- 3. Prior to closing, applicant(s) to be interviewed by the board of directors in order to become a resident of Golden Gate.
- 4. Upon closing and receiving the occupancy agreement from the clerk of courts, a share will be issued to complete residency requirements.

Checking Out? Leave a forwarding address with the post office.





1. New residents must have a welcome meeting by Board member(s).

VIII. SELLING UNIT:

- 1. The Board of Directors must approve all persons prior to closing of unit.
- 2. No more than two (2) signs per unit not to exceed 24x24, are permitted, and if not in the window of the unit the sign must not interfere with lawn maintenance.
- 3. Shareholders may sell their units or may utilize any outside brokerage service.



KEEPING YOUR COOL WHILE COOKING

When you can't stand the summer heat, stay out of the kitchen- or at least make meal prep as easy as possible. Here's how: Limit oven use. As the oven preheats, the kitchen warms up too, and it takes a while to cool down afterward. Choose recipes that don't require an

oven. When you do turn it on, take advantage of the hot oven and cook double batches, as well as foods you can use for multiple meals, such as baked potatoes or chicken,

Put tabletop appliances to work. A microwave, toaster oven, slow cooker and multicooker all use less energy than a oven or stovetop, and foods will still come out tasting great. Bonus: There's often less cleanup involved with these options.

Take shortcuts. You can let someone else do the cooking for you and still have a partially homemade meal. For example, a rotisserie chicken can be used for several recipes or served as is with a simple side dish.

Chill out. When possible, opt for cold, no cook foods such as sandwiches and wraps, green salads, hearty dips, cold soups and smoothies.

Eat in season, take advantage of the peak growing season and plan meals around fresh produce. A snack board featuring raw fruits and veggies is easy to throw together.

REVISED CHECK IN AND CHECK OUT FORM

In order to keep better track of Shareholders/Residents, Guests and the Water Bill, the Board of Directors is implementing a new CHECK IN (which is Green) and CHECK OUT (which is Orchid) system.

The new forms are now available at the Office door. Forms need to be COMPLETELY filled out and signed by Resident or Guest. Appropriate boxes need to be checked and Arrival and Departure Dates need to be ACCURATE.

RULE REMINDER- XI. EXTRA OCCUPANCY FEES AND GUESTS

- 2. Occupancy by guests of the Shareholder shall be for a period of time not exceeding 15 (fifteen) consecutive days and 30 (thirty) total days per year, unless a longer period is approved in writing, by the Board of Directors.
- 3. A shareholder who has a guest over to stay longer than 30 days will be assessed at current rate per month for each guest.
- 4. Use of unit by a Shareholder's guest, when not in residence, is permitted, provided the Shareholder notifies the office PRIOR to the arrival of the guest and assumes responsibility for the water, sewer, and garbage charges and designate the length of stay. (Please do this by EMAIL only)

The Office is opened Monday – Friday from 9:00 - 2:30. If the office is closed please place completed form, signed in office Mail Slot.
