September Birthstones

C apphire

The September birthstone is sapphire –The lustrous beauty of sapphire has been a popular staple in the jewelry world since at least the Middle Ages. Although most people know sapphire as a gorgeous blue color, there are a variety of other colors, including pink, black, and gray. There are even colorless sapphires and a pinkish orange version called *padparadscha*.

Sapphire itself is one of two gem varieties of corundum, the other being ruby. These beautiful gems are far-reaching and have been found everywhere from Australia to Vietnam. Although the geographic origin of a sapphire doesn't necessarily guarantee its level of quality, the sapphires that fetch the highest premiums often come from the Kashmir, as well as Sri Landa and Madagascar.

September is the ninth month of the year and has 30 days. It marks the beginning of autumn in the Northern Hemisphere and spring in the Southern Hemisphere. Notably, it's named after 'septem', the Latin term for seven, as it was originally the seventh month in the Roman calendar.

The month sees a change in foliage in the Northern Hemisphere, as leaves start to turn into beautiful autumnal colors.

September Awareness

There are several awareness celebrated in September — though the five that often get the most attention include Blood Cancer Awareness Month, National Alcohol & Drug Addiction Recovery Month, Library Card Sign-up Month, National Suicide Prevention Awareness Month, and World Alzheimer's Disease Month.

Blood Cancer Awareness Month, a time to honor the 1.5 million people in the U.S. living with or in remission from blood cancers. For all those impacted by cancer, every minute matters—whether it's racing against time to find the right treatment, achieving remission, or savoring quality moments with friends and family.

National Recovery Month began in 1989 under the name of *Treatment Works! Month*, to honor the hard work of addiction professionals. Then in 1998, it was decided to rename the event National Alcohol and Drug Addiction Recovery Month in an effort to honor not only the work of healthcare professions in the addiction field, but to also draw attention to the work of individuals suffering from substance use disorder.

September is National Suicide Prevention Awareness Month. National Suicide Prevention Week is September 4 - 10, 2022, with World Suicide Prevention Day on the 10th. Throughout the month, and especially during the week of September 4, individuals and organizations around the country have plans to highlight the problem of suicide and advocate its prevention.

Suicide is a national health problem and currently ranks as the second leading cause of death for ages 10-45. Suicide is also one of the most preventable types of death in our nation.

Throughout the United States, suicide prevention organizations, including The Jason Foundation, will be facilitating prevention and awareness events.

World Alzheimer's Month in September is such an important observance.

Alzheimer's disease is the most common form of dementia, affecting about 6 percent of people 65 and older. Although it may seem like just a typical disease for older people — it is, in fact, not a normal part of aging. Scientists don't know what causes Alzheimer's, but they suspect it's a combination of many factors. The disease affects parts of the brain that control memory, thought, and language. There is no cure, but experts think that lowering blood pressure, exercising, and not smoking may reduce the risk.



September Recipes For Fall


Fall Kale and Sausage Pasta Bake

INGREDIENTS

- 1 tablespoon olive oil
- 1 yellow onion finely diced
- 3 garlic cloves finely minced
- ¹/₂ lbs. Italian sausage ground
- 14.5 oz tinned tomatoes diced
 - **INSTRUCTIONS**
- 1. Cook penne according to packet instructions
- 2. Preheat oven to 400F/200C
- 3. Heat olive oil in an ovenproof skillet over medium to high heat
- 4. Add onion, sauté 4 to 5 minutes
- 5. Add garlic and sauté 1 minute
- 6. Add ground sausage, and fry until lightly browned. Use a spoon to gently crush the ground sausage into smaller chunks.
- 7. Add tomatoes and red pepper flakes if using, ¹/₄ cup of the finely chopped basil and salt and pepper to taste.
- 8. Reduce heat to low and gently simmer 10 minutes until the sauce thickens slightly.
- 9. Strain penne and add to skillet. Stir through the kale.
- 10. Sprinkle with the mozzarella cheese
- 11. Bake in oven 10 minutes, or until cheese starts to melt and brown slightly.
- 12. Serve with the additional roughly chopped basil

Apple Cider Cocktail

- 2 ounces apple cider I prefer unfiltered
- 1/2-ounce lemon juice
 - 3 ounces ginger beer recommended: Fever Tree
- OPTIONAL: 1/2-ounce orange liqueur recommended: Grand Marnier
- or Cointreau; I do not recommend triple sec; it's just too sweet
- Garnish: Cinnamon stick apple slice, spring of thyme



¹/₄ teaspoon red pepper flakes optional

- ¹/₂ cup mozzarella cheese
- 4 basil leaves extra, roughly torn
- 1 cup penne pasta




