

HOME MAINTENANCE

In the month of August, we will be looking at roofs that need to be cleaned. Please take some time to look around the outside of your home and your roof to see what needs to be done. Of course, we are also looking at your entire lot.

GUESTS

We all love to have company occasionally. Please remember to sign your guests in with the office for anyone who is not an owner or renter of your home. This includes kids, grandkids, family members and friends. See Park rules page 1, # 3 & 4 below:

- 3. All guests staying overnight must be registered upon arrival. Guests arriving after office hours must be registered in advance or the next business day when arrival was not anticipated. Residents are responsible to see that their guests wear their assigned guest badges at all times when park facilities and pools are being used.
- 4. Residents are responsible for their guests' actions. Residents will accompany all guests under the age of 18 while such guests use recreational facilities.

LADDERS

Do not leave your ladders leaning up against your home. This is dangerous for you and your neighbors, especially during storm season. Make sure any items you have around your home are secure and will not blow in the wind. If you have an umbrella, it should be closed every night and when not in use. DECLARATION OF DOMICILE

OMICILE refers to the place you call home permanently. You may have more than one residence, but establishing your domicile is important for legal purposes such as paying taxes, voting and claiming benefits. This is especially important to those of you who are snowbirds but equally important to those of you who have more than one residence elsewhere.

A Declaration of Domicile Form is available to you through the Clerk of Courts in Clearwater and you can obtain it on line as well. Once it is completed (a simple form) it requires notarization and a filing fee of \$10.00 with the Clerk of Courts in Clearwater.

The Declaration of Domicile states that you intend to make a specific state your permanent address. You may have a 2nd residence but it is not where you plan to register your car, establish your banking, pay taxes or vote. Declaring your location of domicile can protect you in legal matters including estate planning. As a general rule, a domicile is where you spend most of the year, usually more than half. In Florida, it usually means 6 months plus one day or more. You may want to discuss this matter with your legal counsel before pursuing the Declaration of Domicile.

CHEF'S CORNER

CHEESE-WINE LOG

- 2 cups shredded sharp cheddar cheese, softened
- 1 3 oz pkg cream cheese, softened
- 1/3 cup dry white wine
- 1 TBL finely chopped green onion
- 1 tsp prepared horseradish
- 1 2 1/2 oz pkg (1bout 1 cup) smoked beef, finely snipped
- Assorted crackers



In a small mixer bowl beat softened cheese till nearly smooth, gradually beat in wine. Add onion and horseradish. Chill mixture about 1 hour or till slightly firm. Shape mixture into 2 logs. Roll each in half of the beef. Wrap and chill till ready to serve. Serve with crackers.

OVEN FRIED FISH FILLETS

- 1 lb. sole or flounder fillets
- ½ cup mayonnaise
- Breadcrumbs
- Paprika

- $\frac{1}{2}$ tsp salt
- ½ tsp pepper
- Lemon wedges



Thinly coat fish fillets with mayonnaise, dredge each in breadcrumbs.


Arrange in a greased 13x9x2" baking pan, sprinkle fish with seasonings.

Bake at 450 for about 12 mins or until fish flakes easily. Garnish with lemon wedges. Serves 2

OLD-FASIONED RICE PUDDING

- 1 cup cooked rice
- 1 cup milk
- 2½ TBLS sugar

- Dash of salt
- 1 TBL butter or margarine
- ½ tsp vanilla extract



Cook over medium heat until thickened (about 20 min), stirring often.

Add vanilla. Spoon into serving dishes. Serve hot or cold. Serves 2.
