From the Manager's Desk:

Thope all of you are enjoying this lovely Summer and have your schedules filled up with cool and fun activities to make the most of the sunny days. **MANAGER**



I just marked a one month milestone working at Americana Cove and I would like to share some of the highlights with you:

I had a chance to meet many of the owners and address issues some of you have: account balance questions, property improvements and general questions and inquiries. I am always happy to hear from any owner and I encourage you to reach out and share your feedback, concerns, and suggestions. My email is Vita.blough@americanacove.com

As an experienced property manager I recognize that my duty is to maintain property values by ensuring an upkeep of the grounds, curb appeal of homes and making sure that all owners understand and comply with community rules and regulations and aesthetics guidelines.

Therefore irrigation system repairs were on my immediate "to do" list. I have met with several well specialists, studied inspection reports and compared proposals. Board has approved Citrus Wells to start well pump repair project after Board members were presented 3 proposals for their consideration. This project will be gradual: priority is to fix 3 well pumps on North side first and then continue overall system improvements following Citrus Wells specialist recommendations. I really hope that after the rainy season is over we will be fully capable to maintain green lawns by ensuring they are watered properly.

I have also had a chance to personally meet with owners and address some of the most common rule violations that directly impact overall property appeal. Such violations include clutter around the house, unmanicured flower beds, golf carts, boats or cars parked on the grass and bushes or trees growing into neighbor houses. My goal is to communicate with each and every owner to make them understand that the effort needs to be put into upkeep of the community and that rules are created to ensure everyone gets to live in a welcoming and clean environment.

Taking this opportunity I would like to tell you about two committees and invite you to sign up for:

• Fine Appeals Committee. Florida Statute has established a very specific violation and fine process to ensure that Association Boards use violation and fines process to get owner compliance with Association's Governing Documents. Fine Appeals Committee members cannot be affiliated with the Board in any way – be it relative, spouse, child or even living in the same household as Board members. Once the Board levies a fine, owner is given a proper notice and a chance to appeal it at the Fine Appeals Committee meeting. Board will be appointing Committee Members at July 19th meeting – please do not hesitate to reach out to me if you have questions and are interested in joining a committee.



• Planning Committee. This Committee will have many important tasks at hand in the next two to three years as Board is working on creating a proactive reserve spending schedule on the projects that are needed to be done in the community to curtail the deterioration of common elements and prevent large repair expenditures. One of the examples are sewer pipes. Americana Cove still has original sewer pipes in some areas that are deteriorating due to the age, materials used (clay) and tree roots growing into pipes. We also are looking at the boat ramp repairs, seawall repairs, Clubhouse improvements – the list goes on. It would be great to engage many talented owners who live here – engineers, architects, contractors – who would be able to work on prioritizing these projects and make recommendations to the Finance Committee and the Board on any future capital improvements.

Please do not hesitate to reach me with any questions you may have – working together we can ensure that we create the best community for everyone to enjoy.

President's Message

Being a Board Member can be a difficult and thankless job. You perform your board function for the benefit of the association and its members. You must work as a fiduciary to protect the association. You are placed in a position of trust and authority. At any given time, your decisions to protect the association may be in conflict with the demands of your neighbors and friends.

One of the jobs to be performed is to approve the applications of your neighbors when they, too, want to live in Americana Cove, a premiere 55+ community. I have been very driven to follow the rules established by Americana Cove and previous boards. The rules to move here are quite simple. You must be 55 or older, not have a felony conviction, and have a credit score of 675.

The first two seem to not be an issue with most people, but, how do credit scores work? One simple number, ranging from 300 to 850, can have a big impact on your finances which tells us if you will be able to pay your bills within Americana Cove. A good credit score makes you more likely to be approved for credit accounts, get better interest rates and even secure lower auto insurance premiums. What is the difference between a credit score and a credit report? The three digit FICO score is a calculation based on the detailed information within your credit report. The three nationwide credit bureaus each track the credit histories of all Americans and you have the right to a free copy of your credit report from each of those three bureaus every year.

What doesn't affect your credit score? Your income, savings or investment balances, using debit or prepaid cards, traffic tickets, and bills such as utilities and rent that are not considered credit accounts. However, if one of those utility bills or rent payments become delinquent and gets turned over to a collection agency, that can show up on your credit report and affect your FICO score.



How is your credit score calculated? There are five factors that make up your score. The largest factor is your payment history which accounts for 35% of the FICO score. Pay your loan and credit card bills on time even if you can only afford the minimum because consistency is what matters with the payment history. Secondly, 30% of the FICO score is based on the amounts you owe. You need to pay attention to the amount of debt you carry compared to the amount of credit you have available. 15% of the score is based on the length of your credit history. It's recommended to establish your credit early and consider keeping your oldest accounts open provided they don't charge you fees for the credit account. New credit and credit mix both make up 10% each of your credit score. If you decide to apply for a new credit card, your score may temporarily go down. And for credit mix, this refers to the different credit accounts you may have; such as mortgages, car loans, credit cards and credit lines. Having a blend of both revolving credit (credit cards and lines that you repeatedly use and pay down) and installment accounts (mortgages, car loans, that you pay off over time) makes for an ideal credit mix because it demonstrates your ability to manage different types of debt.

Credit scores are all about stability. It is something you have control over. With a little bit of know how and some care, you can boost your credit score by quite a bit. An excellent credit score will usually qualify you for lower interest rates on all types of loans as a high credit score tells lenders that you are a safe bet. At the very least, you can make smart decisions to keep your score in top-top shape. There are many articles to help you make decisions regarding your credit score and many advantages to keep excellent credit, even in retirement.

Finance Committee/Treasurer Update

We have been working on several projects for the community over the past three months. We would like to thank the Board of Directors, Office Staff and Committee Members for their help.



- The Board of Directors, Finance Committee and Office staff have supported all the details to ensure we closed our loan refinance with Bank of America on June 30, 2023. We negotiated a competitive interest rate, and our property value has increased significantly over the past 10 years. Our 117 acres will be attractive to home buyers moving forward for current and future generations.
- Our strong reserve fund is fully funded for FY23/24, however due to a series of recent repairs the Board, manager and maintenance team have identified several aging infrastructure areas that should be updated or added to our reserve study for the future. We met with Reserve Advisors on July 6, 2023, to discuss our current reserve study from June 2022 and requested an update proposal to help with COLA adjustments and several changes/additions that have been identified. We will be working with the board of directors to identify these changes and submit them to Reserve Advisors for an updated study later this year.
- Due to fiscal management, cost saving initiatives, loan payoffs and share sales we have additional funds. We have interviewed several bank representatives to look for opportunities for safe, secure liquid investments while we wait for the updated reserve study and create next year's budget. Investments being considered, T-Bills, Broker CDs, and money market accounts.

Water: The Most important Plant Growth Regulator

It can be said that water is the single most important factor that is required for plant growth and survival. It is a vital "nutrient" that must be available in adequate supply or plants decline and eventually die. It is the medium which allows plants to absorb other vital nutrients such as nitrogen, phosphorus, and potassium, giving plants the ability to move these 'fertilizers' to stems, branches, and leaves for energy. Water is vital for all of plant life, and not just for hydration, but also for nutrient transport and temperature regulation.

Water is taken up by plant roots from the soil, transported up the plant, and then evaporated through pores on the surface of leaves. This is called 'transpiration', a physiological process describing the passive movement of water through the plants vascular system which allows columns of water to move great heights. The speed of upwards water movement through a plant is controlled by the tug-of-war between water availability in soil versus water loss from leaves. For example, water can move upwards in some trees like red oak at a rate 92 ft/hr, while in a soft wooded pine tree, upward water movement is closer to 6 ft/hr. In my book the speed of that movement is truly a remarkable phenomenon. Trees can absorb between 10 and 150 gallons of water daily, yet for all the water that is absorbed by these trees, less than 5% remains in the tree to support tree growth.

Plants are like humans in many ways. They need air, water, and nutrients to grow and survive. People can go without food for weeks, but only days without water. The same is true for plants. Just like humans, plants need to regulate their internal temperature. They do this by 'sweating', or as the botanist would say transpiring, which is the process of releasing water through pores on their leaves. Water is lost as a fine mist to the atmosphere through openings in the leaf at a very high rate when it is hot, and plants need to regulate their temperature downward. This sweating process helps the plant stay cool in hot weather and protects it from overheating and desiccating due to excessive heat and sun exposure. They are thus dependent on periodic resupplies of water to "rehydrate", to 'chill-out' and not overheat while out in the sun.

Evidence of the prolonged drought we've just had and problems with ongoing water shortages (both rainfall and irrigation) is still apparent throughout all of Americana Cove. During the entire months of May and June we had 6 rainy days, delivering about 8 inches of total rainfall. It was hot, with average daily high temperatures of 85° F for the month of May and 87° F for June. Daily average wind speeds were blowing in the neighborhood of 10 mph during May and June. During this period, we simply were not able to rely on rainfall alone to sustain the water needs of our landscape, particularly under such hot and windy conditions. The result of this prolonged droughty period is still being expressed in the wilting, severe thinning of canopies, scorching of leaves, and even dieback or death of many of our trees and landscape ornamentals around the park.

Anytime there is a week without significant rainfall of <u>at least one inch</u>, most trees and landscape plants will need some assistance from us to resupply the much-needed water to maintain a healthy plant. It is for this reason, that we should be so thankful to Americana Cove for providing irrigation water from a separate system of irrigation wells. As old as it is, we are thankful that is being maintained and available during periods of critical need. Without it, Americana Cove would not be considered such a beautifully landscaped and such a highly rated community to live in within sunny St. Petersburg Florida.
