



# Donate Blood - Save a Life

Blood gives us energy by bringing oxygen and nutrients to the body's cells. It also carries waste products to the liver and kidneys for removal.

Blood contains different types of cells and other components. Just two drops of blood can include millions of red blood cells, which carry oxygen and carbon dioxide. Blood also includes white blood cells (which fight disease), platelets which help form blood clots), and plasma (the liquid portion of blood).

Blood has a short shelf life, so blood donations are always needed. Platelets can only be stored for five to seven days, and red blood cells for up to 42 days.

Blood donation is safe and simple. It usually takes only about an hour of your time. But only 3% of Americans give blood each year.

You can donate blood if you're in good health and are at least 16 or 17 years old (depending on where you live). Learn more about blood donations at www.nhlbi.nih.gov/education/blood/donation.



# The Perils of Time-Share Resale Offers

### **How It Works**

- You see an ad or get a phone call or receive an invitation to a seminar from someone claiming that they can help you modify or cancel your timeshare contract.
- A reseller may reach out to you claiming to have a buyer interested in your property.
- They may guarantee a sale, claiming your property is in a "high demand" location.

### What to Know

- Selling or otherwise disposing of a timeshare is fraught with challenges, and the timeshare "exit" marketplace teems with bogus offers.
- Bad Actors in this space seem legitimate, complete with a sales contract that spells out the deal and related expenses taxes, closing costs, a fee to the reseller, etc.
- Too often the contract is fake, and the victim cannot reclaim the expenses, which could be in the thousands of dollars.

### What to Do

- Be leery of unsolicited offers to help you unload your timeshare.
- If you're looking to terminate your timeshare contract, start by asking your resort if they have a resale program.
- If you are considering a timeshare resale company, check with your state's consumer protection office to check its complaint history.


