WELCOME TO HILLCREST

Welcome to your new home. There are many new neighbors to meet and lots of activities to get involved in. All our clubs are supported by volunteers and we hope you will become involved with them.

This letter is to update you on some of the doings here in Hillcrest.

Trash pickup is on Monday and Thursday. You must have your bagged garbage out by 8am the day of pickup. If the Monday or Thursday is a holiday there will be no pickup and you can bring it to the garbage dumpsters or hold it at your home til the next pickup. Do not put out appliances, large furniture, paint, electronics etc. Paint and electronics can be take to the recycle center on Hercules. There is a large roll off dumpster on the south side for household items that don't go in the garbage bags. You will need to take it to the dumpster.

Branches and bagged grass/weeds can be put out by Wednesday which is the day maintenance should pick them up. Branches should be no more than 3 feet in length and tied together.

MONTHLY MEDIA is a newsletter magazine that is available monthly. It contains a monthly calendar and articles about the park.

HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION is legally known as Hillcrest Resident's Inc. This group is the intermediary for resident's to management. They meet with management monthly to review complaints and progress on programs.

As a resident's you have the responsibility to put your complaints in writing and tum them in to the office. General complaints, you should give a copy to the homeowners board of directors. They can't follow up if they are unaware of a problem.

SOCIAL CLUB is tasked with organizing and implementing social events. As a general rule they handle all major holidays and then any other parties or events, ie yard sale, season kick off party, end of season, etc. We are always looking for volunteers and ideas.

LADIES FRIENDSHIP CLUB is held monthly on the second Tuesday. It is held at 1pm in the clubhouse and is a time for the ladies to meet in fellowship over a cup of tea/coffee and a snack. This is a fantastic way to meet some new friends.

POTLUCK is held on the 2nd and 4th Thursday's of the month at 6pm. The host/hostess prepares the entree and attendees bring a side to share. The park gives money for the entree. The first potluck of the month is also birthday celebration time. Sign up in the purple book by the Tuesday prior to the potluck so there will be enough entree. Bring your side dish ready to serve, and make a quantity for 6-8 people. You must also bring your place setting.

COFFEE hour is held normally on the 1st Saturday of the month. You bring your cup and \$2.00 and enjoy fresh coffee and a donut or pastry. After the coffee time (where each club is invited to share what they're up to) the Social Club hold their monthly meeting.

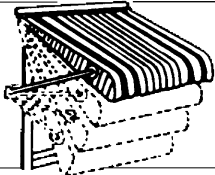

HOA BYLAWS CONTINUED

Section 8. Removal of Directors. At a special Membership Meeting called expressly- for that purpose, any Director or the entire Board of Directors may be removed; with or without cause, by a vote or agreement in writing of two-thirds (2/3) majority of all members entitled to vote at an election of Directors. A special meeting of members to recall a member or members of the Board of Directors may be called by ten percent (10%) of the members. Notice of this special meeting shall be consistent with notices of regular meetings and state the purpose of the meeting.

Section 9. Quorum and Voting. A majority of the number of Directors fixed by these bylaws shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business. The act of the majority of the Board present shall be the act of the Board of Directors.

Section 10. Director is Present A director shall be considered present for a regular or special meeting if he or she is in simultaneous communications, by telephone or other media, with all other Directors.

Section 11. Reasonable Expenses.. Reasonable expenses,, for performance of duties incurred by a Director or Officer will be paid by resolution and, or with prior approval for compensation by an officer other than themselves.

ARTICLE IV - OFFICERS

Section 1. Officers of the Corporation. The Officers of the Corporation, who shall also be Directors, shall be President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer, all of whom shall be elected annually by the Board of Directors. The Board of Directors may from time to time designate additional officers as they deem necessary. Any Officer may be removed with or without cause by a vote two-thirds (2/3) of the Directors present at a duly constituted meeting. Each Officer shall be a member in the Corporation. Officers shall be non-paid volunteers.

Section 2. President. The President shall be the Chief Executive Officer of the Corporation. He or She shall have all the powers and duties usually vested in the office of President of profit or non profit corporations including but not limited to, the power to appoint Committees, to assist in the conduct of the affairs of the Corporation. Unless otherwise directed by the Board, the President shall represent the Corporation and the Board of Directors at any outside meeting at which representation is requested or considered advisable. The President shall be an ex-officio member of all Committees, except the Nominating and Auditing Committees.

Section 3. Vice President. The Vice President, in the absence of the President shall exercise and perform the duties of the president. He or she shall assist the President generally and exercise such other powers and perform such other duties as shall be prescribed by the Directors

Section 4. Secretary. The Secretary shall keep the minutes of all proceedings of the Directors and the members, and shall be responsible for safekeeping of all records. He or she shall attend to the giving and serving of all notices to the members and Directors and other notices required by law. He or she shall have custody of the seal of the Corporation and affix it to the instruments requiring a seal when duly signed. He or she shall perform all duties incident to his or her office and as may be required by the Directors or the President. The Board of Directors shall appoint an assistant Secretary to act in the absence of the Secretary for an extended period. For short absences, any member of the Board may be appointed to temporary secretarial duties.

Section 5. Treasurer. The Treasurer shall have custody of all property of the Corporation, including funds, securities and evidences of indebtedness. He or she shall keep the book of the corporation in accordance with good accounting practices, and shall perform all other duties incidental to the office. The Board of Directors shall appoint an Assistant Treasurer to Act for the Treasure in his or her absence. Any two (2) officer's signatures are required on checks.

Section 6. Secretary & Treasurer. The offices of Secretary and Treasurer may be combined at the direction of the Board of Directors at times of diminished activity of these offices.

Article V - Membership

Section 1. Only bona fide owners may be accepted for membership.


Section 2. Membership will be transferred automatically when a home is inherited from a deceased owner.

Section 3. When a home is sold, the membership is not refundable or transferable, except membership is transferable when member purchases another home in Hillcrest Mobile Home Parle

Section 4. Initial membership fee is \$5.00. Annual dues are \$5.00 per year.

Section S.. Only one membership fee will be required where more than one home is owned

by the same owner entitling said owner to one (1) vote only. Under no circumstances shall a home owner be entitled to more than one (1) vote or more than one (1) membership.

Article VI -Annual Meetings

Section 1. Annual Meetings. The annual meeting, for members in good standing, shall be held at Hillcrest Mobile Home Parle Recreation Hall, unless otherwise designated by the Board of Directors, on the first Monday of February of each year:, provided however,; if that day is a legal holiday, the meeting shall be held on the next day that is not a holiday, at a time designated by the Board of Directors. Such annual membership meetings shall be for the purpose of transacting annual business of the Corporation, authorized to be transacted by the members. If there is no business to be transacted, in lieu of the meeting, an annual financial report, and if applicable; a summary of actions taken by the Board of Directors during the year is to be sent to each member with the annual election notice.

Section 2. Regular Meetings. Regular Meetings of the membership may be held at such time and place as shall be determined by fifty per-cent (50%) plus on (10 of the members. Notice of meetings shall be posted in a conspicuous place on the bulletin board in the recreation hall in the Park, at least forty-eight (48) hours in advance of any such meeting, except in the event of an emergency.

Section 3. Special meetings. Special meetings of the members shall be held when directed by the President, the Board of Directors, or when requested in writing by ten per-cent (10%) of all members in good standing, entitled to vote at a meeting. A meeting requested by members shall be called for a date not less than fourteen (14) nor more than sixty (60) days after the request is made, unless the members requesting the meeting designate a later date.

Section 4. Notice of Annual, Regular and Special Meetings. The notice of annual, regular and special meetings stating the time and place and the purpose for which the meeting is called shall be given by the President or Secretary. Such notice shall be in writing to each member at his or her Clearwater Florida address, as it is on the books of the Corporation and shall be mailed, or hand delivered, not less than fourteen (14) days nor more than thirty (30) days prior to the date of the meeting. Proof of such mailing shall be given by the affidavit of the person giving the notice. Mailing need not be by certified mail. Notice shall also be posted in a conspicuous place on the Park property fourteen (14) days prior to the meeting day.

Section 5. Notice of adjourned Meetings. When a meeting is adjourned to another place or time it shall not be necessary to give any notice of the adjourned meeting, if the place and time to which the meeting is adjourned are announced at that meeting. Any business may be transacted that might have been transacted on the original date of the meeting. It: however, after the adjournment the Board of Directors fix a new date for the adjourned meeting, a notice of a new date of the adjourned meeting shall be given to each member entitled to vote at such meeting.

Section 6. Fail to Accept Notice. Failure to accept or receive notice of any annual regular or special meeting of the members, for any reason whatsoever, shall not invalidate said notice or negate the Board of Directors having met the requirements of Article III Section 3.

Section 7. Quorum. A majority of the members in good standing, (Fifty percent (50%) plus on (1) entitled to vote, represented in person, by proxy or absentee ballot shall constitute a quorum at a meeting.

Article VII Committees

(b) A Committee Chairperson may solicit expert advice from non-members, who serve on temporary basis to the committee without fee or compensation.

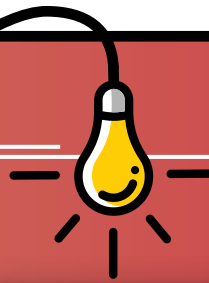

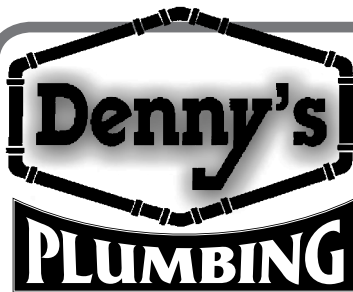

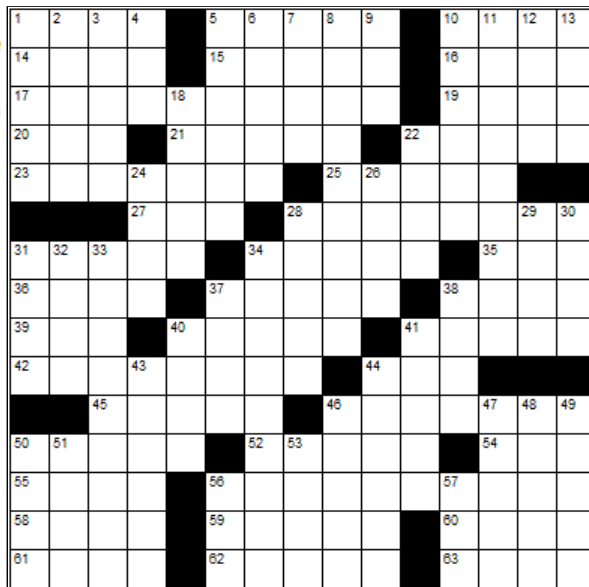

How a 17 year old started a thriving online business

At the age of 14, Joseph Cohen started his online venture. As a matter of fact, he waited until his parents went out of town for the weekend, but instead of throwing a party a la Risky Business, he called a car service, descended on Manhattan, bought \$3,000 worth of toys and Christmas lights and opened a Yahoo! store. Before his parents got home, he had doubled his money and had orders waiting.

Cohen says he did it while his parents were away because he thought they'd try to talk him out of it, because just a few weeks before he had accepted a credit card for a payment of \$1,000 in his first online venture — and the card turned out to be phony.

Three years later Cohen's business has \$1.9 million in sales — earning him \$425,000 before taxes.

During the first 14 months of his venture, Cohen sold \$270,000 worth of merchandise— but the following summer when he was 15 he went away to travel camp and took his eye off the business. On his Web site he offered a 50-foot rolled, flat hose for \$20. While he was at camp for six weeks thousands of orders came in and were put on backorder. When Cohen returned he rushed the items out to customers only to find out that the hoses were defective. He had to give customers' money back while he waited for a manufacturer's refund. Even worse, the item had been left online all summer and had racked up \$43,000 in ad charges through a per-click charge. He took care of what needed to be done and has gone on with his online business.

His advice for success: "You've got to do what you love."

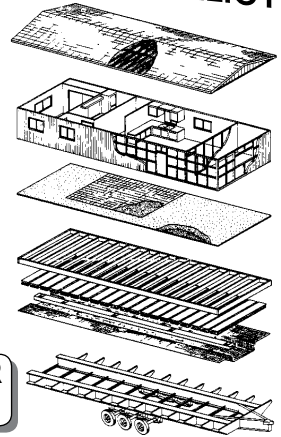
