- 1. If your home backs up to a fence, you are not allowed to plant along the fence. Teakwood is having all growth on the fences either removed or trimmed way back. There are multiple utilities underground, near the fences that need to be accessible.
- 2. Dogs must be leashed, and accompanied, anytime they are outside the home. I am getting quite a few reports of dogs running loose. The owners tell me the dog snuck out when they answered the door. I have a suggestion, as there are no exceptions to the







leash law in Florida, purchase a pet/baby gate to place across the door opening so that when you open your door it keeps the dog inside.



## CHOCOLATE IS GOOD FOR YOU!!


bet you never thought you would hear that but according to an article in Healthgrades it is true. Recent studies have revealed new health

benefits of eating chocolate, and not just the dark kind. There's an expanding body of research outlining the sweet treat's power when it comes to staying healthy and keeping your mind sharp. Here are five ways a daily dose of chocolate can boost your overall health.

- 1. One study found that adults who ate slightly less than an ounce of chocolate each day had lower rates of heart disease than those who didn't eat any. While more research is needed to pinpoint exactly how chocolate is doing this, it's clear the type of chocolate you eat isn't important; positive effects showed up for both light and dark varieties.
- 2. Chocolate's antioxidants seem to protect against plaque buildup on your artery walls. A study in the Journal of Nutrition linked regular chocolate consumption with reduced LDL cholesterol, the unhealthy type that builds up in arteries. Two elements of chocolate, stearic and oleic acid, are thought to be the ingredients that keep cholesterol levels in check. Here, dark chocolate has the advantage as it has the strongest cholesterol-lowering effects.
- 3. Eating a small square of chocolate that contains 50 to 70% cocoa on a daily basis can help lower your blood pressure, especially if you have hypertension. Chocolate combats this with flavonoids, nutrients that have anti-inflammatory and antioxidant powers. These cause blood vessels to dilate, improving blood flow to the brain and heart and reducing blood pressure.
- 4. Drinking two cups of hot chocolate each day can improve brain health and prevent memory decline. A Harvard Medical School study showed that chocolate increased blood flow in particular areas of the brain, improving cognitive function in adults. Research has also shown that people who consume chocolate each day have improved attention, memory, and executive function.
- 5. Regularly eating chocolate can actually help you make healthy diet choices. Researchers from the University of Copenhagen found that after eating chocolate, particularly the darker version, people experienced fewer cravings for sweet, salty, and fatty foods, and they felt more satiated overall. This means indulging in a bit of dark chocolate on a regular basis can not only leave you feeling happy and satisfied—it can also help you stick to a healthy diet.

So, chocolate lovers rejoice! Do remember that moderation is important and also to avoid chocolate items with added sugar and salt.





# FROM DEE'S KITCHEN TO YOU

#### <u>Hawaiian Short Ribs</u>



- 3 tablespoons sesame seed
- 4 pounds beef short ribs
- 1 medium onion, sliced
- 1/2 cup soy sauce
- 1/4 cup firmly packed brown sugar
- 5 cloves garlic, minced
- 1/4 teaspoon ginger and pepper
- 2 small, dried hot chili peppers-seeded and crushed
- 1 1/2 cups water
- 1 teaspoon water
- 1 teaspoon cornstarch

Put sesame seeds in 5quart Dutch oven. Place over medium heat until lightly browned, shaking pan often to toast seeds evenly. Remove from heat and arrange ribs and onions on top of seeds. Combine soy sauce, brown sugar, garlic, ginger, pepper, chili peppers, and water. Pour over meat. Cover it and cook at 350 degrees in oven for 2 to 2 1/2 hours, or until meat is tender. Combine cornstarch and water. Remove meat from pot and make gravy.



#### Chicken, Peach, and Pistachio Pizza

1 10 ounce prepared thin pizza crust
4 cloves garlic, finely chopped
1 shallot, finely chopped
2 teaspoons fresh rosemary leaves, finely
chopped
1 large, fresh peach, thinly sliced, or one cup
of frozen peach slices
1 pound chicken breast tenderloins
3/4 teaspoons of kosher salt, divided
1/2 teaspoon pepper
2 tablespoon olive oil, divided
2 tablespoons unsalted butter
8 oz deli, mozzarella pearls
1/4 cup, dry, roasted shell pistachios, finely
chopped

Prepare oven at 400° place pizza crust on baking sheet. Chop garlic, shallots, and rosemary. Peel and pit peach, then thinly slice. Cut chicken into half inch cubes. Prepare large sauté pan on medium high for 2 to 3 minutes. Seasoned chicken with half a teaspoon of salt and pepper. Add 1 tablespoon of oil to pan, then add chicken. Cook 2 to 4 minutes, stirring occasionally, and until chicken is 165F. Combine in a small saucepan, garlic, shallots, butter, and remaining 1 tablespoon of oil and quarter teaspoon of salt. Cook and stir 2 to 3 minutes over medium heat until garlic is softened. Brush pizza crust with butter mixture, topped with peaches, chicken and cheese then sprinkle with rosemary. Bake 20 to 25 minutes until cheese melts and crust browns. Chop pistachios sprinkle over top of pizza. Slice and serve. Enjoy.
