### **MANAGER'S MESSAGE**

Last September Hurricane Ian hit southwest Florida as a category 4 hurricane. MANAGER
This year NOAA has predicted 12-17 named storms and 1-4 major hurricanes. We have had record breaking heat and with the ocean waters being warmer too, they can contribute to more powerful storms. Please prepare early! In the event of a hurricane, the office has prepared some information for our residents. In addition to preparing your home in the event of a hurricane, we have attached the shelters in our area and shelters



that allow pets. We also have a Special Needs and Pet Registration forms for those that may need it. Please stop by the office to pick one up or you may request to have one e-mailed to you.

<u>Dog Walkers</u> - If you own a dog or walk someone else's dog, please remember that pets are only allowed on your yard and the street pavement — not on other's yards or on the common grass. I recommend walking your pets in the early morning and evening when the sun isn't as strong and the pavement is not as hot. You are not to allow your dog, whether on a short leash or the extension leases, to be on any other grass. I get far too many complaints and have seen this myself. Please respect other's lawns, whether they maintain it nicely or not. Make sure that when your dog is outside, it is on a leash — even if the dog is in your yard and thank you for always picking up after your dog.

<u>Homes for Sale</u> – We have had a lot of homes bought and sold this past year. Please remember to let the office know if you plan to sell your home in Clearwater Cascade and provide the office with a flyer describing your home, price and contact information. We receive calls and walk-ins from potential buyers all the time!

<u>Guests</u> - It is summertime and we have a lot of visitors in the Park. Please make sure you take the time to sign in your guests in the office. You will be given guest passes for each of your guests. Also, please remember that children under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult while in the Park. Children under 18 are not permitted in the adult pool, Jacuzzi, exercise room or billiards room. Children are permitted in the small pool, recreation hall, shuffleboard courts, community center and bocce courts <u>only</u> when accompanied by a resident or adult guest.

<u>Alteration Requests</u> – Please remember anytime you make a change to the outside of your home or around it, you <u>must</u> turn in an Alteration Request Form <u>before</u> any work is done. Unfortunately, we have had a few residents who did work without approval and they did not follow the current Rules & Regulations. This can become costly for the resident if the work that was done has to be removed.

<u>Violations</u> – If you can't clean, paint your home, repair/replace ripped screens, etc. please call the office to discuss the issue so we can work out a plan. Do not ignore the violation letter. I don't want anyone having to pay fines because they can't comply before the date on the letter. If you are reading this newsletter on line and you have received a violation while you are north, call me to reach a solution. The board is expecting everyone to be responsible for the appearance of their homes and lots, no matter where they are.

### FROM THE EDITOR

ow many times do you have questions and turn to your computer? How reliable do you think it is? Recently I went Lto Google Search and asked what questions had been posed about HOA's in Florida. There were a considerable number of them.



Most were straightforward, some were a bit far-fetched, and some didn't make much sense. However, all were answered. I picked five to share with you. If you wish to see more, ask Google.

1. How do mobile home parks work in Florida?


This simply means that the mobile home is purchased and a monthly lot rent is paid on the lot that the home is located on. Depending on the community, the lot rent may include garbage and recycling pick up weekly or in some instances twice weekly, use of the amenities, lawn care, sewer, and water.

- 2. Can you be evicted from a mobile home park in Florida?
  - If you are a mobile home owner who rents a lot from a mobile home park (MHP), you can be evicted if: You don't pay your lot rent. You are convicted of violating a law and your actions threaten the health, safety, or welfare of other park residents. You violate your rental agreement or the MHP rules and regulations. Sep. 26, 2019
- 3. What happens if I walk away from my mobile home?
  - Under the lease, you owe the rent for the full term or duration of the lease; if you stop paying, the trailer park could sue you for the remaining rent due under the lease (technically, they could sue you for the rent for the remaining months under the lease or until they rerent the space, whichever happens first).
- 4. How long can a HOA board member serve in Florida?
  - In Florida, board members are only allowed to serve for eight consecutive years. If your documents don't specify term limits, it's important to check the laws in your state to see if there are mandatory standard term requirements. Jan. 20, 2021
- 5. How much can a Florida HOA raise dues?
  - Technically there is no limit to how much an HOA can raise dues each year in Florida. That said, within each HOA's CC&Rs there could be specific rules on raising dues. For example, some declarations may state that there can only be a 5% increase each year, however, this is on a case-by-case basis. Mar 30, 2021





The last report also included a letter from Grant Escobar, the Engineering Consultant. It is very informative so I have included it below.

Good afternoon, Clearwater Cascade!

Good news! In the last two weeks, we have completed Phase I & Phase II. We are currently in Phase III - Cost Estimating. My goal is to move through this phase relatively quickly in the next few weeks and get us to Phase IV. Phase IV is the point where the engineering and design are initiated. This phase is when you decide to move forward with the project and incur the engineering costs associated with the selected design. It will no longer just be me working on this project, but our team will start designing and completing the necessary requirements needed for permitting approval.



The goal during Phase III is to lay out all the projected costs associated with each option we propose (whether that may be a sea wall, rip rap, etc.) including the engineering design costs.

I am still doing by best to position ourselves for potential partnering opportunities (aka cost-sharing), but we can't initiate any partnerships with the county or anyone else until the design is complete and the permit is pending approval. Essentially, we need to show our potential partners that we are for real, we have the design complete, and necessary project funds to initiate the project. I can discuss this further with you down in the coming weeks.

Once Level Engineering completes our internal engineering design meeting, we will come up with the most efficient and cost-effective option that we will be recommending to the community and to the city.






