Update to land development for 800 8th Avenue SE. Apartment complex.

Please see below for some updated information. A letter will be sent via Postal Service regarding this updated project to our neighborhood. This letter may be addressed to the Property Manager's office. I will ask Albert to pass along a copy of the letter if in fact he does get a copy. The developer will also be required to hold a meeting (to be held at City Hall) to announce and review their plans for the project. No date as of yet has been set for this meeting.

Back when we were pushing to keep the developer that purchased the land at 800 8th Avenue SE from building an apartment complex that he had planned, we fought to make sure the re-zoning from commercial to residential did not pass. We won that battle and have been waiting because the developer would have been allowed to build warehouses for light manufacturing on the same land. Nothing has ever come of it to date.

Our community had also been very instrumental at the Largo Commission meetings to make sure that the referendum that was finally put on that ballot for the Pickle ball complex did not get approved, (different parcel of land). I had signed up to receive e-mails from the land planning dept./ City of Largo (askaplanner@largo.com). This morning, (August 3rd) I got an e-mail letting me know that the apartment project could very well be on again. Thanks to our State Legislature a new law went into effect July 1st, 2023 called the Live Local Act. This law allows the State to override any communities planning and would not require that the land be re-zoned thereby giving the developer the go ahead to put the apartments in place without approval of the City or its citizens. The Live Local Act also prohibits local government from restricting the height of a new development below the highest limit allowed for a commercial or residential building located within one mile of the new structure. Great Facebook page was created by residents that fought not to have the Pickel Ball courts stopped. Like on Facebook: Largo Politics and Policies. This Facebook page was instrumental in getting the word out and keeping local residents informed.

A developer (not sure if it is the same one) has applied for approval to construct an apartment complex on the property at 800 8th Avenue SE. Would be a multifamily, mixed-use residential with at least 40% of the rental units marked "affordable" for at least 30 years. At least 65% of the development square footage will have to be used for residential purposes. The updated project will be larger (more apartment buildings) then the original plans we had been presented.

The City of Largo Mayor Brown is recommending that as many people as possible attend meetings as they are scheduled to ask lots of questions and present their concerns. Time to get the word out again. New Haven Condos on Donegan Rd. are already working to get the message to their residents. I will check the August and September City of Largo Commission calendar to see if this topic is on the agenda for any upcoming meetings. Meetings at City Hall always held on Tuesday evenings.

Meeting to be held on September 13th, 2023 at Largo City Hall 5:00 PM to 7:00 PM. Developer of Allora Largo Apartments will be presenting plans at this Neighborhood Information Meeting. Marge Kristall





his is an update on the Mobile Home Tie-Down Program. The article is from the FMO Magazine. This is the Federation of Manufactured Home Owner of Florida.

The Gulf Coast State College Mobile Home Tie-Down Program is busy completing parks assigned for FY 22-23. Between the two contracted vendors, Storm Ready Services and Florida Homes Direct, 11 parks and 51 individuals have been completed and invoiced: about

300 homes have been completed so far.

FHD is contracted for the panhandle region has assigned 5 parks and 10 individuals.

SRS is contracted for the rest of the sate, and is working several parks at on time with 5 different teams on the ground. They have an additional 46 parks currently assigned in various stages of progress. Three of these parks have over 1,200 homes that will likely take the program into the next grant year to complete.

Also, there are an additional 51 parks with confirmed park representation online for future assignment and another 60 parks that have not yet been confirmed.

All in all, the Mobile Home Tie-Down programs continues to be successful, and we appreciate your support!

Lincolnshire Estates is one of the parks. They will be coming to evaluate the situation and we will know more after that has been done. Remember this is at no cost to the home owner.

We would like to remind everyone to come to the board meetings all owners are welcome. Remember you have to be an HOA member to vote.

A Nurse's Self Care Toolbox #64

ast month we looked at protecting our skin in an increasingly hostile environment by protecting against not only sun protection, dry skin, and the dry skin conditions of aging. Now, the more we know about skin cancer and the precancerous warning signs the better prevention and actions are needed. Especially when we notice something <u>suspicious</u> on our skin. Remember that we live where sunshine gets to our skin many hours a day. Even with the shades and curtains drawn tight.

Some background first. Skin cancer begins in the cells that make up the outer layer (epidermis) of our skin. Skin cancer is the abnormal growth of skin cells that most often develops on skin exposed to the sun or chemicals. Though some groups of us seem more susceptible. Me too.

Melanoma (our focus here), basal cell skin cancer and squamous cell skin cancer are the most common types found in seniors. Melanoma is a disease in which malignant cells form in the skin cells called melanocytes which gives us our skin color. When skin is exposed to the sun, melanocytes make more pigment, causing the skin to tan, or darken. When melanoma starts in the skin, the disease is called cutaneous (outer) melanoma and can occur anywhere on the body. Risk factors are unusual moles, exposure to natural sunlight (even inside our homes, sunlight still invades around curtains and blinds), exposure to artificial ultraviolet light (tanning booths), history in the family, Caucasian, being an adult, certain features like blond or red hair, light skin, and freckles too. Whew!

What do we look for and how often. Checking for moles, new or already there twice a year and looking for a difference in how they look, getting larger, changing shape or color. Does it itch or bleed often. Seeing smaller and similar moles around the larger suspicious mole. By the time we retire we do have a lot of skin tags, moles, and scars. The more often you inspect the more you know these old ones you have seen for years.

I cannot stress enough that <u>we are</u> the first line of defense with noticing problems with our skin that is bothersome. We so often see our physician's medical team where a more thorough skin examination seems to take second or third place in the visit if at all. Ask for a skin examination at each yearly visit and <u>especially</u> if you are concerned! Ask a friend to look at your back too. You do their back too. Take a phone picture if you can. Most people can't escape getting a skin exam if they are seeing a dermatologist. Hold still as it won't hurt! Unless they pull out the freezer gun though only for a moment.

What is the next step if our medical team is concerned about a spot, mole, or lesion on our skin? Most often a referral to a dermatologist. If there is concern on whether it is an abnormal skin growth or even in a high probability area, they will typically do a biopsy. After numbing up the skin area they will do a local excision to remove as much of the suspicious mole or lesion as possible. A pathologist then looks at the tissue under a microscope to check for cancer cells. Melanoma can be hard to diagnose which can mean another biopsy or additional office visit. We should not shave off or clip off suspicious looking areas as this can delay identification if cancerous and, in some cases, increase the spread. Be smart and call your medical team. If you don't have one, then get one today.
