HOME MAINTENANCE

We would like to give a shout out to all the residents who have been keeping your homes maintained and looking fabulous. We appreciate you maintaining the beauty and charm of Sugar Creek. In the month of September, we will be looking at gutters. Please take some time to look around the outside of your home and your gutters to see what needs to be done. Of course, we are also are looking at your entire lot.

ICE CREAM SOCIAL

The Rowans, Dominick's and Staff enjoyed hosting an ice cream social for the residents that are in the Park in July. We had a great turnout, and it was a pleasure seeing everyone have a good time while listening to music, dancing, and socializing (and we can't forget eating the ice cream)! We look forward to another one next Summer!

WILDLIFE IN THE PARK

At times we see wildlife in the park, as they live outside and in our pond. If you happen to see a sick or hurt animal, please call animal control at 727-582-2600 or SPCA Wildlife 727-586-3592. Our office cannot trap or chase these animals. If it is an alligator call 866-392-4286. Please do not call 911 unless it is a life-threatening emergency.



MOSQUITOES

Recently we had the County come in and assess our park for mosquito breading areas. We were advised that this is not an area of concern for the county to spray. What they found was some residents have standing water in their yards, flowerpots and other items that hold water, this includes gutters on your home. We have pamphlets in the office on how you can STOP Raising Mosquitoes. We also have a company that comes out and sprays the pond and the grass in the common areas including the dog park.

If you are concerned about mosquitoes, here are some tips from Pinellas County Mosquito Control Commission:

Mosquitoes breed year-round in Pinellas County. Protect yourself from bites and mosquitoborne illnesses by following these tips:

Avoid the outdoors during high mosquito activity times.

Many mosquito species are active at dusk.

Wear loose, light-colored long sleeves and pants.

Socks and shoes also help create a barrier.

Wear a repellent with a CDC-recommended active ingredient.

DEET, Picaridin, IR3535, and Oil of Lemon Eucalyptus are recommended. You can also try a spatial repellent device that uses repellents such as allethrin. Make sure screens are intact and repair any holes.

Avoid propping open un-screened windows and doors.



Did you know that mosquitoes only need 1/4 inch of water to complete their life cycle? Breeding habitat can be found around your yard and home year-round due to rainfall and watering your plants or lawn.

Prevent mosquitoes by following these tips:

Dump standing water once a week.

Dump and refill water in pet dishes and bird baths

Check common places where water accumulates, such as flowerpots and saucers, wheelbarrows, tarps, children's toys, garbage, recycling bins, gutters, and AC drip lines.

SUSPICIOUS VEHICLES

If you see a vehicle driving around that looks suspicious, after hours, call the sheriff to check it out. Do not wait until Monday to let us know. If you are concerned for your safety and the safety of the residents in the park, the right action to take is to call 911 or the non-emergency #727-852-6200.

GARBAGE

We all know the garbage men come early on Mondays and Thursdays at times so if you are putting your cans out the night before, make sure it is in the evening, so your trash is not sitting out all day. This doesn't look appealing!

If you have a park-related emergency the phone number to call is 727-301-9589. This number is on the first page of every issue of the monthly media as well as the community phone book on page 1. The number is also posted on every door to the clubhouse. Please keep this number handy in case of an emergency.

CHEF'S CORNER

CUCUMBER SALAD

Ingredients

2 medium cucumbers, sliced 1/8 inch thick

1 tablespoon kosher salt

1/2 cup white vinegar

1/4 cup snipped fresh dill

3 tablespoons sugar

1/2 teaspoon coarsely ground pepper

Directions

- 1. Place cucumber slices in a colander over a plate; sprinkle with salt and toss. Let stand for 15 minutes, stirring once. Rinse and drain well.
- 2. In a large bowl, combine the vinegar, dill, sugar and pepper. Add cucumbers; toss to coat. Cover and refrigerate for at least 15 minutes before serving.



4 teaspoons dried rosemary, crushed

2 teaspoons dried oregano

2 bay leaves




