ello Friends and Neighbors,

Adult Pool Update: In addition to the new collector tank that will be a major repair happening sometime next May or June (Pool Works will do this repair), the compressors with their heating/cooling processors have now bit the dust and need replaced. These compressors and processors are what keep here the cooled and heated appropriately.

our pools and spa tub cooled and heated appropriately.

There are three of these units that run the adult pool. Additionally, two more run the family pool and one more run the spa. Each of these compressor units have a heating and cooling processor that either heats the water if it is too cold or cools that water if it's too hot. All three units of the adult pool are gone and the water temperature is now somewhere between 90 and 100 degrees.

The age of this equipment is $(13 \ 1/2)$ years old. Depending upon whom you ask, the life expectancy is anywhere from 7 to 10 to possibly 15 years.

The Board has agreed to have Symbiont Pools replace all six of these units. Hopefully by the time you are reading this they will have been replaced and the pool water will be back to normal temperature.

Shuffleboard Courts resurfacing: Our shuffleboard courts were created by Nidy and require this same company to do the resurfacing. Other companies will not do the work. Nidy has been contracted to make the repairs and they are very backed up with other work. Bobbi continues to follow up with them and they have told her they will be out this fall.

September will begin the 2024-2025 budget process that will continue into October and November with the final budget being approved by the Board in early December and mailed out and/or sent electronically along with ballots and proxy information.

It is not too early to begin thinking about running for the Board of Directors. There will be three openings: Bev Richards, Barry Porter and myself will all be completing our three-year term.

Maintenance Team – What do the maintenance men do all day? Our maintenance team is very valuable to Clearwater Cascade by ensuring assets and equipment are up and running. Not only do they have weekly, monthly, quarterly and yearly preventative maintenance to do, they also have many tasks that the office provides. From water shut off repairs all the way down to delivering a package to a resident. There is always something to be done. The office uses a work order system to keep track of the work being completed. I want to brag about our maintenance team, Joel and Ron. As you know, it is hard these days to find employees that are knowledgeable, take pride in their work, are punctual and pleasant. Both Joel and Ron are all of those things and more. We are fortunate to have such a great maintenance team!

2022 Financial Audit – By now you should have been notified that the 2022 Financial Audit is available for viewing. You can upload it from OneSource, request a copy via e-mail or pick one up in the office.

VOLO – This is a reminder; we use VOLO to communicate with our residents. If your phone number or e-mail changes, please let the office know so we can update our list.

Back to School – This is the time of year when we need to keep an eye out for school buses and children walking to school. Driving in the early morning or afternoon may take a little longer. I spoke to the principal again this year at Cross Bayou Elementary about parents blocking our north entrance while waiting to pick up their children; she will ensure our north entrance is not blocked.

Hurricane Season – We have had a quiet summer so far! But the season is not over. By late summer and early fall, the waters in the Caribbean and Gulf of Mexico will be bathwaterlike. The warmer the water, the greater the potential for extremely strong hurricanes. Please remember to be prepared, have your hurricane kits ready and a plan in case of an emergency.

Coyotes – Did you know that coyotes are an important part of the landscape in Florida? They help maintain healthy ecosystems by managing populations of rodents, insects and other small animals. Coyotes are not large animals and rarely pose a threat to people, especially adults. They can be curious but are also timid and generally run away if challenged. If a coyote approaches too closely, there are methods you can use to deter it and frighten it away. Hazing the animal by making loud noises and acting aggressively will typically cause the coyote to leave an area. By preventing conflicts, we can better exist with coyotes and other wildlife. Keep wildlife wild! As with all wildlife, do not feed them. Never leave pet food or trash outside where it will attract wildlife. Avoid walking dogs during dawn or dusk hours, which are coyotes' normal feeding times. Avoid using a retractable leash.

DID YOU KNOW?

S eptember is the ninth month of the year in both the Julian and Gregorian calendars, the third of four months to have a length of 30 days, and the fourth of five months to have a length of fewer than 31 days. September in the Northern Hemisphere and March in the Southern Hemisphere are seasonally equivalent.

In the Northern hemisphere, the beginning of the meteorological autumn is on 1 September. In the Southern hemisphere, the beginning of the meteorological spring is on 1 September.^[1] September marks the beginning of the ecclesiastical year in the Eastern Orthodox Church. It is the start of the academic year in many countries of the northern hemisphere, in which children go back to school after the summer break, sometimes on the first day of the month.

September (from Latin *septem*, "seven") was originally the seventh of ten months in the oldest known Roman calendar, the calendar of Romulus c. 750 BC, with March (Latin *Martius*) the first month of the year until perhaps as late as 451 BC.^[2] After the calendar reform that added January and February to the beginning of the year, September became the ninth month but retained its name. It had 29 days until the Julian reform, which added a day.

be a contract showing the scope of services and the cost associated with doing the Engineering for the project.


Updates from Sandy on separate issues.


