

Please report pool noodles that are worn or coming apart to the HOA office as worn-out pieces get into the filters of the pool.

We would also like to inform you that there are some broken bricks before the stairs at the entrance of the pool. These bricks may pose a tripping or cutting hazard for anyone who walks over them. Please be aware of the broken bricks and avoid stepping on them or touching them.

The office is working to repair the bricks as soon as possible and restore the safety and beauty of the pool area. We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause you and we appreciate your patience and cooperation. Thank you for your understanding.



### The Following rules apply to parking at ALL times

### All Residents Must Register their Vehicles

- Do not park on the grass ever
- Do not park on the sidewalk
- No overnight street parking
- Parking update: NEW PARKING STICKER POLICY AND TOWING TO BEGIN JULY 1st. For residents who do not have parking decals for their vehicles (maximum of two vehicles per home), you will need to come into the office to get the appropriate parking decal. Please bring in your vehicle registration. It's important to reiterate that clubhouse parking is for residents and their guests during the hours of 9am-10pm. We are implementing a new process for anyone requesting permission to park their car at the clubhouse overnight. ### **Reminder on Trash Policies**

oing forward, the dump will be open 8-3 on Tues and Friday, and 8-11 on Saturday. We are going to try this to see if we can keep the illegal dumping under control but still giving you all access. A reminder/ the rule, if it wont fit in a large size trash can, it does not belong in the dump area. No furniture, chemicals of any kind, propane tanks, paint, electronics, construction debris, grills, etc...ever. The compactor is for your regular bagged up household trash, the big dumpster is for yard waste and the blue



container is for recyclables. ANYTHING ELSE IS THE RESIDENTS RESPONSIBILITY TO HAVE HAULED OFF THE PROPERTY because Valet Living won't pick it up either. If you are caught dumping anything else, that is actually a crime, you will be fined by the county, get a violation letter from us, and we will close the area back up. (we don't want that)

Beginning 8/22, the maintenance staff will no longer be going around to pick up trash or yard waste. Valet Living will still pick up your trash, but all of the same policies above apply pertaining to what is allowed in the dump area and what they will and won't pick up. Everything bagged in trash bags and boxes broken down should be it. It doesn't make sense to have them go back and do the same thing we already pay a vendor for and use up man hours when there are so many other things that need attention on the property. This does include yard waste, you will have to take that to the dumpster because Valet Living does not pick that up. I have faith that this will be a smooth transition, if you have any questions, please call us at (727) 531-9105. Thank you.



Therefore, the team has been instructed to not take direction from residents. All requests for services from the Maintenance Team must come through the office so we can follow the processes that are in place. Please refrain from stopping at the Maintenance Office unless it has been coordinated through the office. We appreciate your understanding.



Since the Maintenance Team will no longer be picking up yard waste or excess trash, the dumpster area will be open from 8:00 am to 3:00 pm on Tuesday and Friday, and 8:00 am to 11:00 am on Saturday for your convenience. No furniture, appliances, chemicals, paint, propane tanks, grills, construction debris, etc. can go

in the dumpsters and must be hauled off property. A reminder that if it won't fit in a large size trash can, it most likely does not belong in the dumpster area. There's an interesting article in Florida Today (article #8325765002) that states "When a business dumps their litter in your dumpster in order to save money and avoid paying the proper disposal of that litter, they are committing a third- degree felony. It does not matter how much litter, as any amount for a commercial purpose is a felony." This is important to communicate to anyone working on your home. If you have a contract for work being done to your home, that contractor must not use the dumpsters on property. They will need to dispose of it elsewhere.

### Let's Get to Know Florida Statute 723 & Our By-Laws

eetings of the board of directors and meetings of its committees at which a quorum is present shall be open to all members. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the requirement that board meetings and committee meetings be open to the members does not apply to



meetings between the park owner and the board of directors or any of the board's committees, board or committee meetings held for the purpose of discussing personnel matters, or meetings between the board or a committee and the association's attorney, with respect to potential or pending litigation, when the meeting is held for the purpose of seeking or rendering legal advice, and when the contents of the discussion would otherwise be governed by the attorney-client privilege. Notice of all meetings open to members shall be posted in a conspicuous place upon the park property at least 48 hours in advance, except in an emergency.

The board of directors shall meet within seven (7) days prior to each annual general meeting, and such other meetings of the general nature that may be required, for the purpose of developing and approving an agenda for each such meeting of the corporation membership.

### **Urban wildlife trying to survive another day**

Te all know that cockroaches will be around long after we are all gone. But so will coyotes. These keenly intelligent and adaptable animals have been surviving for millions of years. They are exceedingly resilient. They pretty much thrive everywhere in North America, including metropolitan areas like New York City ... and Largo.



Coyotes are now the most common large wild predators most Americans have ever seen.

Humans have gone to great lengths to exterminate the species: poison, gas, leg hold traps, hunting (including by helicopter) and all-out programs designed to kill. In a disheartening note, the government's war on coyotes only launched after all the wolves were wiped out. With few wolves left to kill, coyotes became the next target.

But killing off all the wolves also set off an ecological chain reaction. Coyotes easily filled the niche, by forming packs and taking down bigger prey. Coyotes were harder to kill by conventional means, because wolves' social bonds meant that pack members followed family members into traps. Coyotes "ratcheted themselves" into high survival gear.

Since 2001, the U.S. Wildlife Service has killed about 35,000 coyotes from planes and helicopters every year. Sheep and goats have been fitted with 1080 (poison) collars so when coyotes attack a flock of sheep, and go for their throats, they bite the collars and die from poisoning. Coyote poisons have been banned in the United States but a recent ruling by the Environmental Protection Agency had opened the door to using them again. To this day, there are coyote killing contests and there are no limits on the number of coyotes you can kill. The war on coyotes continues.

Instead of reviling them, we should feel lucky to spot a coyote in our urban jungle. Coyotes are smart, resilient, and adaptable animals. They have no interest in interacting with humans; they learned long ago we're the enemy. Yet, of course, no predator is going to pass up a chance of an easy meal. Bring your cats inside where they belong. Don't leave food outdoors. Don't feed wildlife. Trim your bushes and keep lids on your trash cans tight. We can, and should, coexist in peace.


