



luncheons. These are great events to hang out with old friends and meet some new ones.


Just a few reminders from the office:

Dumpsters – Garbage

ust a few reminders:

- J Please use garbage bags when possible so that your trash does not fly out of the dumpster, grocery bags are very light and tend to fly when they dump the dumpster into the truck.
- NO Mattresses are allowed to be put in the dumpster, No furniture (recliners, couches, etc..) is to be put in the dumpster, they are your responsibility to get rid of.
- Put everything in the dumpster, not around the dumpster, no one else wants your trash.
- There are 3 dumpsters that everyone is allowed to use. You are not assigned to one dumpster, so if your usual dumpster is full, please take to one of the other two.
- Do not put trash in the blue recycle bins, also no garbage bags or grocery bags in the recycle bins.
- When it comes to recycling, we put out a pamphlet in the newsletter to remind everyone of all the do's and don'ts of recycling in Clearwater (It is different in every county and *continued on page 15*

every state). Please follow the flyer and when you are in doubt, please just throw it out. It is better to throw it out than to put the wrong items into the recycling system. If you need a new one just ask the office, we will be glad to give you one.

- If you have any scrap metal or old appliances that you need to get rid of, there is a junkman that will come to your home and pick it up and take it off for free for you. Ronnie Kitchen at 727-657-4428, He will also come and pick up those items that you are not allowed to put in the dumpster, such as mattresses, furniture, or other large items but he does charge a FEE for this. You can also call a local thrift store such as St Vincent's, hospice, goodwill, or Salvation army and donate to them if the item is in good repair.

Recipe of the Month

Summer Corn and Tomato Pasta

Ingredients

- Salt
- 1 pound bow-tie pasta
- 2 tablespoons extra-virgin olive oil
- 2 garlic cloves, smashed
- 1 pint cherry tomatoes
- 3 ears fresh corn, kernels cut off
- 2 tablespoons unsalted butter
- 1/4 cup fresh basil leaves, torn into pieces

Directions

- 1. Bring a large pot of salted water to a boil and cook the pasta until al dente; drain.
- 2. Meanwhile, in a large skillet, heat the olive oil over medium heat. Add the garlic and tomatoes and cook, stirring occasionally, until the tomatoes are softened, about 5 minutes. Stir in the corn, raise the heat slightly and cook until the corn is heated through and golden, about 5 minutes. Season to taste with salt.
- 3. Add the vegetables, butter and basil to the pasta and toss.






I walked by and saw my worker in the pit and I asked, "What you looking for?" The worker said, "I cut my ear off and I'm down here looking for it."
