SLOW COOKER BAKED POTATO

(Adapted from an allrecipes.com recipe)

In this heat, few of us want to turn on the oven to make dinner. But we also hate to give up some of our favorites. Crockpot to the rescue! This recipe can be found all over the internet, but I started with Allrecipes.com.



Ingredients:

4 baking potatoes, well scrubbed

1 TBS oil

Salt to taste

4 sheets of aluminum foil (each large enough to fully enclose a potato)

Directions:

- 1. After scrubbing, prick potatoes with a fork several times.
- 2. Rub with oil and season with salt. (I have learned it is easiest to oil the potatoes using a plastic bag. Place the oil in a sandwich/quart size plastic bag, insert potatoes one at a time, roll the potato around in the oil in the bag, remove and repeat until all potatoes have oil on them. And, voila!, less mess on your hands.)
 - 3. Wrap each potato tightly in aluminum foil and place into the slow cooker.
- 4. Cook on low until tender about 7 1/2 hours (time varies depending on the size and number of potatoes). Or cook on high for 4 1/2 to 5-ish hours.

come see me and we can set up a payment plan where Mr. Larson will pay for it, and you just repay it by adding \$100 to your rent every month.

Blacktop patching was done in the 12th street parking lot and on 3rd street. A few streets will be done as soon as we can get them scheduled with the blacktop company.

After I made several disastrous attempts at setting up a park Facebook account, Sonny O'Leary gave me managerial rights to use the one he created when they ran the summer programs. It is Embassy MHP residents. This is what I will be using to communicate some park events; it was recently tested during a water issue; I kept residents updated throughout the repairs. One problem is not everyone uses Facebook, so I am also working on a group email for the same purpose. The Facebook account only has 49 members, and I only have 51 email addresses, despite many attempts to get them! The park does not pay for my cellphone, so I have no way to send out text messages. A few residents have my number, but they are all people I trusted not to abuse it (plus I can just block them if they do)!

I currently have a "Wall of Shame" on the window by the back entrance to the Clubhouse, where I am posting pictures of residents who continue to NOT recycle properly. I have a detailed article elsewhere in this issue; I don't know how else to educate residents! I would like to thank all of the residents that do recycle properly, as well as picking up items on the ground and checking the recycle bins for plastic bags and removing them. If you have something that you are discarding but feel someone else can use it, put it out by the street with a sign that says "Free"; if it is there longer than 24 hours, please discard it. There also is a "swap" table in the 12th street laundromat.

The Park medical room is short on canes; if you have 1 you are not using, please drop it off at the office.


I know it is unbearably hot most days, but your lot and carport need to be maintained according to the park guidelines. You also need to have them "hurricane" ready, which means nothing laying around that could become a projectile in high winds. All ladders must be secured to the back of the mobile or side of the shed (I don't understand why elderly people need ladders, they are accidents waiting to happen), but about 50% of the park has them laying around!

As referenced elsewhere in this issue, we are having a severe homeless issue. I have completed an eviction at lot 109, I am in the middle of evicting Lot 121, and there is another lot on my radar that is going to be next. If I am notified of homeless belongings on park property, I send someone to discard them. Homeless people have their own type of community, so word should be getting out that they are not welcome at Embassy!

My second great granddaughter is arriving no later than August 15th, so I will be making frequent trips to MI and OH. By the time you read this, I will have welcomed the new baby (Delaney Reese Parks) upon her arrival home from the hospital. Lylah Quinn Parks is already 7 months old and starting to have conversations with her Nana that only she and I understand!

he Embassy community had a busy morning on Thursday, July 27th. Before most of us were even out of bed, Scott Hawker, who lives on 8th Street, saw a suspicious character going from carport to carport trying car door handles. He quickly called in a report to Largo PD and they responded. It wasn't long before there were multiple police cars blocking some of our streets, a helicopter hovering overhead, and police dogs walking

the area trying to pick up a trail. Scott gave the officers a detailed description of the suspect and they were able to spot him on nearby security systems. Later in the morning Largo PD received a call from a neighboring community reporting the same suspicious character. The suspect was not apprehended in either search, and he was last seen near US Hwy 19.

But wait, that's not all! Just as the Largo PD was decamping from the 8th Street area, someone delivering News and Views on 1st Street noticed (what was supposed to be) a vacant RV with the door hanging wide open and a pile of possessions appearing to belong to a homeless person nearby. Jessie flagged down one of the departing patrol cars and, even though this was not technically their coverage area, they immediately went to investigate. Fortunately, the RV was empty (this time) and there didn't appear to be any damage to the interior. Jessie has contacted the owner, efforts are underway to better secure the RV and the Neighborhood Watch team was notified to pay particular attention to that area during patrols.

And the takeaway from all of this?

- 1. Hats off to Scott for calling it in. Please call when you see someone suspicious in the area.
- 2. Pay attention and try to provide a detailed description. Scott gave very small details to the dispatcher which later enabled the officers to locate the suspect on several security cameras.
- 3. Lock your doors (yes, even when you are inside the house), sheds, car doors and bikes. Let's not make it easy for criminals to take our bikes and valuables.



EMBASSY MOBILE PARK INC. GARBAGE/RECYCLE GUIDELINES

mbassy Mobile Park Inc. provides dumpsters in several locations, and for specific items. Your regular household garbage goes into the dumpster on 2nd street, dumpster on 4th street, and the 3 black ones in the 12th street parking lot. NO yard clippings, tree branches, construction materials, furniture, etc. are to go into these dumpsters!

There is a 30-yard dumpster located on the north side of 3rd street with a sign on it saying yard trash and tree branches. NO garbage is allowed in this dumpster.

There is a 30-yard dumpster located on the south side of 3rd street that is for construction materials, old furniture, etc. Items must be put INTO the dumpster, not left on the ground. No garbage or materials are to be brought into the park from somewhere else. If the gate is closed, it means the dumpster is full, so you need to take your items home until it is emptied. DO NOT put them on the ground outside or inside the gate.

Last but not least, we have 2 blue dumpsters located in the 12th street parking lot for recyclables only! This means no garbage, no grass clippings, no tree branches, no clothes, etc. Absolutely no plastic bags, which means that if you have cans/bottles in a bag you need to empty the bag into the bin, then throw the bag into the regular trash bin. Plastic bottles must be numbered 1 through 7, rinsed out, lid on. Metals allowed, such as aluminum, tin, steel, including foil, food trays and aerosol cans, GLASS -colored bottles and jars that have been cleaned, without lids or caps. If you are recycling boxes, please break them down flat before putting them in the dumpster....this makes more room in the dumpster; boxes cannot have wavy cores, plastic liners or waxy coatings.

There are Pinellas County Recycle guides in the office, they are not available in Spanish, I have asked, and they said maybe next year.

Items you put out to the street for pickup (this does not mean your household garbage) - all items need to be boxed, bagged, or bundled, and are not to be put out to the street until after 5 p.m. on Sunday, Tuesday, and Thursday. If you put your garbage out before these times, you will get a notice saying we will not pick it up and you will have to take it to the dumpster yourself.

As some of you may know, I have cameras on the dumpsters, so I can see who is not following the rules. I am posting pictures by the back door of the clubhouse so everyone can see who is breaking the rules. I call it the "Wall of Shame"!

Embassy has been fined by the City of Largo twice already for the wrong items being put into the recycle bins. These fines can be passed on to everyone in the form of a larger rent increase (rent is increased every year, new rates go into effect on January 1, 2024). You will receive a rent increase letter around October 1, 2023.

Beginning January 1, 2024, I will be assessing fines to people caught not following the garbage/recycling rules. The 1st offense will be \$50, the 2nd offense will be \$200, and the 3rd time I will start the eviction process for repeated violation of the Park rules.
