#### **RECYCLING**


Please be mindful of what and where you are putting your recycling items. It only takes a minute to break down a box and put bottles and cans in the proper place. *All items must be clean and dry*.

- Aluminum, Tin, or Steel Cans
- Glass Bottles and Jars

#### **CAN CRUSHER**

Te now have a new can crusher. You can find it in the main dumpster area behind the Blue Recycling Bin. You must clean/rinse your cans before crushing them, so we do not get a swarm of Bees. We would like you to crush your own cans but if you cannot, just leave them by the crusher and someone will take care of them. Aluminum is selling for fifty to fifty-five cents per pound, so this is a great source of revenue for the Association. Thank you in advance for your support.



They have also generously agreed to continue this program and will soon be letting us know the additional monthly dates and times they will be here.



The cat jumps up to the piano and starts playing a piece by Frederic Chopin, beautifully. As it finished, the cat then said, "MEOW!"







#### Solving the problems of the universe in your spare time

lbert Einstein worked a day job — eight hours a day, six days a week as an examiner in the patent office in Bern, Switzerland. He liked having a regular payday, and at night he walked around with friends and talked about physics. So it was in his spare time that Einstein changed the laws of physics. And that's part of why the world still loves him so. Even after he wrote and published four historic papers during his "miracle year," he continued on as an employee at the patent office. And isn't that what we all want, after all, to be recognized for the geniuses that we are, instead of the office kooks we feel like.

As a matter of fact, Einstein's job at the patent office might have helped him, since if he had been in the academic world his ideas might have been squelched by the professors in power. Would they have listened to a young guy who believed that space and time were not absolute?

His job probably also kept his mind sharp, because he was constantly called upon to evaluate people's inventions. This required him to use his powers of visualization and to use specifications and drawings to test the ideas out.

Einstein wrote: "Working on the final formulation of technological patents was a veritable blessing for me. It enforced many-sided thinking and also provided important stimuli to physical thought." — adapted from "Who knew: Outside player," by Joel Achenbach, in National Geographic




