work.

Cecilia Payne was the first woman to be promoted to full professor from within Harvard, and is often credited with breaking the glass ceiling for women in the Harvard science department and in astronomy, as well as inspiring entire generations of women to take up science.

Cecilia Payne is awesome and everyone should know her.
